Commentary

We are most fortunate that Lynn Brooks decided to reapply for the post of MWDXR. The Board was pleased to reappoint him to the post.

The satirical material mentioned in 5.1-29 was inappropriate for the purposes of this Club, in the opinion of the Board. It tended to attack individuals on non-DX topics and would have been understood only by a very few "in group" individuals.

C.M. Stanbury II sent a letter to several clubs asking support for a dialogue with him over recent moves in the realm of international broadcasting. In particular, Stan was concerned over jamming, VOA policies, and racism as demonstrated by Trans World Radio's intent to build an international broadcast station in South Africa. The Board gratefully declined this invitation, feeling that it was beyond the realm and scope of this Club.

In 5.1-31 Stan feels it necessary to call into question an editor's right to delete material which he does not agree with. In effect, he wants the editor to be able to prove that a member's opinion is untrue before deleting that opinion. Due to the very nature of the word "opinion", this is impossible.

Note that any member in good standing may nominate any member, including himself, for an office in the IRCA. Hence 5.1-32 is unnecessary.

Note in 5.1-33 that even though three or more candidates will be named as being suitable for TVA recognition, there will still be a blank for write-in nominations. The purpose of the proposal was to draw attention, especially to newer members, to those members who, though their name may not appear overly regularly in the DX Monitor, have nevertheless made significant contributions to the Club.

In general, the Board felt that 5.1-39 was unsatisfactory as a proposal because they were displeased with the work of the Editor. They felt that it was time to place a more active person in the position.

Michael G. Worst reapplied for the position of Countries List Committee Chairman on the off-chance that a suitable replacement could not be found. As this has happened, the BoD reappointed him.

It is unfortunate that Tom McCormack is no longer a member. In this month's voting David Oliphant is being suggested as a successor to the Province of the Month, as he is a qualified applicant.

The Board is in possession of a great deal of information on the Convention but will let the San Diego Convention Committee transmit it to the membership at the appropriate time. Once again, with only one bid there will not be an election to determine convention sites.

The CoF Editor will be responsible for gathering and listing those stations which are AN or NSP. This list will be stencilled and published about every six months. DXing experience of an extensive nature is not required, nor is a large amount of time. However, highly accurate typing is an absolute must.

Dr. John W. Richardson has resigned as Sports Network Editor. Applicants should be prepared to type their own stencils and, in addition to gathering listings of stations carrying specific sports teams, should be willing to write the management

of the various teams to obtain these listings. A moderate amount of time is required for this task. As early as possible in each sports (e.g. baseball, football, etc.) season, a listing of all stations should appear in DX Monitor. Even if the listings have a few errors or omissions, the main part of it will be of service to DXers.

Miscellaneous

We have a few members of the fairer sex in the Club. We would appreciate hearing from you in DX Monitor, and I would appreciate receiving your applications for any task you feel interested in. DXing is a hobby open to all--not just men.

Thanks to all those thoughtful members who sent me Christmas cards. It is appreciated.

All correspondence is now up to date here. The seven day service on all mail is again in effect. If you have a question about your Club Government, please write.

Members are reminded that they are to submit eight copies of each proposal submitted to the Board of Directors. This fact is taken from "Guidelines for Submitting Proposals", a document which will undoubtedly appear with the updated Constitution and Bylaws.

It is necessary to submit only one application form for a position in the IRCA. However, please specify what you are applying for. If, at a later date, you decide to try for something else, let me know via postcard or letter. I cannot mindread, so an application specifying "any editorship" usually gets backfiled permanently until I hear from the applicant exactly what he is interested in.

More applications are needed for the important post of CPC Chairman. See December 18, 1971 DX Monitor for details.

PHILIPPINES

The Philippines seem to be one of the most difficult Far East countries to receive anywhere in North America, despite the large number (approximately 320) of stations actually operating in the country. Following is an analysis of various factors controlling North American reception of DZ's, plus a list of targets.

A. Factors adversely affecting reception of DZ's in North America

1. All high-powered are on even 10 kHz channels.
2. Unfavorable station DA (directional antenna) patterns are used by many high-powered.
3. Most high-powered are blocked by mountains in the Philippines for low angles of radiation departure at azimuths pertinent for reception on WCNA.

B. Factors favorably affecting reception of DZ's in North America

1. Local sunset in the Philippines occurs at or after 1000 GMT at which time most non-AN fulltime NA stations are off.
2. There are a number of split channels that propagate well, and on azimuths open to WCNA.

That DZ's get out, is doubtless. During my tour of duty in Vietnam (April 69-April 70), DZ's covered the dial with such armchair pickings as DZCH-1600, DYLA-1550, DZBU-1460, DZTM-1380, and many more (needless to say, VOA-1140, hi). In fact, I used to listen to DZAQ (then 620), Quezon City, during its AN show, regularly during the wee hours with a Panasonic portable when I had the mid or first watch at our base in the Mekong Delta of Vietnam. The Mangan Mountains, NNE and ENE of the Manila complex (Manila, Caloocan City, Pasay City, Quezon City, and Makati, Rizal) block low angle radiation at an azimuth of $388^{\circ}33'$, which I calculate to be the great circle route to Vancouver, B.C. (Someone with sufficient reference material should check that azimuth). More southerly paths are ven more severely blocked. All the present DZ 50 kWers must follow this path to WCNA.

If you can hear one, a DZ is one of the easiest to ID with plenty of emphasis on callsigns and frequency. All MW assigned callsigns use them and often. The callsigns are most often in American English, rarely in Spanish. The frequencies may be in English, Spanish, or Filipino. Time is liely to be in Spanish or Tagalog (but in English on stations that specialize in English only). Place names are pronounced similar to Spanish. But Manila is a foreign corruption of Maynila ("My-Nih-La"), which will be heard invariably on non-English stations.

