I received a letter a few days ago from Jim Kistner telling me about the IRCA and I have decided to join. I have been interested in DXing for almost three years. My receiver is a Montgomery Ward Airline model 62-136 shortwave of 1938 vintage. I got the radio in 1961 as a piece of junk out of an old house. It took just about two hours of putting it into operating condition, but building a new cabinet took considerably longer. My antenna is a 50' longwire on the roof of our house. I am also building a variable tuned loop antenna to permit nulling of strong local signals so weak signals can be copied with less QRM. I have heard stations in 19 countries and 16 are verified. I have heard stations in 27 states with 18 verified. I am, of course, trying to get veries from all 50 states. I have also heard stations in 6 Canadian provinces with 4 verified. The most distant bcb station is WBZ in Boston, Mass. on 1030. My most distant countries on SW are Australia and West Congo. I have just received my Monitor Registration from Popular Electronics which are WPE7CER and WPE7CEC. I don't know why I received two certificates.

Occasionally go down to the Bay on the warmer weekends and DX Saturday afternoon, evening and early Sunday morning. I am about 500 ft. or so from the water on a high hill overlooking most of the cottages in the area, and find reception on BCB, FM and TV to be really great. We get a definite N, NE and E effect there on these bands and on BCB such stations as CBT Grand Falls, Nfld. on 540; CBN at St. John's Nfld. on 640 kc. and CBY Corner Brook over on 990 kc have been noted on several occasions, during the early evening overriding their channels. Other new Canadians added from the Bay included CJSS Cornwall, Ont. on 1220 kc. logged between 0544 and 6:12 PM on Jan. 1st. Their letter of verification states that over 90% of their US reports come just prior to their 12:06 AM s/off just after WGAR leaves the air. Also a good idea if your radio has a small speaker is to get a 4x6 speaker and connect it to the plugs going to the earphone jack to your transistor radio. This would seem to hold forth some hope for making the HQ180 a bit hotter on splits. Will take the loop and HQ180 someplace sans outside antennas and see just how it works solely with the loop. Believe could use another turn on the loop, as condenser shows a two-sided "peak" only from about 620 kc. up. Not a good verifier. - ed)
- XEHB San Francisco del Oro, MEXICO was logged and reported on 1/27 under KOB with RS from 1945-2000 s/off. Slogan is "Radio Frisco". (DJ)
- CX 12 Montevideo, URUGUAY, "Radio Oriental" operates from 0455-2245 with a power of 25 kws.. (LBG)
- ???? A funning thing happened! I'd just woke up, turned on the radio, and I heard "ache hota" twice. HJJX? This was on 2/1 at 0500. (RJS) (Must be as they're the only one here. HJHJ is on 600 kcs.. - ed)
- .773 Cairo, EGYPT/UAR was in very well on 2/2 at 2310; in Arabic, of course. The new EBU report lists this one as 200 kws., but WRTVH-65 says 500 kws.. Sounds more like the latter! (ELK)
- 775 PJA 8 Sint Nicolaas, Aruba, NETHERLANDS ANTILLES was heard here on 2/1 from 0510-0530 in English and featuring US instrumental music. Very difficult to copy due to heavy YVOD QRM. Not enough for a report this time; I'll have to wait. I consider this my best Caribbean log so far! (RJL)
- TIW San Jose, COSTA RICA was logged and reported on 1/29 & 1/30 from 2100 to s/off around 0100. Although they were excellent at times, it was hard to copy because of the announcer's very deep voice. IDed as "Radio City, 770 kcs.." (DJ)
- 780 YVOD San Cristobal, VENEZUELA was heard with a fabulous signal on 2/1 from 0545 with an ID as "Ecos del Torbes". (RJL)
- HJZG Cali, COLOMBIA, "Radio El Pais" is now using 30 kws.. (DFG)
- 782 CSB 9 Miramar, PORTUGAL was logged, although unneeded, on MM 2/1 at 0225 with a fair signal. (DJ)
- Magdeburg, EAST GERMANY, "Deutschlandsender" is apparently my AN TA here evenings. (RFS) (EBU claims Burg as the location, Ron. - ed)
- 795 Black Rock, BARBADOS was logged on 2/1 with a tremendous signal from 0514 all the way up to 0546. Taped report sent. What a surprise! QRM was heavy from Bonaire on 800 kcs.. I never thought I'd want a station in the Netherlands Antilles silenced, hi! This was logged on the

