"Hi gang!" A late "Merry Christmas" to everybody. An early "Happy New Year" too! Next year I'm going to hear my three-thousandth BCB Station. Would you believe twelve-hundredth? (600 more to go.) Art Peterson: Thanks for the info on AP and AL. Paul Lotsof: KRNO and KPPC are 49 miles apart vs. 51 for WFRC and WWGO. Local KOWN and KPAL are 55 miles apart. A local member asked me to tell about about TV DX, so here goes: To qualify myself as an exxpert-of-sorts, I've heard all 12 "local" stns, plus 8 Texas, 3 Montana, 2 Idaho, 2 Oklahoma, 1 Washington, 1 Kansas, 1 Nebraska, 1 Mexxico City, and 1 Nuevo Leon. When does TV DX come in? Well, one can't really predict, although hot and clear days usually are good in the summer. In the winter, foggy nights have given much good DX. Of course, there are exxceptions, so every day should be checked. How does one recognize TV DX? In my case, the Los Angeles and Santa Barabara, 120 and 190 miles away, respectively, disappear or noticeably decrease in strength. Accompanying the decrease, horizontal bars, alternating black and and about an inch in width, show up.. A low whine or whistle appears in the audio also. What equipment is needed? Nothing spectaculuar, just an average TV set, and an average TV antenna. A tape recorder helps to catch phrases missed during copying. A camara or sketch can catch the video identifications. Which channels are best? Try the lower channels first. The reason is in the division of the channels; channels 2 through 6 are 54-88 Mc/s, 7 through 13 are 174-216 Mc/s, 14 through 83 are 470 - 890 Mc/s. Distance: Expect 800 to 1300 miles. Guess that's it. "73's and Goodwin DXing" (hi, hi, hi, hi, hi, hi, hi)
