Tallinn has sent a book and business card; hope a QSL follows. No TP DX at-all during my listening times. KNEZ-960 was the only special heard on 1/3/66, as KMEN was AN on 1290, and WREN was SB on 1250. CHSM-1250 try was similar last season. I would like to compile a list of all Mainland Chinese stations that have been heard and identified during this season. I would appreciate any tapes of IDs, time pips. I note that China has been heard on 38 frequencies, according to reports in NRC and DXWW to date, but positive IDs (inc. location) have only been reported for a few (eg., 795 Shanghai, 843 Chiang-Shi). Several of us are also planning to compile a tape of foreign DX that we've received this season - audible ones (ie., not just static). Will be available to all, maybe by summer. British Columbia as Province of the Month stencil is now prepared, and Wisconsin, Kansas, New York and others will be compiled soon. Could I have some tips for these last mentioned, please? The book contains a directory of AM-FM-TV in U.S. and Canada. It lists station personnel, addresses of stations, frequencies, powers, etc.

Here's a ~~list~~ ~~of~~ ~~tips~~ ~~for~~ everyone in the west, once you get past WBZ (which everyone should get easily, naturally). WMEX-1510 might also be possible at some distance, but generally the reception from this state is uncommon. WNAC-680 is sometimes heard at sunrise or sunset in the midwest. Ralph Vatalaro and Howie Modell have sent some tips to supplement those from the other parts of the country, so lets see if we can get some of these.

- 560 WHYN Springfield. Try at sunrise, especially in summer.
- 580 WTAG Worcester. Heard well in the east, but WHP interferes.
- 590 WEEL Boston. AN. WARM causes problems in NY.
- 680 WNAC Boston. Has 0100 s/off with SSB. Heard in the midwest.
- 730 WACE Chicopee. Has a f/c on the 20th at 0030-0045. Strong in daytime over southern New England.
- 850 WHDH Boston. Dave Johnson caught this one in Colo. once. Sometimes in the midwest. On AN on MM!
- 860 WSBS Great Barrington. Howie says it can be heard, within 5 miles of the transmitter!
- 950 WORL Boston. Has Ken Carter's "Golden Oldie Dance Party" to SSB s/off. Try at s/on for WORL, too.
- 1030 WBZ Boston. XEQR is the only hindrance. An easy clear channel. Off MM at 0005.
- 1090 WILD Boston. Try SSS, but WBAL makes it hard.
- 1150 WEDP Boston. Occasionally NSP, but now off MMs. Good at s/on down the east coast, infrequently to Florida.
- 1250 WARE Ware. (Where? Ware!). Try them at s/on (Howie got them in NY).
- 1260 WEZE Boston. Howie says at s/on (MM?), Ralph says most AMs. Off MM only?
- 1270 WSPR Springfield. Loud in the east (RR), but WXYZ interferes.
- 1280 WEIM Fitchburg. WADD blocks it in NY, but should get out all over New England.
- 1300 WJDA Quincy. This daytimer has a strong signal in New England. Anyone else?
- 1310 WORC Worcester. Try for this one around sunset.
- 1330 WCRB Waltham. Might make it out if WEVD/WPDW weak.
- 1390 WPLM Plymouth. Try them at s/on. Heard in Fla. How far west?
- 1400 WALE Fall River. Seems to be the graveyard to escape. Try summer and spring s/on, sometimes early (0400).
- 1410 WOKW Brockton. Close to WPOP, so tough. Try around 0700-0800.
- 1420 WBSM New Bedford. Quite variable in strength. Watch it. Occasionally NSP.
- 1430 WTTT Amherst. Try it under WNJR at s/off time.
- 1440 WAAB Worcester. Loud in the east every night. Sometimes at s/on down the coast. ID's as "Double A."
- 1460 WBET Brockton. Even in Mass., it's under WOKD and WHEC at sunset.
- 1510 WMEX Boston. Loud with R&R. Off MM only at 0000. Try 0515 EST s/on with SSB in the west - during summer when WLAC off and WMEX on at 0415 EST. QSL.
- 1570 WDEW Westfield. Noted in NY with WPEP, Taunton one morning. WDEW varied.
- WYLO Beverly. Has made it to NY.
- 1600 WBOS Brookline. Look under WWRL at sunset.

