Brazil Brazil plans to install three powerful radio transmitters in the Amazon jungle, to bring radio service to the farflung inhabitants of that region. The Communication Ministry says 250,000 watt stations will be built at Belem, near the mouth of the Amazon River; Manaus, 900 miles upriver, and Porto Velho, in far western Amazonia. Soldiers, doctors missionaries and explorers who have visited isolated river settlements in the Amazon jungle report that the programs which come in best there are short wave broadcasts of the Voice of America, BBC, and in certain areas, Radio Havana. Thousands of people in the Amazon region get nothing in Portuguese, the national language.. The new stations coincide with the government's program for opening up the unsettled and potentially rich Amazon basin. A 3,350 mile highway from the Atlantic coast to the Peruvian border is scheduled for completion next year. (AP, via Rocky Mountain News, via Bill Nittler. 1/8/72)
