## Entrance Rules

- 1 These contests are open to all IRCA members in the US & Canada who are in good standing. Entrants will be disqualified if they cease to be members.
- 2 The entry fee for the domestic contest is 75¢ (cash, check or stamps) and the fee for the foreign contest is also 75¢, or \$1.50 for entry into both contests.
- 3 The contests will run from 0000 (ELT) 15 Sept. 71 through 2359 (ELT) 30 June 72.
- 4 Stations may be submitted for scoring until 1 Aug. 72, the loggings must take place in the designated period, however.
- 5 The contest manager reserves the right to request any verification submitted in the foreign contest.
- 6 The contest manager reserves the right to have final say over all disputes over points and rules in the contests.
- 7 The domestic contest is a HEARD ONLY CONTEST, the foreign contest is not. Stations may be re-logged only in the domestic contest, they may not be re-logged or re-verified in the foreign contest.
- 8 Standings will be published on a space available basis in the DXM.
- 9 Final Standings will be published after the 1972 IRCA convention. After the final standings have been published, winners and losers will have one month to dispute said standings, after this period, the prizes will be awarded.
- 10 When writing to the contest manager, please include an SASE, or be prepared to have a long wait for a reply.

## Domestic Heard Contest

- 1 Three stations from each of the 50 states and provinces are eligible. Scoring will be as follows;

- 1 pt --- any station with 10kw or more on an unlimited basis
- 2 pts -- any station with 9999w or less on an unlimited time basis, except stations on local channels (ie, 1230, 1340, 1400, 1450, 1490)
- 2 pts -- any daytime only station with 10kw or more
- 3 pts -- any daytime only station with less than 10kw but more than 500w
- 4 pts -- any station, daytime only, with less than 500 watts
- 4 pts -- any station on a local channel (1230, 1340, 1400, 1450, 1490)

The power when you heard the station is the power that counts (including PSAs, emergency power increases, etc)

- 2 Any domestic DX Test or Special for IRCA or any other club, counts an additional 5 pts. The station may be the first, second, or third station from any area, or it may be added after the area is completed. There is no limit to the amount of specials that can be entered to any area. However, DX's must be verified.
  - 3 Stations of lower point value may be replaced, at any time, by a station of higher point value.
  - 4 Lists of stations must include; location, call, freq., date heard, time (ELT), date verified (see rule 2), and verie signer (see rule 2).
  - 5 Once again, stations need not be verified for points, but DX tests or DX specials should be verified, so you can get the bonus 5 pts.
  - 6 Bootleggers (your local neighborhood pirate) are not eligible for this contest. Nor are Beacons, spurs, or carrier pigeons, hi.

1 Those entrants in the USA or Canada will be divided into two zones (or if enough people join, 4 zones, 6 zones, 50 zones, etc.)

Anyone not residing in an area listed above, and would like to join please contact contest manager (foreign members included).

2 IT IS REQUIRED THAT A CARBON COPY OF THE ORIGINAL RECEPTION REPORT SENT TO EACH STATION SUBMITTED BE SENT ALONG WITH POINTS LISTS TO CONTEST MANAGER. This will establish time the station was heard so that appropriate pts can be awarded (see rules 5&6), in the case of duplicate entries. To prevent total chaos in scoring, stations must be submitted for scoring within 7 (seven) days of receipt of verification from the station. While there is no definite way of checking this, it is best for the contestant to submit the points as early as possible, because the contestant may very well be hurting his own chance of scoring the most points by not reporting his points as early as possible. Because after a reasonable amount of time, the points will not be changed, even if the later entry has an earlier reception date. This rule will be strictly enforced, otherwise, there will be more confusion than there is in my mind, hi.

The carbon copies that are sent in, will be returned after a reasonable period of time, probably 1 month. All entrants must further agree to submit either the actual verification or a photostat of the verie for examination if requested to do so. Failure to do so may result in disqualification. Veries will receive the utmost care, and will be returned immediately. They will be mailed by the same class by which they arrived. This rule is inserted to protect honest DXers and will be enforced only in cases of extreme doubt. If you are requested to send a verie, don't feel hurt that you're being questioned because this is not a brand, and I will be the only one who knows who's being questioned. And above all, remember, I make mistakes! Anyway, absolute honesty of each entrant will eliminate this rule.

4 Any station (except beacons, weather stations) operating between 535-1630 kHz are eligible if the distance is greater than 3000 miles from your location, and if the station is not in the domestic category. All decisions are final, concerning distance. It is suggested that the entrant state the distance, and this will be verified by the mathematician.