Here are the sign on and sign off times for daytimers in the Boston area.

- December - s/on at 0715, s/off at 1600
- June - s/on at 0400, s/off at 1915
- Equinox - s/on at 0545, s/off at 1745

These times may also be useful for power and pattern changes, and dawn and dusk fades. Good luck on this state, everybody. It looks like there's real DX in Massachusetts! And thanks for all the tips, everybody.

Doctor Brinkley was a goat gland doctor in Milford, Kansas and operated KFKB there for many years - the old FCC stopped him about 1932 or 3. (and Norman Baker the Cancer Cure Doc of KTNT) from giving medical advice on the air so it was off to Mexico, Brinkley opened XLR (later XERA) and operated in the middle 30's with power so strong (he said 500 kw but it is questioned) that XERA could be heard here during the day in Winter. Doc Baker opened XENT Nuevo Laredo and I believe it finally evolved into the 5 kw on 1550 listed in Broadcasting as XENU - other americans also went south with XEAW, XEPN, XERB, XELO all supper power aimed at US audiences XEAW at one time had 2 stations using the call on the air at the same time, and contrary to belief, by one member at least the USA does not assign the same call to 2 stations at the same time except by error. I've only seen it happen once in 1947, W.WON in Woodsocket, R.I. and Hollywood, Fla. (now WINZ). Hollywood used the call 3 days before the FCC caught their mistake - same city can get same call AM, FM & TV but not a distance of several hundred miles. "Procrastination is the thief of time." After a year I'm finally sending in a Forum report. I'm 16, a junior at Urbana High, and sports editor for the school paper (The Echo). I usually listen with a Hallicrafters S-118 with mechanical filter installed, Heath Q-multiplier connected, along with a Lafayette TM-59A S-meter added. Antennas are a 90' long-wire, 4' loop, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' loop, and a 32' by 8' rectangular loop I'm in the process of finishing. I have heard 48 states and DC definitely, Idaho in the form of KBOI-950 tentatively, while has eluded me completely. The verie situation is pitiful, but with some new report forms I just received I hope to up my total considerably. News around here is that semi-local, WJZ (Decatur, Ill.)-1050 kc/s, has been off its assigned frequency two or three kc/s and has allowed me to receive some new stations on 1050. WJZ has been off freq since Dec. 28th and is still off on the 31st, so look for it on 1047 or 1048 kc/s as it might continue to broadcast off freq. It might do you members with loops well to connect the long wires you have to a ground wire. I have found that by draping this wire (the antenna and ground wires have been hooked in to one continuous link) over my loop antenna in different positions I can produce a much deeper null than is ordinarily produced. I can null stations well over 30/39 to S-1 or so. Experiment and see if it works for you. JO?? (?), JAPAN - I had NHK pips here at 0900 on 12/19. I haven't been able to hear this one at s/off. Can anyone help on the ID and location of this one? (AWP)
- 600 ???? An oriental was noted here on MM 12/27 at 0530. Poor, and u/ CFQC. China? (BWi)
