ANARC Report

(This is the report of IRCA's ANARC Voting Representative, Dr. Richard E. Wood)

IRCA's votes were cast 1) for the suspension of ANARC rules regarding timing of election of a Secretary; and 2) to elect Al Reynolds, the only candidate, Executive Secretary. The suspension was a formality necessary because the official deadline for nominations had passed without an eligible candidate agreeing to run. Allen H. Reynolds, is a member of ASWLC and NASWA and mainly a SW and ute DXer. 35 years old, he lives in Jackson, Tenn., where he is a church worker. He was nominated by well-known DXer Gerry Dexter, a former Executive Secretary. -Dr. Richard E. Wood

Edlie Electronics, Inc. IRCAer Harry Simpson in Kansas City, Kansas, writes that in lieu of an out-of-stock item for \$1.04, Edlie Electronics sent a credit memo for that amount and have twice failed to acknowledge requests for the cash amount. Harry is taking the next logical step of a complaint to the Postal Inspector in that area. Should any member or any person dealing through the mail run into troubles with firms or clubs which take money and fail to make good whatever their promises may be, write the Postal Inspector at the PO where the business is conducted or c/o that Postmaster. Don't write just because you fail to receive something; follow up with at least one inquiry and then inform the firm or club that failure to reply will be handled with a complaint to the Postal Inspector. This is particularly true of fly-by-night radio clubs that fold and don't refund dues. Don't be misled into believing the folding of a club relieves the person accepting the money of financial responsibility. It does not. But when writing to a radio club, it is best to permit plenty of time between complaints. -DEE

- CKGM PQ Montreal slightly over someone else on MM 2/19 0157. Believe format was rock but couldn't copy due to WWDJ slop. (JF-NJ)
- 990 *WERK* IN Muncie MM 2/16 thru WNOX fair w/TT, varying TTs. (BLC-PA) (The 16th wasn't a MM, Brian. 2/26?-NG)
- UnID ?? 2/19 0500-0530:20 when off; played Big Band type mx, pauses between songs, faded last song down, then after 5 sec. dead air, off; very strong here, way o/WNOX/etc.
- 1000 *KKIM* NM Albuquerque ET "Your good music station", (dm-OH) test consists of 1000 hz tone and mx, fantastic signal w/no QRM since WCFL was off. Appears to be a r/c 3rd MM 0215 2/19. (JMo-NY)

- E59 - "Florida Beverage" by Jerry K. Conrad. 2 pages 10-23-71. The first of several articles on the principles and construction of a Beverage Wave antenna, named for its inventor, Harold Beverage. A Beverage requires at least 1000' of wire but can be made extremely directional.

LET'S HEAR YOUR IDEAS ON THIS POINT. I WOULD PREFER TO SEE DISCUSSION ON POINTS SUCH AS THIS IN THE FORUMS, INSTEAD OF LONG LISTS OF STATIONS VERIFIED OR HEARD. MAYBE SOME PERSONS AREN'T CAPABLE OF WRITING A PARAGRAPH WITHOUT THROWING IN A LIST, BUT LET'S MAKE THE EFFORT. [AMG, I THINK YOU FORGOT TO REPORT THOSE 2 STATIONS TO ME.]

(cont'd from 3/3 WDXF) In fact, West Berlin is counted as a separate country, mainly because of its distance from West Germany, but for only four miles separation, Colon has to be considered part of Panama. HOL82 was built after I left the zone, but I would suspect the xmtr is either in the city proper (like HOK-640) or in a nearby portion of Panama (like some of the others). I doubt seriously the U.S. would permit location of a Panamanian xmtr, especially a government controlled one like R. Libertad, in the Canal Zone where there is no privately-owned land. So HOL82 is just another Panamanian, friends, and you'll have to keep listening through the regional mess on 790 or 1420 if you want the super-rare Canal Zone. (Hasn't it ever made it to Fla.?) And in case you haven't been reading the papers lately, there is growing pressure to turn the C.Z. back to Panama. So a country that took Gordon Nelson 6 years to hear (despite the NSP SCN's, modulation is weak, it's non-directional, and ID's are infrequent) may soon be his exclusively if it becomes extinct. Keep trying! 73.
