Well, October 1 was the beginning date for an entirely new DX "career" for this kid. Taking advantage of the experience gained from five years' DX in the southern part of California, I decided that for once I would do something correctly from the start. Therefore, a set of rules to adhere to in hopes that the number of veries coming in will equal the number of reports going out. I'm trying to obtain and send the most accurate reports possible (despite not having a tape recorder), being prompt with getting them in the mail, and including return postage with every report. I make a carbon copy of each report sent out; this serves as a log entry as well as a valuable reference in case a follow-up report is necessary. I include the following info when sending a report: frequency of station, my location, date and time of DX (in station's time zone), my equipment, local weather, reception, programs heard. Veries are in from KFI (v/1) and CBK KIRO WCCO KOA WSM WHAS WWL WCBS WLW CBR KMOX KSL (all v/q). Reports out to WGN KOB WHO KEX CKWX WBZ KDKA WOAI WCAU KGA. As you might guess, I'm trying to nail down all the 50 kw'ers first. The following are excerpts from an article which appeared in the Nov 7 San Francisco CHRONICLE: "The newest anti-hero of California's hippy underground is the only candidate for governor who considers the election just a primary...According to Wolfman Jack, the election between Edmund G. Brown and Ronald Reagan will only settle one question: who will run against the Wolfman on his own election day, December 8. The Wolfman is a radio personality with a capital P. His voice is a rasp of almost painful intensity, and is carried over the airwaves by XERB, a pirate radio station operating out of Baja California and neatly out of the clutches and jurisdiction of the FCC. With a transmitter capable of turning out an effective power of 150 kw, XERB entertains not only the underground audience of southern Calif. but is heard clearly in Idaho, Nevada, Oregon, Alaska, Hawaii and - according to mail received by the station - in the Solomon Islands...Prior to the coming of the Wolfman last June, XERB was an unnoticed voice carrying its race results, fundamentalist preachers and hard rhythm and blues to what it described as the largest Negro listening audience [in the] West. It still has the race results, some of the preachers and all of the rhythm and blues. But it also has Wolfman Jack, and he may be the next governor."

I think they gave an address, but a bit of static blocked it out. New country here!(DB)(PO Box 271, Paramaribo is the address, Delwayne, and power is 50 kw.-RJS) Was heard on 11/6 at 2232 s/off w/fair signal. (RC) Heard on 11/2 and 11/3 from 2200-2230 s/off with previously noted Brahm's Lullabye and anthem. (BN) Possibly heard 11/11-12 1800-1900 in SS, Dutch and EE, but not clear enough for a positive ID.(BAP) (I'm glad to see everybody is padding his country-heard list with this one, but no veries received yet. Hopefully soon!!-RJS)

- 910 HRVS Honduras, Tegucigalpa, "Radio Catolica, La Voz de Suyapa" had very good signals at 0458 s/on 11/14. Opening program is "borado Ranchero". Some Latin QRM. (JAC)
- 965 YNLU Nicaragua, Managua, in with good signal and what sounded like a political talk on 11/5 at 2240. (LC)

- 1310 XEBP Mexico, Torreon, Coah., heard 9/20 at 0627-0631 but weak! (DB)
- 1375 ..... St. Pierre and Miquelon, Am almost positive that this was the outlet I heard w/fair signals 0523-0535 11/7. Doubt that it could have been USSR-1376 because I heard "Wheels" and other Western-oriented music, and I think the language was FF. Will send a tentative. (AWP)

- 1480 XEJET Mexico, Monterrey, NL, heard 9/19 w/0300 s/off. (DB)
- 1480 XEPR Mexico, Poza Rica, Ver., heard 9/19 u/XEJET w/0300-0305 s/off (DB)
- 1503 HJBV Colombia, Turbaco, "Radio Caloa" was noted here again at 2340 on 11/12. Only a fair signal - apparently they're drifting all over the place. (ELK)
- 1515 HJLQ Colombia, Barranquilla "R. Minuto" heard 10/3 at 0353-0404+, very strong ID. (DB)

- 1560 XEVIP Mexico, Mexico, DF, heard with strong EE signal and frequent ads on 10/25 AN. (BN)
- 1570 XERF Mexico, Ciudad Juana, Coah., strong when Canadians are off (0100-0400) with Wolfman Jack and his great record offer. (PMZ)

- 645 SS here at 2245 on 11/5. (LC) (Likely HOS22-Panama City, "R. Mia"-RJS)
- 650 Carrier heard here on 11/13 at 0300 with traces of audio. Hoping for KORL. (RC)

Due to the abundance of UnID tips this time, I thought I'd allnt a whole section to them this time. The ID's/info I've given above is NOT to be taken as a positive logging. I must stress that. This column is to help you ID your mystery stations. If you're new to foreign DXing, don't worry about submitting a list of unID's, because all DXers do when they start. The only solution to the problem is to listen to the SS stations and practice "slogan recognition". Actually, I find it very interesting and challenging to ID a new LA station!!
