THE CBC PURCHASED **CKSB-1050** WINNIPEG (EX ST. BONIFACE) MB; THIS IS THE FIRST STEP IN FORMING A CBC FRENCH NETWORK ACROSS WESTERN CANADA. ETHNIC GROUPS IN THE AREA WILL STILL BE ALLOWED TO AIR THEIR WEEKLY PROGRAMS, IN UKRAINIAN, HEBREW, ETC. STUDIOS WILL EVENTUALLY BE MOVED TO CBC (CBW) WEST. TWO LPRTS (BOTH 860) WILL RELAY CKSB.

THE CBC ALSO ACQUIRED **CFNS-1170** SASKATOON AND **CFRG** (CFGR-1230) 710 GRAVELBOURG, BOTH IN SASK. BOTH STATIONS WILL LOSE THEIR STUDIOS AND WILL OPERATE WITH A NEW FF STUDIO AT CBC (CBK) REGINA.

A PRICE IS ARRANGED FOR THE LAST REMAINING PRIVATELY OWNED FF STATION OUT WEST, **CHFA-680**, 25 YEARS IN EDMONTON. NO CHANGE IN STUDIOS OR PROGRAMS ARE PLANNED FOR 1974, THE TIME OF TAKEOVER. APPLICATION TO THE CRTC SOON BY THE CBC.

THE CRTC GRANTED THE VACANT 800 SPOT AT THUNDER BAY, ON TO THE CBC FOR A NEW EE REGIONAL STATION, EXPECTED TO BE ON THE AIR BY SPRING. EIGHT NEW LPRTS WILL BE SET UP TO RELAY THE NEW OUTLET AS WELL AS THE TAKEOVER OF 11 LPRTS NOW RELAYING CBW AND CBL. CFPA-1230 WILL BECOME INDEPENDENT OF THE CBC.

## 3 states exempted from time change

WASHINGTON (UPI) — Transportation Secretary Claude S. Brinegar exempted three states — Arizona, Idaho and Oregon — today from the new daylight saving time law and redrew the time zone boundary in Kentucky. Brinegar acted in response to proclamations by governors of the states to exempt them from the law putting daylight saving

time into effect at 2 a.m. tomorrow as an energy-conservation measure. Stephen Grossman, assistant general counsel for the department, said the actions regarding Idaho and Oregon were temporary, pending action by their legislatures. Grossman said the temporary exemptions for Oregon and Idaho affected one

county in Oregon, and the southern half of Idaho, included in the Mountain Time Zone. For Kentucky, Brinegar granted the request of Gov. Wendell H. Ford to redraw the Eastern and Central Time Zones within the state. Under the new arrangement, all of Kentucky will be in the Central Time

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Zone, except 12 counties near the cities of Cincinnati, Ohio and Huntington, W. Va., which will remain in the Eastern Time Zone. The entire state will go on daylight time as a result.

Four other jurisdictions have an automatic exemption under the law. They are Indiana, Hawaii, Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands. State legislatures may

also exempt one of the state's time zones in 12 states that have more than one zone at any time before the current law expires, April 27, 1975.

They are Alaska, Florida, Idaho, Kansas, Kentucky, Michigan, Nebraska, Oregon, South Dakota, North Dakota, Tennessee and Texas.


