Around 0715 EDT here CMQ fades out, leaving 640 clear & KFI is audible quite well, even on the Realistic TRF, around 0730. On 10/25 we had good reception of KFI on the TRF until 0800 when I had to stop! Try this time if you don't have a loop! On 10/24 KNBR was audible well on 680 during the same period as KFI was in. There was no trace of WPTF, which is quite strong here in daytime. Any other possibilities for post-sunrise reception of the WC? KNX? KEX? (KOFI?-Brh) Will contribute more often.

RETURN POSTAGE GUARANTEED, FORWARDING POSTAGE GUARANTEED, ADDRESS CORRECTION REQUESTED

All of these phrases have been or will be used on 3rd class DXMs. At one time, 3rd class bulletins were sent out ACR which meant that the bulletin was returned when you moved and the new address, if known, indicated. Charge 10¢ for ACR and more if the original postage was more than 10¢. 3rd class mail, at one time, wasn't forwarded outside of the city even upon request of both the sender/recipient. An apparent change now permits the mailer to guarantee forwarding postage provided the mailer guarantees to also pay return postage if the postage due for forwarding is refused. In other words, when you move now (members receiving bulletin 1st class or air mail, ignore this), your bulletin will arrive postage due for the amount of postage applied originally. If you refuse to pay, your bulletin comes back DOUBLE postage due. This method has been deemed fairest and most practical to all. In the past, your pub. has been shelling out up to a dollar an issue for ACR and RPG. Now the full burden will fall upon you to get your change in; until you do, you will be paying the postage. Any member who refuses a bulletin under such circumstances, if the club is not at fault, will be notified that until reimbursement (3 times original postage) is made, bulletin mailings will be suspended. If the club makes an error, you'll be reimbursed. If the PO makes an error, who knows... So please do not refuse forwarding postage. This will actually serve to benefit the average member who moves in a hurry and forgets whether a change of address has been put in. You'll still get the bulletin (much faster than in the past) and you'll know that something has to be taken care of. Because 3rd class sometimes takes 4 weeks, you may, through no one's fault, have to pay forwarding postage for a while. If you know in advance you're moving, your bulletins can be held. However, most would probably prefer to pay 8 or 10¢ and get the bulletin somewhat more promptly. ALSO--first class mail members (including air) will soon find ACR removed from the envelopes--it was hoped this could help catch errors but it proves too expensive even if the member is relatively prompt. And it is somewhat error prone. So we'll no longer get a notice (3541) from the PO that your bulletin is being forwarded--if your chg isn't made quickly, notify mbn again.

After chasing the SSB on 1150 at 0500 ELT for almost a full year, I managed to pull enough out the s/on to confirm that it was indeed WDEL for my first Delaware stn in 5½ years in NW Indiana. About Panama--Bill Hardy

Glenn Hauser's logging of HOL83-770 on 10/11 with a list of four new stations on the net, clears up some recent loggings but raises some new interesting questions about Panamanian radio, which was always different the 20 months I was there.

10/11 is the anniversary of the 1968 junta when the Guardia Nacional took over the country. The guard commander is the country's strongman. This year's 10/11 celebration was evidently the biggest yet, according to reports of it carried by ABC news. Secret negotiations on a new canal treaty seem to be going on, and the guard commander made strong statements to cheering crowds urging Panamanian sovereignty for the Canal Zone. So it's no surprise that many Panamanians should be AN to cover the speeches and festivities, especially the four new government stations.

A brief SCDX item in the 10/2 DXWW reported HOL80, Radio Libertad, was on 840 in Panama City. (La Onda Revolucionaria and La Voz de la Revolucion are alternate slogans.) Glenn's 10/11 logging missed the HOL80 call, but got the rest. Besides, Jay Murley heard HOL80 AN on 10/4 using that call.

In the past, whatever government agency in Panama has assigned stations to frequencies and given them calls they seldom use, has avoided putting two stations on the same frequency, even with low power at opposite ends of the country. No problem putting 1 kw-ers on 1500 and 1505 only 50 miles apart, but they'd rather split than duplicate. They also don't worry about who else is on a clear channel outside Panama, as they pop small 250-watters on virtually every clear. All Panamanians are nondirectional and evidently full power at night; there are no daytimers.

So, the stations on 770 and 1090 are completely new, and evidently the 770 is 5 kw or more if it was that easy to hear. (That's just a guess though. The newer stations seem to have more power and cleaner signals.) 890 was an inactive facility in David; with a new call it is still in David. The 840 is intriguing. As recently as 9/6 Gary Elston heard a Radio Aeropuerto ID on 840. The 1970 WRTH listed the facility as Panama with 10 kw, but it wasn't there because of HOG-830. The 1971 WRTH says it's 10 kw in Boqueta (a city in the hills near the Costa Rican border), same slogan; the frequency section lists 1 kw in Chiriqui (there is no city named Chiriqui; it's the province Boquete and David are in), different slogan but same call as R. Aeropuerto. So two questions now: First, was HON32 back on the air before HOL80 went onto 840, since HON32 was certainly inactive my whole time there? And if HON32 is back, does it mean that Panama finally has two stations on 840, possibly both of pretty good power?

The second question is around HOG-830. The only fulltime EE station in Panama (excluding AFRTS in the zone), HOG was run by Jamaicans programming mainly for a soul audience. One of the owners was from the Arias family, which includes the elected President the junta overthrew. Evidently both the president and the owner are in Florida these days. After the junta, HOG was silenced about a month, and when it returned, had no news and hasn't had news since. Just records and commercials! Possibly HOG has changed frequencies, but I can't see them operating alongside the 840 which is surely at least 5 kw.

The only previous government station in Panama was Radio Libertad, HOL47-1190,

which operated approximately March to September 1970. It was NSP with many mentions of the Guardia Nacional. It disappeared in September 1970 about the time the station on 1210 returned to the air, so I didn't really miss it. I would imagine the inactive 1190 facility will now be deleted.

If there are any servicemen in the club, why not apply for a transfer to Panama so we can find out what's going on there? hi!

- 1170 KOHO Hawaii, Honolulu in under KVOO, strong at times, with opera music, pips and chime at 0900, ID in JJ and probably EE, but didn't catch it. 10/25. (GMA,W)
- 1178 VOA Ryukyu Islands, Okinawa poor in JJ 10/25 1350, thanks to Gordon Hanson for digging this one out from 1180. (DGC,W)
- +In as usual hetting WHAM 10/25 1017. (SK,W)
- 1210 KZOO Hawaii, Honolulu in JJ with good signal 0940 10/25. (GMA,W)
- +In JJ talk barely under WCAU telephone talk, 0720 10/24. (JM,W)
- ??? UFO here 10/27 1330-1345, not enough audio, looping for TP. (RS,W)
