India A new million watt transmitter near Calcutta has been heard testing in the mornings (in India) testing on 580 kHz, without any announcements. (SCDX)

Turkey

On November 8 a new 300 kw transmitter at Diyarbakir took the air, broadcasting the programs of the Turkish Radio and Television, on 1061 kHz. It is on from 2255-1700 EST. (SCDX)

Irish Clandestines - all in Dublin

Radio Galaxy, 1498 kHz with light music, Irish music, and old time music hall tunes. Request programs on Saturdays and Sundays at 0700 EST.

Solar Radio, 1180 kHz., at 0700-0730 and 1800-1900. Claims to have been heard in Northern Ireland.

Radio 300, 998 kHz. This is the latest station. Pop programs heard at 0500-1200, and also with request program at 1800.

Radio 217, 1384 kHz. Heard with test transmissions usually on Sundays at 0730 with pop music of 30 minutes duration. (SCDX)

Colombia La Voz Portena, Aereo 1643, Barranquilla, is a new station on 1550 KHz. Apparently they do verify by card. (SCDX)

Guyana On January 1, 1970 a new station will be officially opened in Guyana. It will be the most powerful voice in the Eastern Caribbean with two medium wave transmitters on 560 and 705 kHz. 560 kHz will be 20 kw and 705 will be 2 kw. The station will go under the name of Action Radio. This is an offshoot of Radio Demerara of the Guyana Broadcasting Co.Ltd. 560 kHz is already being used. (SCDX) One to look for. They might be having test transmissions between now and the end of the month.

Netherlands Normally the Dutch MW transmitters are silent from 1800-0030. On special occasions Hilversum II on 298 meters (1007 kHz) will transmit a so-called Night Broadcast with announcements in Dutch, German, and English. (SCDX)

### International Waters

Radio Nordsee International is a new commercial radio pirate on board the former Swiss coaster "Servetta." The name has been changed to "Mebo II" after the owners Erwin Meister and Edwin Bollier. HQ is in Zurich, Switzerland. Recently Mebo II left Rotterdam, for Lisbon where she will get the final radio installation. There will be 3 powerful transmitters--according to some, 100 kw each; according to other information, a MW outlet of 30 to 50 kw, a SW transmitter of 10 kw, and an FM outlet. Frequencies will be 1605 and 6210 kHz and 102 MHz. Anchored between Schweningen and Hoek of Holland, Radio Nordsee International will commence broadcasting in German, French, and English any of these days and will be on the air daily from 2300-1900 hours. The owners hope that the station will be audible in the whole of Western Europe including parts of Scandanavia, Warsaw, Rome, and Madrid. (SCDX)

Malawi Frequency changes: Blantyre: 755 kHz., Lilongwe 593 kHz., Ft. Johnston 539 kHz., and Karonga 872 kHz. (WRB)

Thailand Report-- Glenn Hauser, Korat Thailand. (Glenn's address is Box 1466, APO San Francisco, Calif. 96288.)

It's a bit of a shock being immersed in a totally new MW environment so suddenly and I'm still getting used to it. Would you believe I didn't bring the FBIS logs? Or the WRTH... but the library has one. I'm using the HQ 160, which survived with only a few external masts, and a 60' or so longwire strung between two barracks. Noise level is always high, and TVI is a problem too. Hope to get a loop via kit ASAP.

