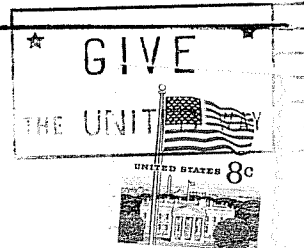
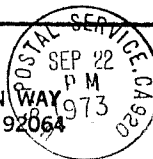

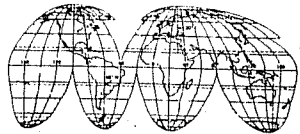

VOA beams NW to China from 11 to 1330 GMT and this transmission sometimes arrives at Tom Carlsson's in Uppsala, Sweden, strong enough to get through the 100 kw signal from Horby, Sweden, on the same frequency. Isn't it quite possible that in times of fine high-latitude reception that Okinawa might appear in the Eastern U.S. as a het against WHAM an hour or two before the fall-winter sunrise arriving from the direction of Greenland? In the Western U.S. we get it best 1330-1400 when it is beaming NE to Korea. Two other things to remember: there is never a time when Okinawa is on the air while WHAM is off; and, Japan has regained control of Okinawa, and it can be expected that some of these days, Tokyo and Washington will sit down and negotiate VOA-Okinawa right off the air. 1973-1974 IRCA CONTEST RULES

- STARTING TIME: 12 am EDT on 9/25/73
- ENDING: 12 am EDT 9/15/74
- ENTRY FEE: \$ 1 (no stamps) irrespective of the number of divisions entered.
- PRIZES: Engraved trophies as well as certificates for all other contestants with good loggings.

GENERAL RULES:

1. These contests will be open to all IRCA members of good standing.
2. You must enter prior to 11/01/73. New members are invited to join within 30 days of membership.
3. All loggings must be made within 25 miles of your primary listening post.
4. The contest manager reserves the right to disqualify any station or member from the contest.
5. You must update your scoring within one month of the date of reception of the station to be entered. Please report any station only once.
6. Call letter, slogan or frequency changes do not constitute a new station for the purposes of the contest.
7. Entry in any contest implies consent to all rules, including those which may appear later as necessity dictates.
8. This is a fun contest, and it runs on the honor system.

1. Object of the contest will be to conclusively log up to three stations from each of the states in the USA, ten provinces and two territories of Canada. D.C. will be considered a 51st state, but the three districts of the Northwestern territories will be considered one province.
2. To assist DXers with less expensive equipment, there will be Professional as well as Amateur Divisions. You may qualify for the Amateur Division if the combined new purchase price of your equipment (or its equivalent) is less than \$ 100 (9/25/73 10 am prices, hi). This includes the price of your loop, radio and tape recorder, if any.
3. Up to three stations may be entered from each state or province, and each will be worth one point. IMPORTANT: Only one of these three stations may have a power of 50000 Watts. For USA stations, the third station (or any one of the three) has to be either a daytime only station or a Local Channel station (1230, 1240, 1340, 1400, 1450 and 1450 KHz). A daytimer broadcasting outside its regular hours due to a check or emergency still counts as a daytimer.
4. One (additional) bonus point may be claimed for each station in a distant region. To determine which stations qualify, determine the region number of your location as well as that of the station. Then consult the simple table below.

USA: Regions are determined by the first digit of their zip codes (except for Alaska and Hawaii). The station's zip codes can be found in the NRC Domestic Log. If you do not have a Zip Code source, I can send you a list of states and region numbers.

CANADA: B.C. = region 9
Alb., Sask. and Man. = region 5
Ontario = region 4
Quebec, N.B., Nfld. and N.S. = region 0
Other = region X.

OTHER: Region X (e.g. Yukon, Alaska, Hawaii).

5. Entries must include call letters, location and region number of the station along with date and time heard.
6. Only stations licensed by the FCC and CRTC will be allowed.

FOREIGN CONTEST RULES:

1. The object is to conclusively log up to two stations from as many countries as possible.
2. There will be 3 divisions. Contestants may enter one, two or all three divisions, but should specify their division(s) when entering.
DIVISION TA: Europe, Africa, and Asia West of 60° longitude.
DIVISION AM: North, Central and South America. Alaska is included, but the rest of the USA and Canada are not.
DIVISION TP: Oceania (including Hawaii) and Asia East of 60° longitude.
3. There will be one point for every station conclusively logged, up to two per country.
4. The IRCA Country List will be used to define a country.

- 5. A conclusive logging must contain program details, frequency when heard to ± 5 KHz, as well as two of the following heard: Call letters, slogan (or jingle ID), location (town or country), national anthem or identifying piece of music, parallel programming.
- 6. All catches must be reported to the DXWorldwide column (with full details) as well as to the contest manager (no program details).
