RADIO TODAY REVISITED To answer some questions received here, S9 is a CB publication whose orientation actually is closer to SWLing than Radio Today ever was. Tom Sundstrom, as editor of "DX Korner" reminds those of you with the choice of taking your Radio Today refund (the latter having ceased publication) in S9 or 73 mag that S9 "has the only active BCB-SWBC-Utility stn info column going." Tom's section depends upon reader support and is very similar to IRCA DXR format except that listing is by country. To answer the most-asked question on the subject of Radio Today's folding: 73 is an amateur radio magazine with emphasis on construction projects and little or no "operating news" such as fills the pages of CQ & QST, two more ham radio magazines. Some are considering demanding a full cash refund of the remaining portion of their Radio Today sub. Certainly someone who subscribed to R. Today as a strictly SWL mag would hesitate to take S9 as a replacement since S9 is nominally a CB mag. The magazine (R. Today) has made no offer of cash refund; however, some states require magazines sold in the state (Radio Today was sold in all states) to provide cash refund upon request. If anyone has trouble getting a refund, please let DEE know, but allow sufficient time (8-12 weeks).-DEE.

"Operation during Emergency". Send your complaints to the FCC. I heard it on KFAB which was the ONLY Omaha area station that followed instructions. Looking for KFNF-920 to come back on the air. 73's. Bulgaria Eight new MW transmitters of 5, 10, or 30 kw on 710, 773, 944, 1043, 1178 and 1295 have been in operation since January 5. Bulgarian Radio now operates three networks: H (Horizon), 0300-2300 on 596, 710, 773, 863, 1043, 1160, 1178, and 1295-- a light program with news ever 15 or 30 minutes. B (Boten), 0600-2100 on 746, 827, 944, 1124, 1223, 1295 and 1376; O (Orpheus) 1630-2130 on FM only. Foreign Service programs in Turkish are now from 0400-0540 Sat. and Sun until 0500, and 1730 Sat., Sun.

1700-1830, on 1295 and 1376 kHz. Broadcasts in English, French, German, Greek, Esperanto, Etc., are unchanged. (SCDX)

Pakistan The new 120 kilowatt transmitter of Radio Pakistan at Hyderabad was inaugurated on February 4. It will cover 24,000 square miles in daytime, and all of West Pakistan at night. (SCDX) (Hopefully even beyconf. Ed)