- 795 Black Rock, BARBADOS (cont.) Zenith 1000 D as the SX 62 A is out of service. Nice radio. (RJL) Beautiful signals on 1/30, 1/31 & 2/1. On 1/30 with the Churchill funeral around 0500. (RJS)
- 800 PJB Bonaire, NETHERLANDS ANTILLES. Never heard such a signal! Was logged here on 2/1 with S 8-9 signals from 0435 in Spanish and then changing to English at 0530. Beautiful ID taped at 0550: "This is the international sound of ... Caribbean; Trans World Radio." ID again heard at 0600 when their signal was S 9. (RJL)
- ???? An unknown LA was noted here on 2/1 from 0636-0659. Who? (RJS) (Your YSAX of last year maybe? - ed)
- 810 -FEN- Tokyo, JAPAN was logged at 0430 briefly on 1/25 with a detailed weather report and mentioning "Tachikawa Air Base". ID heard with difficulty at 0430: "This is the Far East Network, Tokyo." The time was given and a program of requested popular US music followed. Already have this rare bird QSLed but will send another taped report. (RJL)
- CX 14 Montevideo, URUGUAY, "Radio El Espectador" operates from 0400-0000 with 35 kws.. They are affiliated with CX 18 on 890 kcs., but they do not operate in parallel. (LGB)
- ???? An UnID Spanish station was noted on 1/25 at 0436 with a moderate signal. Any idea who this one is? (RJL) (Most likely WKVM. - ed)
- 812 ???? An unknown LA station was noted around this frequency on 1/3 at 0445. Maybe HJBW early? (RJS)
- 820 HJED Cali, COLOMBIA was heard on SM 1/24 around 0420+. Had a four note car horn IS. WBAP and WFAA were off. (MS)
- 827 Sofia, BULGARIA was heard on 2/2 & 2/3 from 2335-0010. Seemed to be News until 2346 then music until 0000. A woman talked after that. Fair signal on peaks but severe QRM from WCCO and heavy QSB. Country # 69. (E)
- 830 CMCA Havana, CUBA is getting the best of WCCO nightly at 1830 and again at 2000. (MM)
- JOBB Osaka, JAPAN was heard on 1/25 with an S 9 signal after 0500. JOBB is in // with JOIB on 750 kcs. and JOBK on 670 kcs.. Program consists of dramatic presentations, light music, short commentaries and an English language program at 0400. (RJL)
- ???? An UnID LA with tangos etc. was noted even cutting through WCCO's OC late on the AM of 1/2. Too small Argentines are listed. (RFS)
- 836 Beirut, LEBANON sent a card to verify my 11/8 report. Received on 1/19 for my first Asian! (HH)
- 840 4 RK Rockhampton, AUSTRALIA was logged on 12/28 from 0422-0443. Weak to fair signals. WHAS took them out at 0443 when they turned on their carrier. Got off a fairly good report. (HH)
- JOQK Niigata, JAPAN was logged on 2/1 at 0310. Good signal. QRM from an UnID Spanish station starting at 0400. (RJL)
- ZYD 8 Salvador, BRAZIL. This station and PRH 9 were really strong for the first time MM 2/1 with this one dominating. Mostly a talk program logged at 0250. A clear ID as "Radio Excelsior de Bahia" noted at 0300. Taped report sent, and will work on PRH 9! (DJ)
- 850 KICY Nome, ALASKA signs off daily at 0500. (RJS) Noted with the best signal since last season, S 7, at 0400 with weather as "5 below zero here at KICY". A "featured story for tonight" followed on Curtiss Le May. (RJL)
- HJKC Bogota, COLOMBIA was undoubtedly the loud LA noted here on 1/31 and 2/1 after 0520. (RJS) Their s/on came "screaming" in here on 1/25 at 0430 with an S 9 signal. Wow! Already verified. (RJL)
- CX 16 Montevideo, URUGUAY, "Radio Carve" operates from 0455-2300 with a power of 50 kws.. They are affiliated with CX 24 on 1010 kcs., but they do not operate in parallel. (LGB)
- 855 ???? A mystery heterodyne was here on 1/30 after 0500. Too much KOA to get any audio. (RJS)
- 860 XEMO Tijuana, MEXICO is noted at various times during the day and night with religious programming. (PE) (This is the actual location, Paul. Their power is 5000 watts. - ed)

