- 890 Algeria, Algiers, Algiers II heard u/WLS 1/2 at 1856½. Dakar-type program. Haiti, Gordon Nelson tells me that a new outlet with 2500 watts has a 0530 MM s/on. (Vatalaro, Mass-last 2 items)
- 899 Lesotho, Reportedly testing irregularly w/2 kw transmitter (later to be 10 kw) at 2330, 0215, 1100. (Ginbey/S. Africa/Sweden Calling DXers/NRC)
- 900 Venezuela, Maracaibo, YVMD, "R. Mara" heard 1/9 at 0500. Ex-1150. Powerful signal, listed 1 kw power. (Nelson, Mass./NRC IDXD)
- 935 Morocco, Agadir, -RTM- heard o/CBM and WLNH on 12/27 from 1700-1800. Taped report sent (1725-1739). (Vatalaro, Mass.)
- 940 Hawaii, Waipahu, KAHU easiest Hawaii nightly after 0300 with country-and-western music. (Hoogerheide, Ore.)
- 975 Costa Rica, San Jose, TIRS was probably the SS giving TC's as CST 0426 on MM 1/16. (Godwin, Cal)
- 1000 Nicaragua, Managua, YNY heard on 1/13 and 1/14 at 2100-2300. Regular "Radio Mil" ID's but with Managua hitched onto it. (Vatalaro, Mass.)
Virgin Islands, Charlotte Amalie, WBNB heard s/on at 0500½ on 1/9. EE ID's then right on to march music program. (Vatalaro, Mass.)
UnID, S/on at 0458 1/9. UnIDed NA. Taped, hope to see Gordon soon, hi! (Vatalaro, Mass) (Ralph, probably YVOA-San Cristobal, La Voz del Fachira)
- 1015 Colombia, Barranquilla, HJAI checked in 1/9 at 2245 with rock music and ID as "Radio Quince". Did they change slogan from "Kalamary"? (Hartman, Wisc.)
- 1025 Costa Rica, San Jose, TIAC heard 1/9 w/s/off at 2310. (Hartman, Wisc.)
- 1040 Honduras, Tegucigalpa, HRVH "Radio Mil" finally got clear "Radio Mil" ID out of this one 0056 1/13 after several nights of hearing what sounded like "Radio Centromil" after nearly every record--usually strong most nights from 2300-0100 s/off. Country #30. What's their power? (Sullivan, NY)
- 1045 UnID SS heard 1/9 between 2230-2315 w/SS music & reg. programming. (Hartman)
- 1120 UnID SS at 0510 MM 1/16, probably HJ or YV. (Godwin, Calif.)
- 1160 Peru, UnID s/on with NA at 0601 MM 1/16, too weak to ID, unfortunately. (Godwin, Cal.) (4 OAX.. listed w/1 kw or over, good freq.-RJS)
- 1175 Costa Rica, San Jose, TICA "Radio Columbia" loud and clear 2130-2330 1/15 with pop mx and time checks (often to the second) accompanied by a gong after each record. // to TILX-725. 500th station logged!! (Sullivan, NY)
- 1187 International Waters, Radio Caroline South very good on 1/5 with hit mx and announcement: "Caroline-for sounds galore". Easily separable here from WQWO. (Calkin, N.B.)
- 1214 Albania, Radio Tirana with tremendous signal here nightly during the first week of '67. Unidentified languages before and after 0000 with 6-note IS and clear ID given at 0000 EST. Odd I hadn't caught this one before. (Calkin)
- 1223 UnID station up and very good on 1/6 at 1746-1810+ with choir singing and operatic music. Missed the language on the brief announcements. Sweden? Or did I see an RNE station here??? What is best time to take a logging on Sweden if this was RNE? (Calkin, N.B.) (RNE has 0030 s/on at last report, don't know s/off however-RJS)

- 1286 Czechoslovakia, CSI, Prague with excellent signals 1/6 with English HIT PARADE SHOW FROM 1742 TUNE*IN TO 1800 WHEN ID given in SS. Hits slightly stale. (Calkin, N.B.) (My caps there, sorry for error-RS)
- 1295 St. Maarten, Philipsburg. ID of PJD2 heard weakly w/much QRN and QRM from unID SS 2130 1/14. Country #31. (Sullivan, N.Y.)
UnID SS, heard 2130-2303 1/13, 1/14 around 2130. Fading and mucho QRN most of the time. SS dialog 2200-2300. What seemed to be a long closing anct at 2300 pretty well covered up, lively instrumental mx and then s/off at 2303. Only SS listed is HOS23, but as Panama is on EST, s/off was 11:03 PM local time which doesn't seem too likely. Loop says east of Panama. (Sullivan, N.Y.) (S/off time is not conclusive, I'd say likely HOS23-RJS)
- 1325 Aruba, PJA-10 with full ID in SS at 2204 1/8. Good signals and have reported hopefully. (Calkin, N.B.)
- 1340 Colombia, Barranquilla, HJ(FA?) Cadena Radial de Caribe, new station here since 12/20, QTH is Apartado Aereo 276. (Silvera/Jamaica/NRC IDXD)
- Mexico, Mexicli, BCN, XEMA in with good signals 0337-0400 s/off, IDing as "doble-A" MM 1/16. Many commercials. KIST was strong, but looped. (Godwin)
- 1376 France, Lille I very good as usual 1915 with light dance music 1/5. (Calkin)
- 1380 Dominican Republic, R. Horizonte heard here is D.R. not Venezuela. Location is Santo Domingo. Still testing, calls unknown. (Silvera/Jamaica/NRC IDXD)
- 1395 Dominican Republic, HIBN, R. Puerto Plata here from 1450. (Silvera/Jam./NRC)
- 1410 Mexico, Mexico, DF, XEBS on RS at 0330 1/2 behind WING. (Hoogerheide, Ore)
- 1420 Colombia, Cartagena, HJAP, R. Bahia here, ex-1430. (Silvera/NRC IDXD)
- 1430 Colombia, Riohacha, HJBZ, Ondas del Riohacha here from 1440/1445. (NRC/IDXD)
- 1470 Mexico, Tijuana, BCN, XEBBC on RS at 0145 very loud. Announcements as "Radio Cadena Nacional de Tijuana". (Hoogerheide, Ore.)
- Mexico, Mexico, DF, XESM had nice signal 1/9 at 0218. (Vatalaro, Mass)
- 1490 Hawaii, Lihue, KTOH w/pop music at 0445 1/2. Alone on freq, good signal. (Hoogerheide, Oregon)
- 1529 Vatican City, Latin transmission at 1620, "Laudeteur Jesus Christus" IS end into Italian I think at 1630. Good signals daily and separable from WCKY easily. (Calkin, N.B.)
- 1534V Windward Islands, station here appears to be 100 watts in Chateaubelair according to WRTVH Summer Supplement, apparently the St. Vincent station shown on 1515 in 1966 Handbook. (Nelson/NRC IDXD)
- 1540 Bahamas, Nassau, ZNS nice signal killing WPIRR on 1/7 from 1813-1830. Taped. (Vatalaro, Mass.)
- 1550 Australia, Emerald, Queensland, 400 in with ABC ID and IS MM 1/16 at 0500 atop CBE. (Godwin, Cal.)
- 1562 Cuba, Cardenas, CMGB heard weakly on 1/9 at 0238. (Vatalaro)
- 1323 UnID SS here nightly, particularly strong at 2200 1/8. Suspect a Colombian but have never seen one reported. Who is it? Always seems to fade when I might get an ID. (Calkin, N.B.) (No idea, sorry this out of order-RJS)