- 625 TIRICA San Jose, COSTA RICA was first logged 12/28 from 2210-2305 with US and SS music, and "La Voz de la Victor" IDs between records. (MS)
- 635 Pyongyang, NORTH KOREA was poor u/ various "slop-overs"; apparently NOT // 655 at 0530 on 12/27. (BWi)
- 640 ???? I had an UnID SS station here MM 12/27 from 0715-0735. Could CMQ be in this late? (LBG)
- 645 Radio Peking, CHINA was apparently the station here at 0530 on 12/27. It was NOT // 635 or 655 at any rate. (BWi)
- 650 YVQQ Puerto la Cruz, VENEZUELA was in weakly on 12/17 at 2130. (AWP)
???? A FF signal was in from 0136-0145:15 on 12/27 o/ HJKH. They played American music with some songs in FF and some in EE. I had a short ID with "Radio" in it at 0145 and then it apparently left the air at 0145:15. (BWo) (Bill, I assume that this unsigned report was from you. Nothing here on this one. New frequency for Guadeloupe? - ed)
- 660 KFAR Fairbanks, ALASKA was noted in strong 12/17 at 0044. (AWP)
- 695 ???? An UnID SS station was here the evenings of 1/1 through 1/3. (MS)
- 700 Montego Bay, JAMAICA was logged in // with 750 on 1/3 at 0446. (RJS)
TIHB San Jose, COSTA RICA had an excellent signal atop WLW on 12/27 at 2250 with an ID as "Radio Reloj, numero uno en Costa Rica." (LBG)
- 735 ???? Perhaps Macau was the strong oriental here 12/27 at 0614. I can't seem to get this one at ID time. (LBG)
- 750 YNX Managua, NICARAGUA, Estacion X, was heard 12/27 at 2303 ID. Fair for a brief period. (RJS)
- 760 XEZZ Tonalá, MEXICO was fair o/u two American stations with "Radio XEZZ" IDs at 0730 on 12/19. (BWi)
- 770 YVQQ Puerto la Cruz, VENEZUELA was heard at s/on 1/3 at 0450. WABC lost. (RJS)
???? There's an SS station generally on top of WABC around 0400 onwards here. Mentioned "Colombia ... Radio Continente ..." at 0528 on 12/28, followed by what was apparently an ad with a Barcelona address. Radio Puerto la Cruz? (BWi) (Sounds likely, Bill - ed)
- 780 JOIU Muroran, JAPAN was quite strong at s/off at 1000 on 12/21. It's only 1 kw., but it was very clear with a definite ID. (AWP)
???? My hopefully Philippine station was in fairly well 12/27 from 1006-1025 playing pure R&R with announcements in EE. At one point the announcer mentioned Okinawa, I believe, but KSDT broadcasts in JJ according to WRTVH. (LBG)
- 785 Black Rock, BARBADOS was noted with a definite ID at 2300 on 12/17. Reported, for a new country. (AWP) Must have been the OC here, but with no modulation 12/29 in the early AM. When are they on with programming? (MS) (WRTVH says 0458-2215, except Sat. -2305, but note the above - ed)
.... Pyongyang, NORTH KOREA is the oriental listed here u/ the EE station to 0505 on 12/27. Fair on top afterwards and NOT // 655 or 850. (BWi)
???? An EE station was noted here with an ad for Andrews Liver Sauce at 0445 on 12/27 followed by orchestral music. QRM from Pyongyang above. Hoping for Barbados. Anyone know who? (BWi)
- 795 ???? An oriental was noted here poorly at 0530 on 12/27 not // 655, 670 (NHK-1. 785, 1090 or 1370 (NHK-2). Peking? (BWi)
- 800 PJB Bonaire, NETH. ANTILLES comes in occasionally. They had a booming signal 12/17 at 0230. Not required. (LM)

