FLASH TIPS AND TEST RESULTS

Brian Cartwright notes that the correct calls on Al Ogrizovich's Eter on 1530 are WBCW, Jeanette, PA 15644. Address is 111 4th St. Brian monitored them 0150-0230 1/10 with light rock, weak signal for 27 miles. Announced maximum output of 175 mv/m.

CKKW, Kitchener, Ont. currently is on 1320 khz with 1 kw day and night. They are upping power to 10 kw by April, and changing their frequency to 1090. This from Desmond Lanktree who noted that the "KW" of the calls doubtless refer to the "K-W" area of the Kitchener, Waterloo twin cities.

Dave Martin notes that KBAI, Morro Bay, CA has been on since Feb. 4. Operates on 1150 during daylight hours with non-directional power of .5 kw. Format is "adult contemporary" (light rock-MoR); is affiliated with ABC Contemporary Network. Most common on-the-hour and s/off ID is simply a singing "KBAI, Morro Bay". Studios and offices are in the Golden Tee Resort Lodge; transmitter is at the foot of Black Mtn., in the eastern city limits.

Argentina (or at least Buenos Aires) is on double daylight time, judging from many GMT-2 TCs noted by Glenn Hauser on LS10 1030 MM 2/18. This should make propagation possibly many stations formerly s/on 1100 or 1200, as long as advanced time lasts into southern autumn.

Anguilla-1505 DX test 2/18 was considered excellent by Glenn considering the power; test was extended to 0630-0930 GMT; there were many IDs, NNRC plugs, usually holding its own against KSTP and WLAC tests.

WPDx test was heard by Glenn 0225-0230 EDT 2/19 when WSB relented with open carrier and breaks.

Other bits from Glenn: R. Alegre de Panama is the new slogan of the 730.7 khz station heard 0847 2/18 GMT. Maldives is on 1500, not 1507. Sesqui-harmonic from WDSG still noted on 2175x 2/18 0637 EDT, 2230. (whatever that means, hi. Ed)

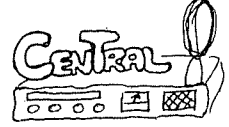

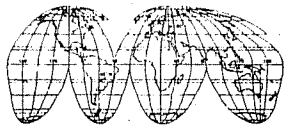

I regret being a wet blanket, but I rate the chances of logging Alaska at 660 on the EC during the WNEC MM SF, as about the same as hearing Afghanistan on this frequency. An essential preliminary to hearing KFAR anyplace east of the

Rockies is extraordinary high latitude reception conditions, the kind of DXing climate that occurs no more than once or twice in a fine DXing season. In any event, 0645-0700 is too early to even try for KFAR, for Mexico City plus Cali are both on at that time. KEAR signs off at 0800, and if the EC DXer then nulls Cali, he has a better chance of hearing New Zealand than getting KFAR. Even when Cali fades away completely in the 0800-1000 period, I detect no trace of KFAR in Denver, and I have been trying to get it for years. Ditto for KQRL on 650, for I have nulled it many times without detecting a peep from KYAK, Alaska. Getting Alaska is virtually a West Coast monopoly, although Nittler logged 750 from Nebraska last winter and Hauser 650 from Oklahoma four years ago.

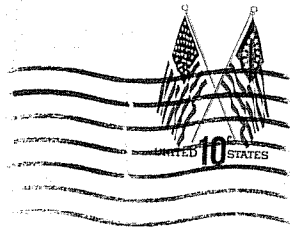