The following is a list of stations which, due to a clear azimuth to WCNA, and clear or split frequency, are more likely than others to be heard on WCNA:

Two short and one long pip at 1400, KK talk, and what sounded like the letters "KBS" in EE immediately after. Some sort of pulsing sound about once every 3/4 sec. much of the time (jammer?). Also noted during this period were UnID rock music 1353; not WLS as looped NW; WLS had already faded out. Plus, according to my notes, "weird sounds like haunted house" around 1356 (I take weird notes at that hour of the AM, hi) There was a mild TP opening that morning as 655, 750, 770 and 830 were also in. (BP,W)
- 967 HLSA? South Korea Now that you mention it, nobody has determined for sure if this is HLSA here or not. Sorry for the hastily drawn conclusion. According to the 1970-71 f/c list, CHOAX's is on a 4th Tues. If 11/31 existed, it would've been a Wed. so 11/31 isn't the day CHOAX holds their f/c. Actually 11/31 in my report was a typo, should have been 11/13. (BP,W)
- 1020 ZCO Tonga, Nuku'alofa had to be the EE s/off 12/28 1000. Righteous Bros or some such EE pop music after some foreign accent (which I'd thought was SS and might've been my later UnID on 1020; see LA's). Right at top of hour heard TC clearly as 7 o'clock, then some kind of an ID mentioning "...islands. We are now closing down. Our next transmission will be at 10(?) :00". Then maybe more announcements or a quick fade-out. 1000 s/off matches WRTH sked, and Jay Murley's Polynesian article indicates this is

1020 contd fairly easy from WC. Did I hear Tonga or not? (BH,W)(I would think so.Ed)

I received a polite letter in Spanish from the SM of XEOS-1340 that resulted from an apparent misprint in the NRC LA log. When I heard XESO-1150 on 8/30, I mailed my report to Ciudad Obregon, the location listed in the NRC Log. Apparently it was delivered to XEOS (same city) instead, and I got the letter from them saying the station on my tape was not them, and suggesting it might be in Mexicali or Ciudad Juarez. Does anyone know where XESO is really located? B/s is Sr. Sergio Anaya Valenzuela, Gerente, if any of you should happen to hear XEOS and need a verie signer.

Chile Radio Presidente Balmaceda has been suspended by the Chilean government for the second time. The decision was taken because the broadcasts were considered as offending President Allende and the Chilean Armed Forces. R. Presidente Balmaceda belongs to the Christian Democratic Party. (SCDX) The report was for SW, but probably the MW station on 1300 was also affected. (Ed.)

Portugal Emissora Nacional, Radio Portugal is now using a new frequency of 971 kHz; has been heard in England at 2300. (SCDX)

Australia--Mervyn J. Joyce, QSL editor of ADXN

The Eastern States of Australia--Queensland, New South Wales, Victoria, and Tasmania will start Daylight Saving Time on November 1, 1971. This will make east coast summer time equal to GMT + 11 hours. This is the first time it has been attempted in Australia since the war, except in Tasmania, so is on a trial run this summer. As a result east coast ABC stations will now sign-off at 1300 GMT, rather than 1400 GMT as before. This will give us an extra hour to look for some of the North Americans.

Zaire The new name of the former Republique Democratique du Congo is Zaire, with a dieresis over the "I". An acceptable anlicised pronunciation would be "zah-EER", though English speakers will call it as it looks nevertheless. (Ron Schatz)

The IRCA Foreign Log Project

One of the best ways a DXer has of checking to see what foreign stations have been heard is to check the reports in DXWW. This way details of reception are gathered, such as time heard, programming, and interference. Many DXers save back issues for years as references. After a time this can present a storage problem. Not only that, but the process of checking each individual issue while looking for a particular station or frequency can be extremely tedious. It would be much more convenient if all the reports were arranged by frequency and country over a long period of time. The process of finding out what stations have been heard on any frequency is then a simple matter.

I am planning just such a log of all reports made to DXWW for an entire year-- from June 1971 to June 1972, to be printed eventually as the IRCA Foreign Log. It

will be arranged in the same format as Listeners' Loggings in DXWW--by the three major regions of TA, LA, and TP. The reports, just as they originally appeared in DXWW, will be arranged by frequency, country, and in chronological order. The entire log should run about 120 pages. The method of reproduction hasn't been decided on yet, but perhaps it will somewhat resemble the NRC Domestic and Foreign Logs. Perhaps some of the outstanding articles on foreign DX which have appeared in DX Monitor will also be included.

Since the material for the Log will still be gathered until the beginning of June, it probably will be sometime during the summer that this will appear. Even though it is still early, I would like to get your opinion of such a project. If you are interested in getting a copy, please let me know as soon as possible. The number of copies we have printed up will depend on the number ordered. If you don't order a copy in advance of publication, you may run the risk of missing out. The cost, while still indefinite, should be in the neighborhood of \$3 or \$4.

The DX season so far has been outstanding, with an exceptional number of TAs reported earlier. Even the auroral conditions work to our advantage, by allowing the IAs to come in better. Since the number of sunspots is decreasing each year, next season should be even better than this season. You'll want a copy of this Log, I think, to help you next season.

In the past few years, the number of IRCA members who have really become serious about foreign DXing has increased; correspondingly, the quantity and quality of reports in DXWW has increased. If you check, you'll find that we consistently have a larger number of foreign reports each issue than any other DX club. That is why this project should be of such interest to all our members; it should indicate that IRCA has come of age as a top-notch DX club. I would think that all should be proud that we have advanced to the position where such a project is possible.

One further note--if the Log is to be a success, the reports that you have been sending in can't stop. We want this to be representative of the DX received over an entire season, so keep those card and letters coming in... FJP