- 863 Yerevan, ARMENIAN SSR was logged fairly well at 2100 on 1/10 in // with other Soviet stations. (RFS)
- 875 TISS San Jose, COSTA RICA, "La Voz del Tropico" sent a v/1 and a picture postcard for my reception of their special 12/25 AN program. The v/s is Juan Bautista Araujo Fernandez (As reported by LBG). Verie # 27 from Costa Rica. (KG)
- 880 PRI 3 Belo Horizonte, BRAZIL must have been the Portuguese station logged here MM 2/1. Very strong at 0355-0401 fade-out, with apparently a political talk. No ID on the hour but PRI 3, "Radio Inconfidencia" is more likely as it is considerably closer and runs more power than the other station listed here, ZYU 33 in Porto Alegre. - 885 ???? A very, very weak signal was heard here on 1/30 with what seemed to be the same program as was being broadcast by WCBS (which was relaying the BBC for the Churchill funeral) was noted right after 0500. (RJS) (Maybe Montserrat, Randy? - ed)
- 890 CX 18 Montevideo, URUGUAY, "Radio Sport" operates from 0500-2200 with a power of 24 kws. See also 810 kcs.. (LBG)
- 926 -RTB- Brussels, BELGIUM was in with a fair signal on 2/1 at 0120 with a program of popular music. (ELK)
- 930 CX 20 Montevideo, URUGUAY, "Radio Monte Carlo" is AN, 7 days, and uses 20 kws. during the day and 10 kws. at night. (LBG)
- 935 Burg, EAST GERMANY, "Deutsche Soldatensender" is generally on top from 1900-1930 s/off. Address anyone? (KG) (Both EBU and Wireless World list this location, Kermit. You might try the Staatliches Rundfunkkomitee as listed in WRTVH, although they probably won't admit the existence of this station. - ed)
- Lvov, UKRAINIAN SSR is in the clear until 2030 s/off after Germany's 1930 s/off. Except see below. Received a v/c from Moscow for my 12/21 reception from 1930-2030. Specifies 935 kcs.. (KG)
- Agadir, MOROCCO has run past 2000 with Ramadan programs lately. Heard on 1/17 at 15 Db over S 9. Reported hopefully. (KG)
- 940 XEQ Mexico City, MEXICO, "Radio Majestic" was heard on 1/25 at 0200, R 5, S 5 with QRM from CBM. Heard an ID at 0240. Who dis? Taped. (SGS) (This is the one, Doc. - ed)
- 960 ZFB 1 Pembroke West, BERMUDA. A mystery station in Bermuda was logged here on MM 2/1 from 0315-0400 peaking at S 5. Noted calypso music and English talk with a slight British accent. ID at 0358 gave specific mention of 960 kcs.. Call given, but not readable under KABL QRM. Nothing listed in DXWW since 9/12. Who is it? (LRS) (This one, Larry. The power is 1000 watts, and their address is Box 652. My 1962 form v/1 was from C. Amritt for M. Sheppard the General Manager. - ed)
- 970 CX 22 Montevideo, URUGUAY, "Radio Universal" operates from 0400-2330 with a power of 1000 watts. (LBG)
- YVLR Maracay, VENEZUELA, "Radio Central" is now officially here with 10 kws., from 990 kcs.. V/1 and Christmas card were received from Hogo Montesinos Castillo, Director. Venezuelan # 43. (KG)
- 971 -WDR- Langenberg, WEST GERMANY verified my 12/22 report via a QSL card. The v/s is not readable. Address is Koln, Germany, Wallraplatz 5. (HH)
- 989 -RIAS- WEST BERLIN sent a v/c and a letter plus several booklets and schedules for my logging of 11/7 from 1815-1900. (KG)
- 995 HCEW 2 Guayaquil, ECUADOR is occasionally noted here during the evening. They sent a nice long letter and pennant for my 12/21 & 12/22 reception. V/s and address as listed before. (HH)

