Change of Time

Recently the Board of Directors, on my proposal, voted favorably to change the time used in DXWW from EST to GMT. To my mind, this is a step which is long overdue. Greenwich Mean Time has been used by DXers throughout the world as a standard means of time indication. To my knowledge, the only clubs not using it (at least for foreign reports) have been the two major BCB clubs in the US--IRCA and NRC. Now both clubs have adopted the use of GMT for foreign reports. IRCA has also elected to use Eastern Local Time (EST or EDT in season) for domestic reports. DEE, in last issue, indicated that he didn't know when this would go into effect. As far as domestic reports are concerned, there won't be any change until DST goes into effect next spring. However, as far as I am concerned, the change from EST to GMT for DXWW will go into effect immediately. I will change the times on reports to GMT until people get used to reporting in the new time. However, FROM NOW ON, STARTING WITH YOUR NEXT REPORT, PLEASE CHANGE ALL REPORTS TO GMT, AND SO INDICATE ON YOUR REPORTS.

Some newer members may not be used to using GMT. To convert your local time to GMT, add 5 hours to EST, 6 hours to CST, 7 hours to MST, and 8 hours to PST. Thus, midnight PST, or 0300 EST, becomes 0800 GMT. This means, also, you must be careful to change the date where necessary. For instance, 0000 GMT occurs at 1900 EST the previous evening, and your reports should indicate the new date.

Since England itself no longer uses GMT as its ordinary time zone (they have placed themselves in the European time zone, to be in step with the rest of the Continent), a newer term, Universal Time, (UT) is becoming more popular instead of the more familiar GMT. They're the same. 2300 GMT = 2300 UT. I've also seen it written as 2300Z, to indicate the same time.

Geomagnetic Conditions

A sudden commencement geomagnetic disturbance began at 0046 GMT November 7 and ended about 0300 Nov. 8. A slow recover to normal has been continuing, according to the Telecommunications Services Center in Boulder, Colo., through Nov. 10. Geomagnetic conditions for the week of Nov. 11-18 were expected to be unsettled, particularly during local night hours. As a matter of interest to TV DXers, intense sporadic-E conditions were noted over the NA continent 0000-0500 GMT on Nov. 10.

- 560 AFVN South Vietnam, Pleiky. The AFVN station here is no more. The tower was toppled in war action, and only 1 kw is now being fed to a longwire antenna; this happened some months ago, per an AFVN engineer.
- 843 ... Thailand. You'd alsmot think it was untended, automated...relay of SWKSHPT news from Bangkok 10/22 at 0005 featured a heavy mix of news and TTV Radio (English) audio, exactly as was the case on 6070 kHz, which was obviously the feed's source.

One presumably in Ban Tak, the other in Bangkok area, as monitored 10/18 at 0730 with Sunday only English program of Thai TV Radio, //6095 kHz SW. Program for Thai International Airways, sked "2:05-2:55"; 0700 into Thai music (march) without ID and transmitter off.
- 898.5 ?? Iran? Man and woman talking, music 10/27 at 1820, evidently Tehran as nothing on nominal 985.
- 907 ... Thailand. A station now heard on this frequency, 1328 11/6 with ID and ad; may have mentioned Takhli as location; looped E-W.
- 910 ... Jammer. "XM" grinder, with seemingly hand-keyed ID in Morse twice at a time, 1815 10/27; curiously, much better on longwire than on loop.

CSC also runs the 843 kHz station in the northeast.
- 917 ... RSFSR, European, Makhatch-kala with Russian sports coverage 1818 10/27. It was so slurred I at first thought it was Portuguese...
- 1000 ... China Jammer. "BU" steady by under Taiwan 1805 10/20.
- 1030 ... Thailand. A new 50 kw station has been activated by SWKSHPT for Changwat Phitsanulok. First noted 11/4 at 0005 with news relay past 0030, 0058 time melody, etc. 0100 more relay without local ID. on 11/6 at 1240 English' language lessons with China looped; also low het. Ending at 1245, ID. 6 Hz SAH with China.
- ... Pakistan (West?) as per Arctic Radio Club reporters, a new Pakistani also on this frequency; noted 1505 11/6 with YL news in English, sked for national service; China looped but dominant; also het on high side.
- 1180 AIR India, Jabalpur listed. 10/20 1810 Indian music, 1820 anti-air and off. Last June's Akashvani magazine showed s/off at 1710.
- 1220 ... South Vietnam. New station being heard, location unknown. First noted 10/28 at 2220 or slightly below, Viet talk and music. Looped toward South Vietnam, not North, and programming matches too. Also 11/6 at 1430 Viet talk and music. China looped.
- 1288 ... Thailand. A big event here in Nakhon Ratchasima, the 4th annual, 3rd regional games ("Ghee-Lah") has inspired AM, FM and TV stations for the occasion. Noted 11/4 at 0110 with music, 2-way radio conversations. "Que Sera" in Thai (!). Ads on scratchy ETs, long pauses, etc. The games were to end after the first week in November; they're an elimination round for the Asian games in Bangkok next month.
- 1450 ... Taiwan. During a very rare transmitter failure of local AFTN, Chinese classical music and announcements, not Commie type, heard 1735 10/27. 1800 AFTN carrier back but looped for timesignal, ID and William Tell overture motif, s/off. BED48, Kaohsiung, listed. AFTN back on 1805. (You quite obviously were not on duty at the time, Glenn--such a happening couldn't happen with you in control. Ed)
- 1532 ... Thailand. The Rongrian station previously reported on 1556-7 is now fairly stable here, but claiming to be on 1560, as heard during ID 0105 11/4; also with announcement about the Gheela. Also on in the evenings.
- 1591 ... Thailand. Looks like I'm leaving just when the local situation is getting crowded. Another signal of local strength now here. ID something like "SWKS Kongthap Pa Thii 2", 0205 11/4, songs and ID as 1600 kHz, 190 M. (Your stretch in the Army certainly isn't up yet, Glenn--are you being transferred? ED)
