Of course, any try for CFFB should be made during periods of the best high latitude reception. This is all theoretical, but give it a try! It ought to be there!

The name of the new amalgamation is Stimme der DDR--The Voice of the German People's Republic. (SCDX)

International Waters Radio Neptun is a new pirate radio station, which according to broadcasts in English and German, broadcasts from the Radio Ship Faithful, 6.4 kilometers from the coast of Clacton, Essex on 1320 kHz with one kilowatt. A better week you can't ask for!! And, even better, the next two days were also low (0 or 1). However, it jumped to 6 and then 10 for Nov. 20 and 21. As a summary of what things were like in Riverside, Page Taylor called Sunday PM with info that TAs were really amazing. The call was relayed to several parts of the country. Those on WC seem to agree that things were mediocre that night. However, Monday brought some readable audio. Tuesday was better. Wednesday peaked. Thurs. was = to Tues. Then Friday, the bottom fell out with only traces audible of the carriers. Sat. and Sun. were shot completely by the increasing geomagnetic activity. Things were particularly unusual Sat. 11/20 PM; at the normal 0418 GMT 11/21 listen for A value on WWV, only WWVH was coming in; previously, they were never more than slightly audible. That night was a complete reversal. And the cx on the entire band were just as erratic with local KWOW being covered by at least 3 others. -DEE