5 Scoring; the FIRST PERSON in any zone reporting a verification from a station for entry into the contest will be awarded 10 points for a singleton, plus 2 (two) points for each 1000 miles of distance between the DXer and the station. The singleton will be determined in accordance with rule 2.

6 The NEXT PERSON in the same zone to report receiving a verification from the same station, will be awarded 5 (five) points for an eliminator, in accordance with rule 2. After this has happened (an eliminator has been awarded) the station becomes dead (see rule 7).

7 All stations that have been used for both singleton and eliminator, shall be then known as "dead" for all contestants in that zone (it is still open to the other zones). A listing of "dead" stations and which zones they are "dead" for will appear at the end of the contest standings, when published in DX Monitor.

Me again(!). As I said in my last WCDXF rpt, I've DXed for three years, which by no means makes me a seasoned veteran DXer. However, I left out one important item. I am a very seasoned veteran at being suckered by buying catalog receivers, such as Laffayette, Allied-Radio Shack (especially their "Realistic" line), Heathkit, etc. They work just great right after you buy them, but a mysterious thing happens to most of them after the 90 day warranty expires. They develop problems. If they still work, they don't work well. They need realigning frequently, certain parts of the bands simply fail to work, etc. So you ship it back to the company and are charged an arm & leg for shipping and labor. Sometimes they fix it, but on trying it again, you find frequencies 1500 & 600 kc exact, but you hear 1100 on about 1050 kc. I advocate buying a Hammarlund, either 2nd hand or brand new. You pay anywhere between \$100 & \$400 for a 2nd hand one. I paid \$109. You will never need another rx again. Hammarlund rxs last as long as you do. If you want more info, write me. 73

The Ted Vasilopoulos Award (as amended by preceding proposals)

The IRCA Board of Directors approves the creation of the "Ted Vasilopoulos Award," which shall consist of an inscribed plaque, the text to be decided upon by the IRCA President, and a free year's membership in the IRCA. The "Ted Vasilopoulos Award" will be awarded on a basis of a ballot by the IRCA membership-at-large annually to the one IRCA member the membership believes has done the most in that year to promote the affairs of the IRCA and to improve the hobby of BCB DXing. In the case of a tie in the TVA balloting, duplicate awards shall be given, provided that the Secretary-Treasurer determines that sufficient monies for such purpose are available in the club treasury. No IRCA member shall be eligible to win the Ted Vasilopoulos Award more than once over a five year period. The Elections Committee Chairman shall, when announcing the opening of balloting for the award, declare who is ineligible for the award during that particular year. He shall list the names of all who have won the award in the previous four years, including their names whether they be IRCA members at that time or not. The money necessary to pay for the TVA award plaque and the IRCA membership awarded each year shall come from the IRCA treasury. The awarded membership is to be via 3rd-class mail. Balloting will be conducted each year according to the schedule established for IRCA election of officers. The chairman of the Elections Committee will be responsible for the distribution and collection of ballots, and will present the award at the annual convention. In his absence, an IRCA member selected by the Election Committee Chairman will make the presentation.

4.2-51 Proposed Bylaws amendment, to be submitted to the membership for ratification. Delete Articles VII, VIII, IX; insert a new Article VII (text follows); and renumber Articles X through XV to VIII through XIII, accordingly.

"ARTICLE VII - COMMITTEES

The Board of Directors may, from time to time, establish various committees to carry on the activities of the IRCA. The Board shall have the power to establish guidelines and policies relative to the functions, operations, and authorities of any committee, but, in all other respects, committee chairmen shall have complete authority over the operations of their committees. For purposes of these Bylaws, the editors and publishers of the DX Monitor and any official agents of the IRCA are considered to be committee chairmen." #All directors-F. Passed.

4.2-52 Proposed Bylaws amendment, to be submitted to the membership for ratification. Article III, Section 2, Part 1 (duties of the President) to be amended by deleting subparts f., g., h., i, and revising subparts a and d. as follows:

"a. [The President] shall preside at all official club functions, including the annual business meeting, when in attendance. If he is not to be present at an official club function, he will, whenever possible, appoint a member who does plan to be present to preside at the official club function; this appointment is not subject to Board approval.

d. Shall have the power to appoint the chairman of any committee, with the advice and consent of the Board of Directors." #All directors-F. Passed.