- 1000 WBNB Charlotte Amalie, VIRGIN ISLANDS finally sent a v/1 from John S. Denham, CE for my report of 12/7. Their mailing address is Box 1947, St. Thomas, Virgin Islands, 00802. Has an 0530 s/on. (DJ)
- 1007 -RNE- Malaga, SPAIN must be the weak TA here with a 2005 s/off. (RFS) (The RNE Program Guide lists it as 1915, Ron. - ed)
- 1010 XE.. (...?), MEXICO. I'm beginning to think my XEFM of last issue might be XEDX relaying XESM as Don Erickson heard a 1340 kcs. station with that ID too. (RJS)
- CX 24 Montevideo, URUGUAY, "La Voz del Aire" operates from 0620-2200 with a power of 2.5 kws.. See also 850 kcs.. (LBG)
- 1025 Dobl/Kronstorf, AUSTRIA sent a very nice v/1 (no QSL card !) from the Austrian Radio, Technical Department, P. O. Box 200, Vienna 126. This address differs from the one in WRTVH which I reported to. They mention that they were pleased to learn of my good reception on this frequency, and that last year they didn't receive a single report from the US for this frequency at this time ! Austria #12, and prized above the verie from Vienna on 1475 kcs.. (ELK)

- HIBE Santo Domingo, DOMINICAN REPUBLIC, "Radio Mil" was noted on 12/20 from 0223-0245 with heavy QRM from another UnID LA station. (HH)
- 1187 Szolnok, HUNGARY was noted with a program of popular music on 2/1 from 0034-0040. Fair signal. (ELK)
- 1190 ???? An UnID LA station, with continuous Mexican music and no announcements, was noted on 2/1 AN. Too weak to be XEWK. Who ? (RFS)
- 1195 TICA Puntarenas, COSTA RICA, "Radio Columbia" was logged on 1/6 from 0546-0631. Good copy. (HH)
- 1200 PRB 6 Sao Paulo, BRAZIL was logged here quite strong at times on MM 2/1. Best from 0324-0330 with a woman talking in what might possibly have been Japanese. (They do carry Japanese programs but not at this time according to WRTVH). At 0330 a Portuguese I was given as "Radio ... Sao Paulo." Taped report sent. (DJ) (Dal, I noted them last February at almost this same time, also in Japanese. Never answered. - ec)

