Haven't been able to do much lately as I'm working overtime almost every day (except Fridays when we put out the bulletin). Hope all those that have ordered Foreign Log Volume 5 have gotten theirs by now. I ought to tell you that there are still plenty left for the ridiculously low price of \$4.00 (\$4.25 to non-members). Get your order in now, before the season is over!!

Mark Connelly in a recent letter to me states: "For many of us, radio extends our knowledge of other countries cultures; medium wave is better than short wave in this regard, as programming is usually intended for a country's native populace rather than a foreign audience to which some political arguments must be sold. Medium wave DXing is a hobby that is within reach of anyone, wherever an AM radio is found, not a 'cult' or 'elite group' like short wave. Many people DX, even though they are unaware of the meaning of the term 'DX' or of the existence of organized hobby clubs dedicated to hearing far-away radio stations. Truckers listening to WSM and WWVA from Florida to Maine are DXers of a sort as are the many people calling WBZ talk shows from all over Canada and U.S.A. My message for 1977 is for all of us to reach out to this 'silent majority' of 'casual DXers' for membership growth potential. No one starts with fancy gear; membership recruiting should stress the fact that DX can be heard with equipment the average person already owns..." What else can I say. He hit the nail right on the head. Know anybody interested in radio. Why not mention BCB DXing and its advantages. It couldn't hurt.

I'm sure that you all are waiting for the results of the survey that we took a few months ago. Well, I will try to run down a few conclusions in this and future New Members columns. The big question about bulletin format was decided in favor of the present format as: 25 prefer the present (newspaper) format, 24 say that the present format is OK, but wouldn't drop out if we changed, 1 will drop out if we change, 18 prefer the magazine (booklet) format, and 14 don't care. A total of 83 persons filled out and returned the questionnaire, quite a number considering response to previous questionnaires.

The "component" receiving the most "A" votes (won't renew without it) was "DX Roundup" followed closely by "DXWW". Thirdly was "DX Forum." I'll give a complete run down in a future issue. The only feature to receive more "E" votes (Get rid of it!) than "A" votes was "Precision Frequency Measurements." There were quite a few comments that came along with the questionnaire, some of which will be given some space in a later issue. My thanks to SPC member Gary Kayser for tabulating the results.

Boston Radio: Coverage Characteristics, continued. WHET, Waltham, 1330 kHz, audible on groundwave days through metropolitan Boston area to southern-most areas of NH & Maine, bothered by WARA & WNBH slop in S.E. Mass. area. Its primary night coverage is very limited. WEVD in NYC kills it in most locations beyond a 10 mile radius of the transmitter site; QRM is even bad at times in downtown Boston. WLYN-1360, Lynn, day only, is good along the coast from Cape Cod to western NS, inland coverage suffers WDRG QRM west of Framingham, Mass. WWEL-1430, Medford, is an omni-directional daytimer located in the same swamp as WEEI & WILD. Coverage is comparable to that of WILD, the 6-db. power advantage just about offset by increased frequency-dependent ground attenuation. Slopped near WBSM, WJBQ, & WAAB; otherwise, good coverage of coastline from Cape Cod to west NS. WMEX-1510 covers E. Mass., northern RI (WNLC QRM to south), south & central NH, Maine, southern NB, NS, & possibly SW Newfoundland coast on day pattern (50kW); w/5kW at night it loses drastically, especially to southwest (protecting WNLC/WLAC). Heavy CJRS QRM limits reliable night reception to Hull, Quincy, Boston, and the north shore as far as Gloucester/Rockport. Reception in the western suburbs is abysmally poor; usually CJRS owns the channel. WNTN-1550, Newton, is heard reasonably well in central & eastern Mass. (except south side of Cape Cod), also it's heard well in northern RI, southern NH, immediate coastal Maine & the Nova Scotia west coast from Digby to Lockport. WUNR-1600, Newton (Oak Park), nulls steeply to the west & day coverage is limited to an area bounded by the western tip of Nova Scotia, coastal Maine/NH, and in Mass. by a line drawn from Haverhill to Lowell to Concord to Natick to Sharon to Plymouth.

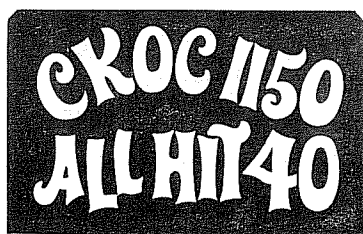

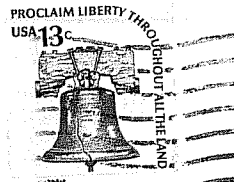
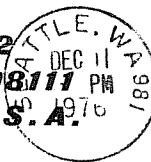