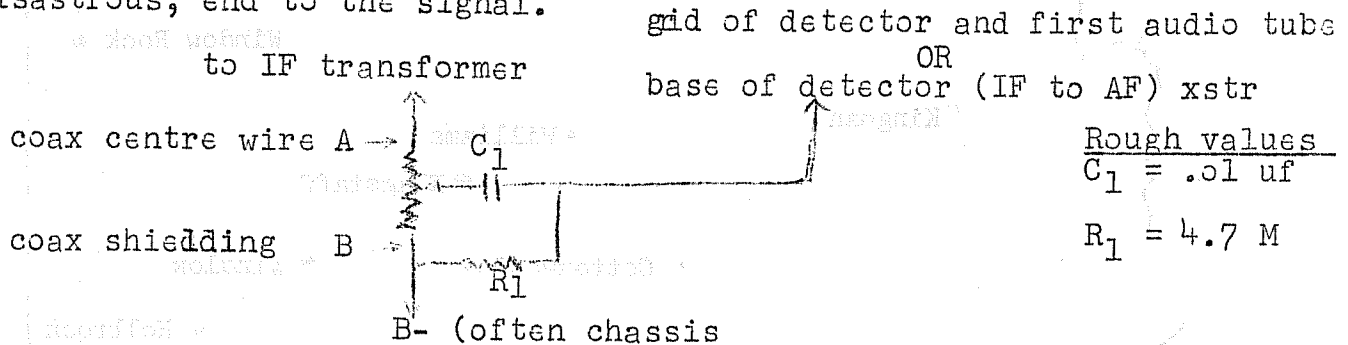

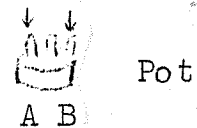
Volunteers to man new Nome station A new education radio station, founded by a Jesuit priest and staffed completely by volunteers is scheduled to take to the airwaves in Nome next Wed. (late July or early Aug. -DEE). The new station is the 10kw KNOM, founded and managed by Father James Poole, S.J., who raised nearly \$100,000 in donations to build the facility. The station will be one of only two major broadcasting facilities to operate in western Alaska, and also will have the capacity to reach Siberia with its broadcasts. Fr. Poole said KNOM will be supported by 17 volunteers, ranging in age from 19 to 75, and including another priest, a nun, six announcers and even four nurses. The nurses, who work at a Nome hospital, will pay half the station's costs with their salaries. Donations cover the rest of the \$4,000 in monthly bills, according to a spokesman for the station. The station pays the expenses of all the volunteers including Fr. Poole, and each receives \$5 per week spending money. In its 16-hour broadcast day, news will total about 3 hours. The station has joined the Associated Press. Music and announcements will make up the bulk of the remaining 13 hours.



Circuits of rx are generally found to have many things in common. One of these regularities is the placement of the Audio Frequency gain control (best known as the volume control) so that it varies the bias (i.e. - signal level; voltage) of the audio detector and first tube/transistor of the audio section of the rx. This is the perfect spot to tap out to your own amplifier -- either for recording or better sound reproduction. Coaxial cable (shielded wire such as that used for mic hookup or loop lead-in) must be used to eliminate signal loss and reduce hum pickup and it is normally best to terminate in a phono or phone plug or DIN connection, as bare wires or alligator clips are prone to touch each other and this will put a sudden, and possibly disastrous, end to the signal.



Physically find the volume control pot in the rx and see if you can trace which end goes to either B- or chassis. This is the end of the potentiometer to which the shielding of the coax should be connected. The coax inner wire should be connected to the other end terminal. Be sure that the solder joints are good and strong. A "Cold Solder Joint", where the terminal and wire have not both been brought up to a temperature that will melt the solder, will cause nothing but trouble as it can suddenly become an intermittent connection or actually have the wire and terminal disconnect themselves from each other. You should note that the output level through this recording outlet cannot be controlled using the volume control on the rx, thus allowing you to monitor your recording on the rx at a desired level without effecting the recording level. However, the RF or IF controls (if your rx has this feature) will effect recording level in the same way they would effect the level if you did not adjust the volume to your speaker. One last word of warning -- most transistor rx and some tube rx require that you always have a speaker attached to the speaker terminals (or other load, such as a resistor with about the same impedance (a.c. "resistance"(reactance) + d.c. resistance) as the speaker). Severe damage (usually the blow-out of the last audio tube(s) or transistor(s) ) may result otherwise. If there is a transformer just before the speaker in the circuit, you can forget the warning. Another solution to the problem (if it exists) of no speaker connected to the speaker terminals, is to pull the final tube(s) or final Transistor(s) I have just told you you might blow. Naturally, if your rx's xstrs are soldered into the circuit and not in xstr sockets, this is quite impractical.



