At Los Angeles last August, most of the members present signed a petition to change the present method of selecting convention sites. Currently, the members at one convention choose the site for the next. A Bylaws amendment has been approved by the Board that would change the wording of Article X to the following:

The general club membership shall select the convention site on the basis of bids submitted by those wishing to host it through a special election to be held six months prior to the convention date (the fourth weekend in August). All bids must be submitted to the Board of Directors for approval prior to the special election.

In order to become enacted, this amendment must be approved by the membership in a special election to be conducted soon. In the meantime, the site for 1969 is Chicago and the new procedure would not become effective until 1970.

The proposal that would have authorized the club to borrow money was loosely worded, and a revised proposal will be submitted. The terms of the borrowing were to be: maximum amount - \$150.00; interest free; and due and payable only at such time as the club no longer needs the funds, in the opinion of the Secretary-Treasurer.

It should be emphasized that the club needs a certain amount of working capital to be able to buy supplies in large quantities (including mastheads) and to keep a supply of various denominations of stamps on hand. Also, the club has participated in various new projects that have tied up money (achievement certificates, prepared cards, letterheads, DX Explanation slips, report forms, etc.). Many of these items are not offered by other radio clubs.

Article V, Section 2, Part 1, m of the Bylaws indicates that the President shall be responsible for the inclusion of the complete IRCA Constitution & Bylaws as amended during the previous year, in one of the summer issues of the DX Monitor each year. The Board has waived this requirement since there have been no changes in the documents since the last printing in Sept., 1967. However, anyone desiring a copy of these documents may have one by writing publishing headquarters (Don Erickson). New members receive copies of the C & B upon joining the club.

We are out of DX Booklets and a new printing will be done soon. Details will appear soon in the DX Monitor for those wishing to update previous articles or write new ones.

The Board has selected Bill Lipis as the representative from Region #7 on the Board of Directors. Bill will serve until August, 1968, when new elections take place.

Editorial Comment

In the past few months there have been several occasions when a lot of hot and hasty words have been hurled back and forth in the pages of DX Monitor. The old Chinese proverb, "Never answer a letter when you are angry," has been violated on these occasions. To cite several examples: the accusations thrown back and forth at the time of the merger proposal; and more recently, in the discussion concerning the role of DXWW. I would like to end the current dispute started when Hank Ward asked in the 11/9 Monitor:

"What do you all think...particularly those of you who are not dyed-in-the-wool foreign DXers...would it help to move such catches into the Roundup sections of the DXM?" This was at a time when RJS had just resigned as DXWW Editor and apparently no one wanted to take the job over. (Actually LBG asked me just about this time to take over the job.) Recently Hank has written me: "I want to point out that I do not oppose DXWW nor have I since you took over the reins so ably. When it appeared that the IRCA was in financial difficulty and without a DXWW Editor, I took a position I felt valid, that the limited number of reporters to DXWW did not justify the expense of the additional pages, that the handful of then active reporters could just as easily communicate on a round-robin basis, if need be....So, I started 'editorializing', assuming my long years as a DXer and age gave me some degree of authoritative voice. I think I can say at this writing that it met with some degree of success. We got reactions to a number of things I hammered and chipped away at." He cites as examples my time-zone format for DXWW and the current discussion on accepting taped IDs as verifications.

If I may be allowed to editorialize, I feel that enough has been said by all on this particular point. While Hank's question was valid in November, it no longer is to the point, as he himself admits. Since I have taken over as Editor, there has been a revival of interest in DXWW, and people who did not contribute before are beginning to do so, even though their main interest is in domestic DXing. I see no point in continuing such discussions, since they are now evolving into squabbles as to who is a "small" or "big" DXer. If we are to work together as a unified club to produce an ever better and better Monitor, we should weigh our words carefully before blasting off. Personal disputes should be carried on by mail, not in the Monitor.

To return to the other proposal Hank made, I am in favor of accepting taped IDs as verifications. Written verifications date from an era when a DXer had to have some evidence to back up his claims of reception. In this way, written veries have been a tremendous help to the hobby, in keeping down the number of those whose imaginations were too active, to use DEE's expression. Now, I think, general acceptance and use of tape recorders leads to an alternate method of exhibiting such evidence of reception. As Jim Nall pointed out, many of us do not have the time to write reports, nor the cash to spend on postage, especially to foreign stations. I would favor, however, limiting such verifications to a tape at least five minutes in length, with a clear ID involved. (After all, this is perhaps the absolutely shortest length of time you would listen if you were writing a report. (Just as an aside, I cannot see how someone who runs a recorder while he is asleep can say that he has "heard" a station.) I favor dividing DX Records into the following divisions: Total verifications (QSLs and tapes); and a separate column for QSLs. The DXer who has gone to the trouble of writing a report and getting a QSL should have some special recognition. The only sad thing about using tapes is the loss of the thrill of getting that long-awaited QSL in the mail, perhaps with foreign stamps on the envelope and maybe even in a foreign language.

In general, I favor all of the proposals set forth by LBG in his recent President's Report. I would obviously be in favor of beginning an exchange with the Australian DX Radio Club, if the BoD decides that our budget can stand the cost.