- 800 ???? The SS station here at sunrise is probably XELO. (MS)
- 810 WKVM San Juan, PUERTO RICO was noted 12/27 at 0530 or so with a clear slowly read call as "W-K-V-M" and many "Radio Reporte/Deporte/Rocorte" IDs. It sounds like "Deporte" at times, then "Reporte"; anything definite? (dS) Was heard 12/29 at 0427 with the SSB u/ WGY. (RJS)
- 828 YNOL Managua, NICARAGUA was in well at 2100 on 12/28 with call letters, slogan and two descending chimes. Poor after 1820. (sic) (BWi)
- 830 Radio Peking, CHINA was heard with pips u/ JOBB's s/off. This is not definite, however, as it may have been "slop-over" from 835 as suggested by LBG. (AWP)
- JOBB Osaka, JAPAN has been heard many mornings at 1000 s/off now that dawn is so late. (AWP)
- ???? I heard a language similar to SS (Not FF) on 12/28 from 2013-2023 atop WCCO. Perhaps it was XELA broadcasting in a peculiar SS dialect. (L)
- 834 Belize, BRIT. HONDURAS was logged 12/27 in beautifully at 2010. I listened all evening without the crystal, hi! It was way o/ WCCO most of the time. (MS)
- 840 YVMY Barquisimeto, VENEZUELA was logged 12/24 at 0506 o/ WHAS and evrything else. (dS)
- 4RK Rockhampton, AUSTRALIA was in pretty poorly from 0410 to WHAS's s/on at 0459 on 12/21, but I got a reportable log anyway. I didn't expect to hear them in the mid-Winter. (BWi)
- KEFG Celaya, MEXICO was very strong at 0803 on 12/27 and at 0757 on 11/29. (L)
- ???? There were two SS stations here at 0445 on 12/18 with the IDs on one being "Radio Presidente ..." Conditions were pretty poor so maybe it was Radio Bandeirantes. Does anyone know anything further? (BWi)
- 850 Pyongyang, NORTH KOREA was so strong at 1020 on 12/17 that it all but covered up KOA! (AWP)
- CMKC Santiago, CUBA was probably the Cuban heard at 0655 on 12/19 and at 0422 on 12/28 with "... en La Habana, Cuba, territorio libre de America". On top before XEUS's s/on. (BWi)
- XEUS Hermosillo, MEXICO - A Mexican was on top here at 0830 on 12/29 and it IDed as XE?S or XE?F. Considering the powere XEUS at 1 kw. is more likely than XEZF at 250 watts. Also, it apparently "s/on" by going straight into SS songs at 0457 on 12/28 without any voice or NA. (BWi)
- ???? Two UnID SS stations were noted 12/24 at 0457, too weak to ID. My wish to Santa says that CX16 was on top with talks; probably of a religious nature. (dS)
- 870 ???? An UnID JJ station was noted here at 0345 on 12/17 giving EE lessons. The signal was poor and giving way to WWL. Could this have been JOLB in Fukuoka? (LM) (It's the only JJ listed here - ed)
- KAIM Honolulu, HAWAII was heard here 12/18 at 2255 for a few minutes. Not enough for a report and suffering extreme QSB. On 12/19 at 0930 they had an excellent signal and were broadcasting in JJ, I believe. No time to copy due to my employment, but it would appear that the early AM is the best bet here. (LM)
- 875 TI?? (?), COSTA RICA is a new member of "Cadena Monumental", so apparently TISS, La Voz del Tropico, is now extinct. No call was heard although the signal was quite good 12/27 from 2259-0002 on 12/28. From 2335-2357 I listened to a program in EE presented by Canadian Pacific Airline directed to listeners in Guatemala City and San Jose (obviously intended for use on stations in both cities). At 0002 I believe the station signed off; frequencies were given including 1050 (listed as "Radio Monumental" in Puntarenas) and "ahora 1000 kcs." (indicating a new outlet) which is now listed as TICEC, Radio Cima, in San Ramon. (LBG)
- 879 XETZ (?), MEXICO remains UnID positively although I'm pretty sure of the call. It signed on 12/29 at 0802 with a record of a chorus repeating the word "felicidades". Then the announcer IDed the station as "Radio Felicidades, 88 de su radio" and gave a location that sounded like