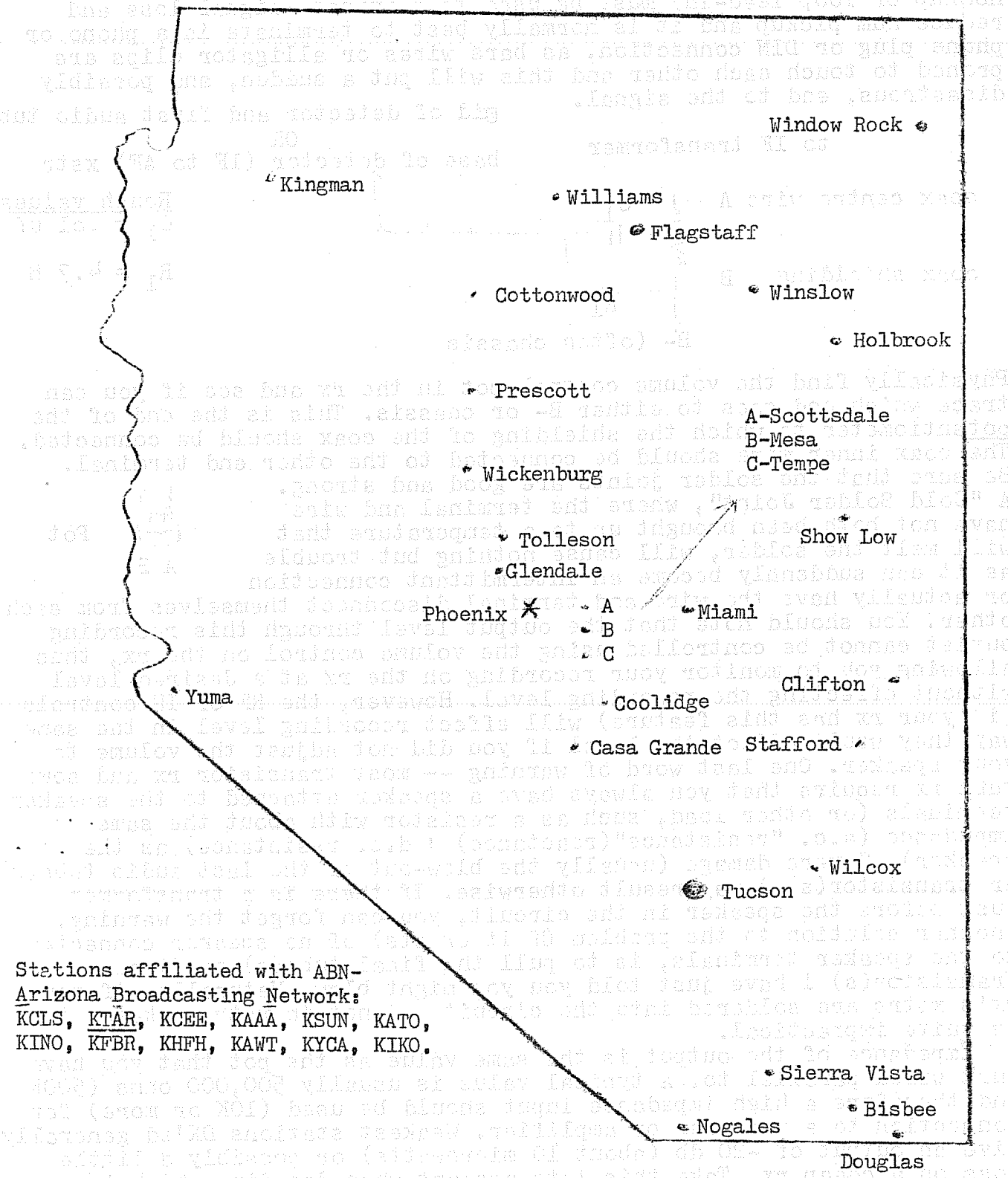
Impedance of the output is the same value as the pot that you have just wired parallel to. A typical value is usually 500,000 ohms (500K) and therefore a high impedance input should be used (10K or more) for connection to a recorder or amplifier. Weakest stations DX'ed generally give an output of -20 db (about 10 microwatts) or possibly a little less on a cheap rx. Take this into account when deciding which t/r or amp input; tuner inputs or radio-phono inputs (not magnetic phono) are usually the best bets. If you note distortion through the amp or t/r where you didn't hear any through the rx speaker, try a lower gain input.
