Thrush type note - In the Sept. EI it is positively established that the original VOA station on 1040 was at "Dry Tortugas. In fact the VOA itself now admits, for the first time, that there was a DT relay during the Cuban missile crisis. Previous stories of this DT XMTR were, so far as I have been able to determine, based entirely on unconfirmed newspaper accounts. And most will recall the extremely evasive answers given out last summer by VOA concerning the original 1040 relay. Further as IRCAnS will recall; VOA 1040 initially rec. its programming off the air and one of its pickup points was Radio Americas, itself an off-the-air relay. The EI piece concludes - "One might also wonder if there is another chapter in this story - namely, that RA could have been located much closer to Dry Tortugas at that time". I believe the only rational answer is yes. But then DXers aren't always rational, like htere are still some who even dispute the existance of those 24 hour portables, hi.

I don't advocate making the tests so easy that the use of skill is taken away, but at least give us WC DX'ers a chance. Tests from WC stns should also be arranged to help EC DX'ers. Pearkins, Jr. has submitted a proposed amendment to the new draft of the Editorial Policy (soon to be distributed in the DX Monitor): Article III-F dealing with omission of reports in the bulletin at the discretion of the editor, would be amended: "However, editors must state that an omission was made to the report or the report, itself, was omitted. In the case of an entire report being omitted, the member's name should be mentioned in the column."

Enclosed probably with this bulletin is the brochure from DX Stamp Service, a fine organization that serves the DXer by selling return postage mint stamps for enclosing in reception reports to foreign countries. Why not get stocked up now for the upcoming DX season?

And don't forget the NRC convention to be held in St. Louis over the Labor Day weekend (Aug. 29-Sept. 1). Inquiries should be sent to Bruce Reynolds, Route #2, Warrensburg, Missouri 64093. All IRCA members are welcome.