- 879 KETZ (cont.) "Lavelle". Time was CST. Any listing, Ed? (LBG) (Nothing - ed)
- 885 Plymouth, MONTERRAT was noted weak (as always) 1/3 at 0510. (RJS)
- 890 YVLW Valencia, VENEZUELA was noted with an ID at 0525 on 1/3. (RJS)
- 891 Radio Peking, CHINA is believed to be the station here, drifting from 890. I heard it at 0643 on 12/27. (LBG)
- 900 PJAG Aruba, NETH. ANTILLES, Radio Victoria, was noted in SS with an ID, tone and fanfare at 0530 on 12/24; beautifully on top the frequency. (dS)
- 940 XEQ Mexico City, MEXICO was noted 12/29 at 0235. No CBM. (MS)
- 950 JOKR Tokyo, JAPAN was good at 0430 on 12/27 o/ QRM, mentioning "Tokyo" a few times. How do you get a report on these without a recorder? (BWi)
- 965 YNLU Managua, NICARAGUA was logged for the first time from 2325-2355 with talk, SS music, and a singing ID ending with "Managua". On tape. I wish I could figure out the rest of that ID. Pretty good signal at times. Noted later in the evening a bit before 0100. (MS)
- 1000 TICEC San Ramon, COSTA RICA, Radio Cima, may be extinct as Radio Monumental on 875 (which see) mentioned a new network station here. (LBG)
- 1015 ???? An UnID LA was here AN 12/29 and 1/2. Too weak for an ID; HOU? (RJS)
- 1020 ZCC Nuku'alofa, TONGA - Mr. David Hill, Technician, said my report was not enough for a positive verie. I'll try again. Address is PO Box 36. The letter was very friendly; they indicated that Tongan time is GMT+13. (JC)
- YVMK Maracaibo, VENEZUELA, Radio Calendario, was in almost all MM 12/27 with a strong S7 signal. (ES)
- Radio Peking, CHINA was tentatively logged here 12/17 at 0200 mixing with KDKA. No reports are forwarded to any Communist country from my address without a lot of red tape, hi! (LM)
- 1034 Tallinn, ESTONIAN SSR finally got past WHO at 0000 on 12/17. Reported. (L)
- 1035 HOS21 Panama City, PANAMA, Radio Union, really surprised me with a very readable signal MM 12/27 from 0620-0637 with a newscast. I sent a taped report. (LBG)
- 4VEF Cap Haitien, HAITI was fair a quarter hour before sunset at 1950 on 12/20. (BWi)
- 1040 PRG2 Sao Paulo, BRAZIL, Radio Tupi, was heard the best ever on 1/2 from 0155-0230. (RJS)
- KHVH Honolulu, HAWAII came in briefly 12/26 at 0155 but WHO is too strong here to try for a report. My first log of KHVH; generally Radio Peking booms in later on. (LM) (Try Sunday morning with WHO off, Len - ed)
- 1042 ???? An UnID station was here hetting PRG2 at 0225 on 1/2. (RJS)
- 1043 Dresden, EAST GERMANY is presumed to be the one I heard here weakly at 2315 on 12/17. (AWP)
- 1090 XERB Rosarito, MEXICO, my third Mexican, was heard 12/26 from 0245-0300 s/off; QRM from KING. Their address is Box 1190, San Diego 12, California. (JK)
- ???? An oriental was noted here poorly u/ an OC at 0510 on MM 12/27. It was not // 1370 (NHK-2) or 670 (NHK-1). Are all NHK-1 stations in //? (BWi)
- 1100 Shansi, CHINA is the location given by WMWG for the outlet which was heard in // to 835 at 0745 on MM 12/20. Fair signals. (BWi) (The latest FBIS also lists Chungyang - ed)
- 1115 YNC Leon, NICARAGUA was heard with "en Nicaragua" on 1/1 at 0453. Were they AN for New Years? (RJS) (Randy, have you heard any calls on this one? I'm still confused by the identification of this one - ed)
- 1120 HOF4 David, PANAMA, Onda Popular, was logged tentatively only at s/on 1/3 at 0456 with an anthem. I thought I caught an "Onda Popular" and a couple of mentions of Panama. (RJS)
- 1140 A dial tone jammer is noted here often. (MS) (This is Fidel's answer to WMIE in Miami, Mike - ed)
- ???? An UnID LA was noted here on 1/3 at 0443. Possibly this was a s/on. Venezuelan? (RJS)
- 1165V Radio Americas, SWAN ISLAND is a regular here every night. (MS)
- 1170 ???? An UnID LA was here 1/3 at 0423, but it was wiped out by WWVA's s/on. Too early for Puerto Rico? (RJS)

