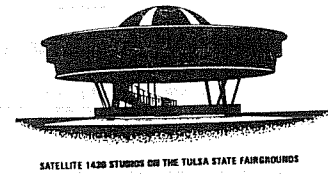

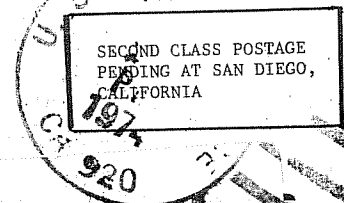

I received two friendly letters from Eric G. Norberg, Assistant PD of KMPC-710 in Los Angeles. KMPC is owned and operated by Golden West Broadcasters. GWB also owns and operates KSFO-560, KEX-1190, and KVI-570. Eric was PD at KMBY-1240 in Monterey, CA, from about 1968 to 1972. He was also the v/s during those years sending out a v/l. If any of you have access to Billboard Magazine, you might want to look at the 10/19/74 issue on page 28 for the article concerning KMPC with a picture of Eric. (Report number 2. mw) KMBY-1240 gets out extremely well for the frequency and power, mainly due to the salt-water ground system. KMBY's ground system is actually totally immersed in the waters of Monterey Bay (the self-supporting tower is on a concrete base right at the water's edge on Cannery Row in Monterey). Due to the shape of the bay and the type of terrain nearby, KMBY's signal is foreshortened to the south (though it can be heard after midnight Sunday in Los Angeles), and increased to the north. The 0.5 millivolt contour (daytimes, measured) extends from Pt. Sur to the south, to Soledad, to Pacheco Pass to the east, to 10 miles north of the (official, but rural) city limits of San Jose on Highway 101, and west from there to the coast. Eric G. Norberg said that KMBY has always got a lot of DX mail from British Columbia, with the furthest ever DX report being from Dr. Richard E. Wood (then of Hawaii) and a confirmed one from Illinois (the DXer sent a tape to confirm). I hope to mention in a future DXF report, the comments by EGN in relation to KMPC's signal. 73s to all. (Two reports combined, 7 sentences of non DX deleted. mw)

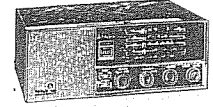

CPC Results and FLASH TIPS..

From former member Dave Christianson comes the following bits of information about Seattle Radio: **KUUU-1590**, has been sold by Davis Broadcasting (owners of **KLOK** and **KWIZ**) to a local group and has dropped AN broadcasting. Sterling Recreation Organization (SRO) is trying to buy the frequency from them, subject to FCC approval, to switch **KTW-1250** to 1590 fulltime. At present **KTW** shares time with **KWSU Pullman, WA**, and signs off at LSS and again on at 2315 PLT. **KTW** has been trying to change their license for years; this apparently is the first attempt to change frequency.

KYAC-1460, at present a daytimer, is trying to get the shared time license that **KTW** will vacate, thus getting more hours on AM (their FM is fulltime and goes soul/jazz after AM s/off.)

Dave recommends you try to log and verify these stations as soon as possible, as he doesn't know how far along proceedings are. **KUUU--1590** will either go to 1460 or off completely, as they have been losing money for a long time with many different formats. At present they are oldies mostly. **KTW** is news/talk/sportstalk presently. **KYAC** is soul.

CPC results:

KRMO-- 990 was heard by Louis Buehler (MO) poor to excellent with voice IDs, TTs, music. QRM from **WNOX** and a Spanish station.

KTLK-1280 was good to unusable for Buehler with voice IDs, TTs, with some **WGSO** QRM and possibly another tester. Heard here in San Diego best (for **FJP**) in the first ten minutes (5 kw non-directional); for Seaver about 20 after (1 kw non-directional). QRM for **FJP** was **KIT** and someone carrying Wolfman Jack.

KQXI--1550 heard by Buehler with voice IDs, c&w religious-type music, mixed in with **WOKJ** and **CBE** s/on.

Financial Report for 1973-74

This is country no. 15, will be sending to PRK for 15 countries verified award. This will be a taped verie since I do NOT write to stns in Communist countries (Lobel)
- 665? UnID TP w/carrier & faint audio 0930 11/11 & lots of splash from KNBR. Didn't allow me even a guess at who it might be (Peterson)
- 705.4 KOREA-S, Seoul, KBS, HLKA heard well 0815 11/11 w/KNBR QRM, signal dropping off to poor by 0935, picking back up to good for the 4-pip time signal at 1100. This & a few other TP's good in spite of geomagnetic storm in progress.
- 765? UnID TP carrier in 0835 11/11, gone by 0920. Most likely is No. Korea listed (Peterson, 2)
- 770 JAPAN, Akita, JOUB is, I'm 95% sure, the one heard at s/off 11/7 & 11/11 at 1500. Both AM's, FF lessons concluded at the hour, & the anncr (man) gave call letters in EE. The "J-O-U" was quite clear, but anncr's voice dropped on the final letter. Anthem followed immediately (Godwin)
- 830 JAPAN, Osaka, JOBB, 11/11 1200. Poor reception w/pips + man in JJ u/WCCO. A few minutes earlier they were b'casting in what sounded like an EE lesson (Lobel)
- 840? UnID stns here puzzle me. At 1500 11/4 there were at least 2 stns here. One repeated a 10-note musical theme 4 times just prior to the hour. JJ style : mx w/man in JJ (Lobel)
- 1000 JAPAN, NHK synchros making it through KOMO's OC easily along w/stn below w/NHK pips at 0900 & 1000 11/11 (Peterson)
- CHINA, JMKPTT, Chengchow, if one can assume that the regional stns are more powerful than the locals (anyone know if this is a valid assumption?). A new province for me based on that assumption. Anthem at 0900 u/the NHK pips, then at 1000 the China 6 pips uniting w/the NHK pips & with the last pip from each perfectly synchronised to mark the hour - absolutely beautiful! All this on 11/11 (Peterson)
- 1130 JAPAN, Tokyo, Bunka Hoso, JOQR in nicely u/CKWX 1208 11/11 w/talk in JJ. By 1300 KRDU was on, making it impossible to check JOQR's time signal which was 4 ascending tones & a pip on the hour 5 years ago (Peterson)

A careless RFS-type error in the 11/2 DXWW credited YSS-655 to RFS; it belongs to Rich Mayhew. So if you think I turned honest or something, ... hi!
