From the 2/27 issue of BROADCASTING & an AP Report 193,::

It was learned in Washington that US government officials are concerned over the construction of six powerful new radio stations in Cuba. The concern is over the interference they will cause to broadcasting in the US. The first of the six stations is already on the air at San German near Holquin. The station, using 150kw, is operating on 600 kc/s which is a U.S. frequency with 24 stns using 5kw or less. FCC officials say they can do nothing about the situation. The Cubans have ignored its provisions under the Castro regime. Broadcasts from this operation will have a "substantial impact" on the nighttime skywaves on at least 15 stations in the U.S. Another active tx also nr Holquin and operating with 50kw is said to be a former 1kw stn on 670 kc/s. 2 active tx's are reportedly operating in Colon, with 30kw and Pinar del Rio also with 30kw. US officials have no evidence these stns are in operation. Cuba is known to have purchased 6 high-power tx's from Czechoslovakia th that are being installed by Czech engineers.