- 540 AFVN South Vietnam, Saigon always good at night // other frequencies such as 560 when heard at 0620 EST w/DJ show. Is only 417 miles. Heard 12/6.
- 545 ... Hong Kong (this isn't in any of my available lists), R. Hong Kong, very weak in English, almost American-sounding program, from 0625 12/6. At 0700, 6 pip TS, ID, news. (This is listed in WRTH-SS 69 as ZBV, the EE service, 20 kw, nominally 860 kHz. Ed)
- 548 PB445 Asiatic RSFSR, Vladivostok, open carrier until 1030 EST 12/5, then R. Moscow IS, Chinese program. 2628 miles.
- 550 ... Malaysia, Ipoh, Malay program, ID, TS, 0730 12/3 news by YL. Country #9.
- 560 AFVN South Vietnam, Pleiku, psychedelic music //540 0720 12/3; QRM from 563.
- 563 ?? Thailand, as yet unidentified, noted evenings, including an EE segment, "Back to the Bible," giving Bangkok and Manila addresses, at 0701 12/6. Strong signal here.
- 650 AFRT Ryukyu Islands, Kadena, the ID given at 1419 12/2. Country #4.
- 730 AIR India, Gauhati A listed, with news in EE 1040 12/5, giving AIR ID, low het QRM. Country #14.
- 750 ??? China ? Jamming noted here at 1045 12/5, very broad band, with a hint of CC heard under, probably BED2, Taiwan.
- 790 ... Singapore, Multilingual program of R. Singapore noted ending news in EE at 1045 12/5, then light classics. Country #15, 955 miles.
- 797 RTAF Thailand, Nakhon Ratchasima, a local of mine noted on exactly 800 the first day, but since has been fairly steady here. Is Air Operations Command, noted with Thai rock at 0620 12/6, and splattering  $\pm$  25 kHz. (Listed as 800 kHz in WRTH. Ed)
- 845 ??? China unlisted by fairly strong. Look for a het on Thai's 843. Noted at 0615 12/6 talking about guess who? (Art Peterson reported both these last two stations some time back. Ed)
- 900 AFVN South Vietnam, Cam Ranh Bay, complete AM and FM IDs, Viet and US anthems during 24 hour program, at 1055 12/2. Country #1.
- 930 AFVN South Vietnam not in my lists, where? With NAs, 1100 12/5, then lost feed from Saigon, apologized. (I don't have a list of AFVN stations in Vietnam, so can't help you, Glenn. Ed)

- 1025 ... Asiatic RSFSR, Omsk listed. German startled me at first, at 1158 12/2, IDed as "Zweites Programm fur die Deutsche Bevolkerung," then Mayak IS, 1200 Russian. Country #3.
- 1042.5 .. Thailand, Bangkok, listed as 1043 but drifting is Wor Por Thor Nin, with Thai songs 0605 12/6, 135 miles, down from 1048.
- 1048 ... Thailand, Bangkok, Military Intelligence station, playing Dvorak's New World Symphony from a canned EE program, for cut off incomplete at 0755 12/3, at 0757 EE commentary about Dvorak, cut. 0759 chimes, 6 pip TS, 0800 eight strikes, ID, Thai talk. List 1043, later heard on 1042.5.
- 1050 ... Hong Kong, as reported, EE now on this frequency, discussion on local problems heard 0540 12/5; country #13 at 941 miles.
- 1124 ... Libya, seems the likely source for Arabic at 1436 12/2. Country #5; first African here.
- 1130 DZHP Philippines, Manila, ID 1100 12/3, plug for National Radio Net; country #11, 1259 miles.
- 1180 ... Thailand, Krung Thep, Ministry of Education, music 0556 12/3, 0558 Thai and EE announcements. Is sometimes joined by //3203. Country #7.
- 1190 ... China, R. Peking, carrier cut on at 0557 12/3; IS 0559, 0600 language. Country #8. Anyone know exact QTH? Must be South China, judging from strength. (Listed in FBIS as Chungyang JKT, but I was unable to locate any portion of China by this name in several atlases. Ed)
- 1190 HLKX South Korea, Inchon, 0507 12/3, Moody Bible Institute program; 0529 TC for for 7:30, then another religious program. Country #6.
- 1240 ... North Vietnam Radio Hanoi's foreign service frequency, lists only 10 kw, and indeed much weaker than than HS on 1010. Opening FF program 0830 12/3, mentioning 9840 kx; low het and CCI. Only 488 miles. Country #10. (Can you explain CCI, Glenn? Ed)
- 1300 ... China, R. Peking's Foreign Service also noted here at 0600 12/4 //1190 and stronger. QTH? (Also listed as Chungyang JKT. Ed)
- 1367 ... Kazakh SSR, Petropavlovsk listed. Classical music 1055 12/4, Mayak IS cut then dead air. 1100 begins Moscow Chinese. Country #12. Apparently the most reliable evening Soviet station here.
- 1580 ... Thailand, Bangkok, "Voice of Free Asia" ending news in EE 0543 12/4, music, then special report at 0545.

- 620 ??? UnID SS heard SM 0328 12/1 u/WSUN. (AMG) (Others have also noted an UnID on this channel. Could be HISD, YNM, XENK--all noted here recently. Ed)

- 635 TGW Guatemala, Guatemala, La Voz de Guatemala heard here and 645 12/2 with excellent signals, evidently transmitter problems. Taped with calls and slogan 2300. 2345-0015 played Fred Waring album, "We Wish You a Merry Christmas" in its entirety. Taped and reported. Not heard since. (JKC)