- 1178 Horby, SWEDEN is presumed to have been the identity of the strong carrier (no audio) heard here 12/16 at 2300. (AWP)
- 1205 Bordeaux, FRANCE was noted MM 12/27 with an excellent signal. Do they accept tape reports? (ES) (I should think they would - ed)
- 1235 ZBM1 Hamilton, BERMUDA sent a postcard QSL for my 10/19 reception. The v/s is John Foster, Programme Director. Country #13 QSLed. (JO)
- 1370 WIVV Vieques, PUERTO RICO is heard most any MM between 0430 s/on and 0500 WSPD s/on; even through WSPD's OC. A report was sent for 12/2 and the verie was received 12/23; included a v/1 and religious literature. Several addresses were given in the material but Vieques Island, Puerto Rico, 00765 should be fine. The v/s is Rev. Donald D. Luttrell, Director. US stamps were used; 8c airmail is sufficient. (MS)
- JOKD Kitami and JORB in Kochi, JAPAN, the NHK-2 synchronized stations, were in well with EE lessons from 0515-0545 on MM 12/20. (BWi)
- 1457 Clevedon, ENGLAND was logged MM 12/27 from 0145-0200. Not too strong, but readable. (ES)
- 1466 3AM2 Monte Carlo, MONACO was logged 12/27 from 0100-0200 with an S9 signal; in FF. Report sent. (ES)
- 1470 XESM Mexico City, MEXICO was in good with US R&R on 12/27. It's loud on the East Coast. (ES)
- 1520 TGDX Guatemala City, GUATEMALA was probably the SS station mentioning "... de Guatemala" at 0530 on 12/27, followed by marimba music. The time zone was CST. I sent a taped tentative report although no ID was heard. (LBG)
- JO?? (?), JAPAN - The NHK-2 synchronized stations were noted in // to 1370 on MM 12/20. Poor signals. (BWi)
- 1523 ???? There was a fairly strong carrier here 12/27 at 0607. I thought that it might have been the new Chinese station, but by around 0700 it was gone. (LBG)
- 1525 TIEEAW Turrialba, COSTA RICA had a terrific signal MM 12/27 from 0541 to past 0700 with frequent IDs as "Radio Turrialba". I sent them a taped report. (LBG)
- 1550 XE?? (?), MEXICO was on top here with "Radio Television" slogans at 0727 and 0740 on 12/19. Anyone know who this was? (BWi)
- 1560 ???? An UnID SS station was noted here very loud, S8 - even with XERF, on 1/1 at 0505. Mexican? (RJS)
- 1575 ???? There was an UnID SS station weak here 12/27 at 0632. (LBG)

"PIRATES"

Radio Scotland, "All for you on 242", 1240 kcs., 50 kws., on the converted lightship "Comet", came on the air on 1/1. Their sked is 0100-1430 and 1730-2100. Poor reception here owing to the fact that the French network is being QRMed. (KB)

Radio 270 will be the new name for Radio Yorkshire. The latter name is owned by a Bradford firm which has potential commercial interests in the U. K., and they threatened an injunction. (KB)

The Postmaster-General has warned stations on forts - Radio 390, Radio Essex, and Radio Tower - that they are within territorial limits and jurisdiction, and are liable to prosecution under the Wireless Telegraphy Act - 100 pounds fine, 3 months in prison, and confiscation of the apparatus. Radio 390 answered by asking its listeners to write to the PMG if they wanted the programs to stay on the air! (KB)