- 1270 ???? I'm full of mysteries ! An unknown Spanish station was noted here on 1/31, at 0415 and again at 0452. No IDs then. Who ? Mexican ? (RJS) (Maybe CMJC, Randy ? - ed)
- 1280 CMHM Santa Clara, CUBA was heard on 2/1 with "Reloj Nacional" programs at 0325 but somebody's tone took care of that, hi ! (HMM)
- 1290 HJEB Cienaga, COLOMBIA, "La Voz de Cienaga" is a new ANer here from 1270 kcs. which it announces. (RFS)
- CX 38 Montevideo, URUGUAY, "SODRE" is a new outlet here. They operate with 5 kws.. See also 650 kcs.. (LBG)
- 1295 -BBC- Crowborough, ENGLAND sent the usual BBC card along with a personal letter from Miss V. R. Pressman. She specifically mentions my reception on 232 metres and gives this location. I feel that this is the best way to report to the BBC, i. e. One station at a time, and ask questions which can only be answered by a letter. - 1380 XEKT Tecate, MEXICO. Tecate's finest here for daytime reception. ID on 1/30 at 1803. (RJS)
- 1410 CX 44 Montevideo, URUGUAY, "Radio Austral" operates from 0530-2200. They Use 10 kws.. (LBG)
- 1425 Thule AFB, GREENLAND, "Radio 1425" was logged and taped from 0357-0431. Gave temperature as 21 degrees with a high expected of 30. Country # 27 logged. (LL) Was tentatively logged as the R & R and American English here faintly on 2/1 at 0410. Temperature here was in the high 40's which may have helped reception. - 1505 TIRU ? Liberia, COSTA RICA, "Radio Norte" (Reference DXWW 26 January) I will try for this one again, and to tape an ID, the only sure way. (RJS)
- 1529 VATICAN CITY sent a QSL card signed by Edward J. Lynch, S. J. for my 11/8 reception. (HH)
- 1530 WUPR Utuado, PUERTO RICO was logged on 1/25 from 0430-0500 under "Radio Pueblo" in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic. (KG)
- CX 50 Montevideo, URUGUAY, "Radio Independencia" operates from 0300-2200. Their power is not known, but FBIS lists it as 5 kws.. (LBG) *The 1965 WRTVH says 1200 watts for this one. - ed)
- 1540 ZNS Nassau, BAHAMA ISLANDS was logged on 1/12. A v/l was received signed by H. R. Bettel. Their address is P. O. Box 1347. (JCD)
- 1554 ???? An UnID TA is noted to sign on here at 2300. Who ? (RFS) (Very interesting comments in EBU on this frequency, Ron. They note a Russian station here, and note that announcements of Tallinn, Nogaysk and Moskva have all been heard. Also, it notes that some report a station in Baranovitchi here. Cute huh !? - ed)
- 1560 CV 156 Vichadero, URUGUAY, "Radio Vichadero" is the correct call for this station. It's listed in FBIS as CX 156. (LBG)
- 1562 "Radio Veronica", INTERNATIONAL WATERS sent an answer in less than a week. I sent my November report in January after securing their address. They mentioned that their QSL cards were being printed. I'll count this letter as a verie, card or no card, hi ! (HH)
- 1580 HJAY Galapa, COLOMBIA sent a verie for my 12/21 report. They sent a letter and a pennant. The v/s and address are as listed before. (HH)
- 1594 CSB 4 Lisbon, PORTUGAL, "Emissoras Associados de Lisboa" was logged on 1/18 from 0250-0310. (KG)
- ???? An UnID TA is noted weakly here evenings. Manx ? (RFS)
- 1600 CV 160 San Carlos, URUGUAY, "Radio San Carlos" has replaced the station in Punta del Este here. Their power is around 250 watts. (LBG)

PIRATES "Radio Lambay", operating from a boat in Dublin Bay, is due to start broadcasting soon on 600 kcs.. (WRTVH)

"Radio Invicta" uses the following address: 35 Bouverie Square, Folkestone, Kent, England. They operate from 0200-1400 daily and from 1900-0100 on Saturdays and Sundays. Reports are wanted on the latter programs. They plan to go to 4-6 kws., and are now using 1000 watts. (WRTVH)

PORTUGAL (From John Callarman) "Maria da Paz de Barros Santos, head-international service, Radio Portugal, sent R. P. QSL card verifying my report on 665 kc. after I sent plea that exclusively medium wave DXers in N.R.C. and I.R.C.A. would be 'left out' since there were no medium wave programs directed to North America (re Jack Keene's recent info.) Letter said 'In actual fact your letter is incorrectly addressed since the report refers to a Portuguese broadcast and not to one of those produced by the International Service. Under the circumstances, however, we are sending you one of our own QSL's. IF this is not what you require, you should write again addressing your letter to the Head of the Technical Department, Emissora Nacional de Radiodifusao applying for acknowledgement of a report on the Portuguese transmission." (Thanks, John ! This then looks like the way to get R. P.'s veries. - ed)

NEW ZEALAND (From Maurice J. Cross) "On March the sixth of this year the 43rd. N.Z.B.C. station will start testing. The official opening of the station will be at 7.00 p.m. NZST (2.00 a.m. EST SAME DAY) on Saturday March the 13th and there-after will operate between 5.00 p.m. and 11.00 p.m. NZST (Midnight till 6.00 a.m. EST) daily except Sunday when it will close 30 minutes earlier. This is a commercial station (it will be carrying advertising) and is located at Blenheim using the call of 2 ZE on 1540 kcs. Power is stated to be 2 Kw. but it is thought that this may be an ERP figure not transmitter output as is using a twin full-wave vertical self-supporting antenna (omni-directional).

Maurice also notes that the NZ Radio DX League is planning to issue another revised edition of the "Pacific-Asian Log Book" (PAL) later on this year. Details will be published as soon as they become available. Members of the IRCA will be entitled to a slight reduction in prices. If no price increase is needed, it is expected to cost about 60-65 ¢.
