- 560 YVLX Villa de Cura, VENEZUELA, "Radio Rumbos" was heard on 2/22. It seemed to be // to 770 kcs. with News at 0540. (RJS)
- 600 ???? (...?), JAPAN - A strong station, probably Japanese, was heard here around 0740 on 2/15. Anyone know who or where ? (JW)
- 630 4 QN Townsville, AUSTRALIA finally gave me an Aussie here, the first this season. Talk about Queensland at 0415 on 2/22. (RJS)
- LS 5 Buenos Aires, ARGENTINA was noted very weakly from 0330-0400. Not reportable copy. This on 2/22; hope they're better on 3/8. (JLK)
- 645 ???? On 2/22 this oriental station was NOT // to 655 kcs.. Some have said that it's China, ex-640 kcs.. It did sound Chinese, and there was no IS at 0700. 655 kcs. was very weak, but the programming was totally different. - ???? A SS or PP station was heard on 2/20 from 0335-0350. Very weak signal. Followed at 0440 by a Chinese station, probably Peking, that was cut down by WHAS's s/on. (KGS)
- 855 ???? A mystery station was noted here on 2/22 at 0536; probably SS although I'm not sure. Is the Netherlands Antilles station still on here ? Language ? Had OAX 4 A on 854 kcs. in at 0610 making further reception
