The only way to be sure is to listen at the top of the hour when the correct calls are required to be given. Concerning the various medium wave proposals, whatever the FCC does I hope they give priority for areas where nighttime service is needed the most. I hope they give preference to already existing daytimers that want to go fulltime instead of authorizing new stns in major cities since new stns aren't really needed. I see no great harm in small town stations going fulltime to DXing since most smalltime stns that are fulltime now are not all night. I predict that daytimers will always be around...frequencies vacated by daytimers will be taken by new daytimers. 73.

Here's more info from KLIF--I was well received by station employees as they're from Ohio, too. They use 12 towers at night with radials at 47, 61 and 90 degrees to protect WOWO: 189 degrees protecting XEWF (Guadalajara) and 310 degrees for KEX. I can't repeat the description of the day pattern that he gave me but will say that they protect WOAT daytime with the 189 degree radial, and use 47 and 305 degrees (approx.) for WOWO and KEX during critical hours. At night about 100 watts goes toward SE Ohio. KLIF dropped ABC news 12/9 so I heard the last Perspective on KLIF, doo-wah. They just have 1 to 7 minutes of local news on the hour during the day now. And from KRDS-1190 Tolleson AZ: Sunday night 2345 Church World News, music from 0000-0100, s/off at 1 to 0530 with Back to the Bible. All times EST, subtract 2 for KRDS time. Now, how much energy is being transmitted that far away from the carrier frequency? Well, AM theory tells us that sideband power = carrier power x percentage modulation squared divided by 2. Or,

$$P_{sb} = \frac{m^2}{2} \times P_c$$

For a 1,000 watt transmitter, at 50% modulation, there's another 125 watts worth of sidebands, and at 100% modulation, there's another 500 watts worth of sidebands. Therefore, a single station transmitting a 10 kHz tone at 100% modulation is the same as having three stations on three adjacent channels transmitting open carrier, with a more powerful transmitter for the middle station. Next: "Overmodulation". 73's.

In the latest DX News, Ernie Cooper proposed using new abbreviations other than OM and YL in describing the gender of announcers heard on BC stations. I agree partly with his reasoning. Suggest you read P42 of 12/18 DXN for his comments. My thoughts are: OM (Old Man) and YL (Young Lady) are terms of friendship and fellowship used between hams. If you want to use the terms OM and YL, get a ham license. If you want to use the term "Good Buddy", get a CB license. Besides, since OM and YL are terms of camaraderie, what kind of warm feelings implied by those terms does the MW BCB DXer feel when he's/she's hearing an announcer on "Y" station for the first time? Japanese and Latin American DXers seem to understand that EE ham term better than MW DXers here, as they frequently use the terms in correspondence in place of "san" and "senor", respectively. 73 de Charlie in Bermuda.

Ref. beacon SIS on 1715 kHz (1/6 DXWW), it had a unique ID pattern: 6 transmissions of the SIS identifier followed by a long dash - different from any other Colombian beacon I've ever heard, and I logged quite a few of them back in the 50's and 60's. On the other hand, Colombia certainly does seem far more likely than Argentina in December. While in a sense all my principle BCB interests have to do with "fringe" operations, this is the first season in quite a few years that I've spent a great deal of time on the band's upper fringes. But there's no doubt that in the coming years much of the BCB action is going to be between 1610 and 1800 (or 1860) kHz, especially in light of the FCC's plan to further curtail the present clear channels.



 The total eclipse of the sun on Monday 2/26 may offer some interesting DX for BCB DXers here in the Northwest. The eclipse will pass over parts of WA, OR, ID, MT & SK w/totality occurring around 1610 GMT (0810 PST) near the coast and around 1645 GMT in Canada. An interesting article on eclipse DXing appears in the 1/79 issue of QST in which the author relates his experiences during a 1963 eclipse in Quebec. Just before totality on that Summer afternoon, 80 meter ham stations 300 mi. away were heard. By the time the sun started to "reappear", the signals had faded out. It's possible that similar results could be achieved on BCB during the 2/26 eclipse. Research has shown that during an eclipse there will be a small patch of nighttime ionospheric cx if the sun is totally covered and cx similar to ISR/LSS if it is partially covered. DXers living within 200 or so miles of the total eclipse may be able to hear stations on the opposite side of the "patch" due to their signals reflecting off this small bit of nighttime. The effect would be similar to "E skip" reception of TV & FM stns. Since the reflection point would be moving Eastward, a DXer might hear several stns on a given freq fading in and out, one after the other. It would probably be worthwhile for NW US DXers to tune around during the eclipse to see if they hear anything unusual coming in. 73.

His report was based on published information, and in no way matched what we broadcast.

Your efforts at publicising the test worked very well. We have received about 20 letters of thanks, from as far away as Holland where one man reports he heard about the test on Radio Austria. Radio Canada also broadcast information about the test, and other clubs have sent their bulletins to us.

We definitely picked a bum night. But thanks to everyone who gave it a try. Since we do have one verification, I have decided to release a tape of the broadcast. You may distribute it anyway you want to, as long as only the cost of the tape and postage is charged.

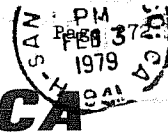

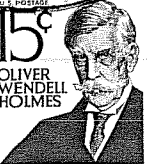
