Bertram Podall - 141-05 Pershing Crescent, Apt 512 - Jamaica, NY 11435
2nd $\frac{1}{2}$ of rpt. see 2/13 DXM for 1st $\frac{1}{2}$. On directions & distance, it should be easier for most DXers to use the airline distance tables given by some airline timetables or the World Almanac which also has tables of US city lat. & long. One can take the number of degrees difference in long. & multiply by 53 to get a fair estimate. Ex.: L.A. to N.Y.C. is actually 2450 statute miles. They are 44° apart which gives 2332 for the approximation or about 4% error. Using FJP's distance to Pyongyang 6041 miles - I get 6201 miles. Directions are found by using only 16 points of the compass - the Boy Scout type of "boxing the compass". Long. & lat. are N-S, E-W a straight edge (ruler) lets you angle to the 4 major points. If the straight edge hits the diagonal of the N-S lines you have NE or SW; NW or SE & the remainder is just an approx. for ENE, SSE, etc. Quite simple if your not required to be within the mile. Best DX & 73.

In the three IRCA DXR's of average length (1/9/71) 350 tips were listed. This is three times as many as NRC has. DXWW has an average, I guess, of about 120 tips per issue; IDX has about 175. DXWW needs more support. Wish some of y'all, especially Santa Clara County members (Dan Adams, etc.) would try foreign DXing. How about this fall when the TPs start coming in all over the dial? I can't see where "non-DX comments" are "disgusting". They do a lot to make DXM more personal. 73

SPECIAL ANNOUNCEMENT: It has finally been decided to count taped veries in DX Records. Please observe the following guidelines when counting taped veries

- 1) Tapes can be for any length of time; however, they must contain at least two (preferably three) of the following: Call letters, location, slogan, frequency. This holds for both domestic and foreign stations.
- 2) Slogans for foreigners are pretty well known. In the case of domestics, a slogan must be relatively specific. E.g. "Boss Radio", "The Country Grant" etc are not acceptable. "Missin'" (for KJGG), "Fraser Valley Radio" (for KJLV/KJVR) are okay.
- 3) Network ID's, Pips, etc. are okay for foreigners if regular ID's are not available and if the tape contains a definite ID from another station on the frequency. For example, WKK pips with a WCCO or KJLV ID underneath could count as JOBB-330.
- 4) In all instances, a tape must be able to prove reception beyond all reasonable doubt. If unsure as to whether a tape should be counted, ask yourself that old question of questions, "If another DXer heard the tape, would he be satisfied that I had heard the station?" If the answer isn't yes, don't count it.
- 5) As is the case with contests and achievement awards, the DX records editor reserves the right to inspect taped and/or written veries listed on DX Records forms.
