*CKJS, Winnipeg's first multilingual station, on 810, went on the air officially on March 25. The station operates in 15 languages initially, including 60% in English and French. Offices are in the Union Tower Building, 191 Lombard Place.

*WOTT-1410 was not heard March 24 by David Ball (Ont.), 100 miles from Watertown, NY, so the test was not on.

*KDOWN-720, Las Vegas, NV is on the air; signs off at 0300 ELT according to Albert Lobel. Has been heard widely up and down the coast. Apparently has major pattern toward Los Angeles, to protect WGN. Rich Heald in Northern California reports that they are ordinarily on top, with WGN on top on fades.

* The Traveller's Radio Network, which offered travel info in the Northwest, will not be on this season, according to information received by Bill Hardy. The energy crunch is cited as the main reason--not as many cars on the highways.

GIVE THE BoD A CHANCE, FJP!

An Editorial - FJP

It has been suggested to me that my editorial ("The Days of a Do-Nothing Board of Directors Is (sic) Over") in last issue was unduly severe on the BoD. Over the years there have been many members of the BoD who have contributed conscientiously to the good of the club. These certainly were not to be indicted by my comments.

It has also been felt in some quarters that my editorial was only the first insidious step in a plan to overthrow the present club government and to convert IRCA to a dictatorial organization run solely by the publishing staff and editors.

Such was not my intent. What I wanted to point out was that the BoD should be made up of those who are among the most active in the club - not necessarily in reporting - but in showing an interest in the club by their active work. There are positions, mostly in the editorial staff, which have been empty for a long time in some cases, mainly because qualified personnel have not indicated interest in such positions. I would hope that those who are considering running for the BoD would show their interest by applying for such vacant positions.

It is my position (although this position is not shared by all in SDPC) that IRCA must maintain its form of club government. IRCA was founded primarily as an alternative to a "dictatorial" government in another club; I think we must maintain a democratic government if we are to be true to our traditions. Although I sincerely hope that those running for the BoD will devote their energies for the good of IRCA, I cannot force them to do so; nor do I advocate a radical change in IRCA's structure, even if the BoD members do nothing more than vote on issues presented to them. What I will continue to do, however, is work to encourage the BoD members to increase their degree of involvement in IRCA, so that the club members can really consider them the club leaders, in fact as well as in name.

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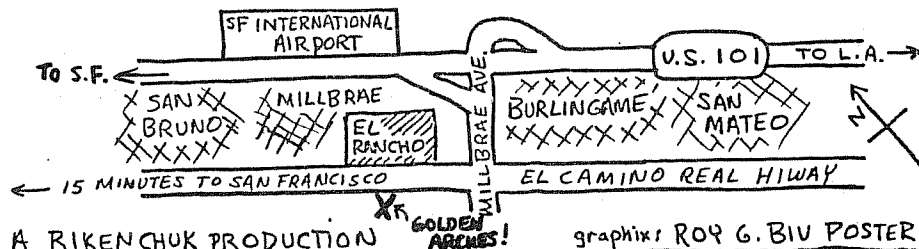

Wyo. Station Gets AP Award

NEW YORK — (AP) — Radio Station KWVO of Cheyenne, Wyo., was named Wednesday by the Associated Press as the top broadcast station in the nation in cooperation with the AP during 1974.

Entries for the annual awards were submitted from 38 states and the District of Columbia and constituted the highest number of entries ever for the national contest, according to Curtis Beckmann of WCCO Minneapolis, chairman of the Associated Press Broadcast Awards Committee.

Other top awards went to WASH. Washington, D.C., for spot news coverage; KMOX, St. Louis, Mo., for weekend coverage, and WTAX, Springfield, Ill., and KFH, Wichita, Kan.,

for enterprise. Honorable-mention citations were awarded to 12 other stations.

Three honorable-mention certificates were awarded in the over-all cooperation category. They went to KGAY, Salem, Ore.; KCBS, San Francisco, and KRCC, Council Bluffs, Iowa.

Awards will be presented at the Associated Press Broadcasters National convention to be held at San Antonio, Tex. May 29-31. The convention is to conclude with the awards luncheon May 31.

KWVO, Cheyenne, was cited

by the AP for its contribution of 476 news and sports stories to other AP members during 1974, as well extra efforts by news director Mark Sands, sports director Dave Montgomery and other members of the staff in cooperating with the AP in news work.

KWVO was named earlier this year by the Wyoming Association of Broadcasters as the station of the year in Wyoming. It marked the second consecutive competition in which KWVO captured the award.

"What do I do about television interference (TVI)?"

"I get the most obnoxious interference from TV sets until 5AM! It's impossible, and driving me out of my mind, because it shreds every signal..." "Is there anything I can do? I live in an apartment house with 88 units." (Receivers R-390, SPR4. ANT: 150' longwire.)

What you are experiencing is the harmonics of 15.750 KHZ horizontal sweep oscillator, used for (among other things) to develop the high voltage to run the picture tube. In most sets, the tube used can easily develop 25 watts of RF at that frequency. Because consumer electronics is very poorly made (little or no shielding), and there are poor laws governing radiation emissions from TV's, you are stuck with your problem. One or two possible aids would be to ground all of your equipment, although in an apartment situation, this would be impossible. The other, which may help, would be to go to a loop antenna. Transistor TV's seem to lessen the problem, but the RF is propagated both thru the power lines and from antenna transmission lines. A sure cure is a glass of water poured in the offending sets, (don't get caught) or to move. I moved here because of TV's (among other noise-makers) and still have one that bothers me--and Poway (this part) has underground utilities! Good Luck!..

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
