Hi DXers! Well, time for another report. My hopes were rewarded, because WBTS, 1 kw in Alabama varied. My best so far. Last Dec. ('65), I heard WGNE test with a beautiful signal, (they're 500 watts in Fla.) I didn't report! I'm still kicking myself for it! I'm starting to pick out stations which verify from all DXMs, from 3/5/66 to present. If I don't get much response, I can use the list for myself, but I hope someone will find it useful. What John Hoogerheide said about DXR reports in 11/26 PST DXR is true and helpful, but to me, even if no technical info is given, the mere fact that the station was heard near my area is helpful, because I can tune to the frequency at the specified time and be pretty sure of hearing the station. This has worked several times for me. I'm not going to leave out an extraordinary catch if there's no s/on time or something. I did this a couple of times this week in the DXR. That's about it for this week. Auf Weider Sehen! Farvel! Goodbye! 73 etc. (I think that JWH would agree that special catches should indeed appear in the DXR, but notes as to type of pgm or format (e.g., rr, cw, etc.)--anything to help ID the station, should be included. mbn)

Admittedly DX conditions seem to be getting poorer, but a lot of people who are DXing aren't reporting to the Roundups and DXWW. 37 copies of the WRTH were ordered this year at discount prices. Phil Meidell, a "black list" of non-verifiers could do more harm than good. For one thing, I doubt any station is a perpetual non-verifier over the years. Even HJED has been known to send QSL cards, hi. Also, there is a risk of black-listing stations that do verify good reports but have not replied in one or two instances. Perhaps a better idea would be a list of reluctant verifiers, with a criterion that at least 3 good reports from different DXers have gone unanswered recently. Such a list might prove useful to expense- and time-conscious members. Thanks for the call, Ed, and "Radio Colossal" info. Good DX.

Following dan Sheedy's line on an interesting topic, my receiver is a HQ-129X which has undergone quite a bit of modification. Currently using only one mechanical filter at the moment, however I have 2 Lafayette filters in the drawer and will soon be putting them in. I removed the SW coils and made it a ECB only set for better access and component re-routing. Besides anything I need to hear on SW can be heard on my "loaner" S-38, hi. The RF, mixer and 2 of the 3IF tubes have been type-changed. All in all I feel the HQ-129X makes an excellent "test bed" for some serious rcvr development work. I had the pleasure of visiting, by coincidence it would seem, Watertown, Massachusetts on Dec. 30th. I read recently that Radio Americas was broadcasting from a secret location somewhere in Watertown. Well, as experienced people who work in the broadcasting industry know, the Nems-Clarke FIM-135 Field Intensity Meter (with 10 microvolt sensitivity) is unparalleled in portable equipment for determining intensity and direction of radio signals; it is used to maintain Directional Antenna systems at radio stations. I might here mention that I was unable to detect the slightest trace of any radio signal emanating from the Watertown Disposal Yard with any of the equipment I used. So it would seem that the recent report in IRCA is in error, nevertheless I continue to hear signals from Radio Americas nightly and on my loop they DF from the south, not the north and west as would be expected. - 1180 Florida, Marathon, VOA in SS with surprising EE announcement "Calling CQ, calling CQ, calling all hams in Latin America". Fair strength, 2130, 1/1, reported. (Vietmayer, Cal.)
- 1210 Hawaii, Honolulu excellent at 0432 s/off (no anthem) 1/7. (Northam,Ore) UFO, from 0335 on with fair signals, probably JOQR since KZOO supposed to s/off 0300. (Wilson, B.C.)
- 1370 Colombia/DU?/Puerto Rico?/Japan, Bogota, HJKX, undoubtedly the SS with near continuous music on 1/9 at 0408 tune-in. No JOKD until 0425 (over 2 hrs. late.
