Roadside radio in Kentucky. The Kentucky Department of Transportation plans to institute "highway advisory radio," approved last year by the FCC, during construction of a new freeway in Louisville. Low-power transmitters will provide up-to-the-minute information on detours, alternative routes, and expected delay times. Roadside signs will advise motorists to tune their AM radios to 530 or 1610 kHz. The transmitters are designed to be moved elsewhere once the work in Louisville is completed. (continued from last DXM, speaking of over-modulation-jz) Another reason some stations seem to splatter more than others is the use of specialized processing. These units, recently put on the pro audio market, keep a lot of power in the sidebands, instead of just allowing it. In other words, they are high-frequency compressors which keep the station "pounding out those highs". The purpose of this is to make up for the awful frequency response of most AM receivers without using simply an equalizer and without overmodulating. They work by dividing the audio spectrum up into "bands" and passing each through a separate limiter and result in more continuous splatter than ordinary limiters which may have a more "buckshot" effect. I stress that these artificial means are quite legal. The FCC's only requirement is that splatter at 15 kHz out be down 25db from the main carrier power. Suffice it to say that the aims of broadcasters and those of DXers aren't always the same. Perhaps we should all be nice about it and accept the DXing challenge as it is, and not try to make it easier. 73's.

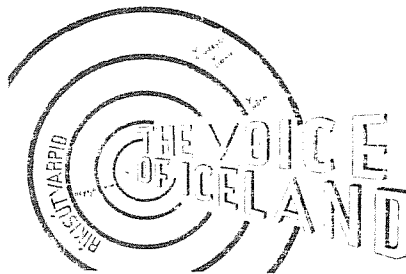

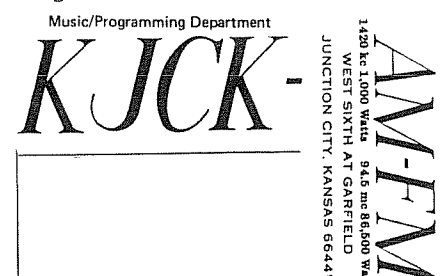

### Roman Radio Station Is Attacked

Foxworth

ROME, Jan. 9 (AP)—Masked gunmen burst into a leftist radio station today and wounded four women taking part in a discussion on birth control. A fifth woman was burned by a firebomb thrown by the assailants.

"Help, help, they are killing all of us!" one of the women screamed, according to people who were listening to the station, Future City Radio. Her voice was then drowned out by shots and an explosion. One of the women said that there were four or five attackers.

A few hours later, an anonymous caller told the Rome newspaper Il Tempo: "We are Fascists and are responsible for the attack at Future City Radio."

Another caller told the Italian news agency Ansa that an extreme right-wing organization called Armed Revolutionary Cells was responsible for the assault on the station, which is run by a left-wing extremist group.

"Honor our fallen comrades," he said, apparently meaning two right-wing

youths who were killed in an ambush a year ago. The anniversary has been marked by a series of ambushes and arson attacks during the past week.

Anna Attura, 38 years old, one of the women wounded in today's attack, was reported to be in critical condition with a stomach wound. Three women were wounded in the legs and a fifth woman suffered burns.

### Turkey's 2d Train Crash in Week Kills 30, Hospitalizes Nearly 100

ANKARA, Turkey, Jan. 9 (AP)—A commuter train crashed into a parked passenger train in heavy fog today, killing 30 people and injuring nearly 100 in Turkey's second major train wreck in five days. Poor visibility was blamed.

Authorities said the accident occurred on a blocked track a few miles from Ankara. They said the first train, after developing an engine malfunction, was led into the blocked area, and that engineers posted the red and yellow warning lights.

A railway official said the engineer of the second train was unable to see the warnings because of the fog and that it was too late when he pulled the brakes on his locomotive.

Five days days ago two crowded passenger trains collided near Ankara, killing 16 people and injuring more than 100.

### Syrian and Iraqi Leaders to Meet

DAMASCUS, Syria, Jan. 9 (AP)—The presidents of Syria and Iraq will meet here on Jan. 20 to strengthen their renewed political and military alliance, the Government newspaper Tishrin said today.

The paper added that the Syrian-Iraqi military committee would meet in Damascus before the two presidents, Hafez al-Assad of Syria and Ahmed Hassan al-Bakr of Iraq, get together.



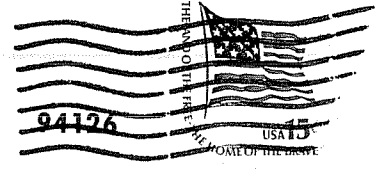
