FCC DOCKET - CLEAR CHANNEL BROADCASTING

As you all know, the FCC is presently considering various alternatives aimed at breaking up the remaining "clear channels". As the proposed move definitely impacts the DX hobby, some of you may wish to write the FCC with your opinions. If you do, I recommend you first read a copy of the docket, "Clear Channel Broadcasting in the Standard Broadcast Band", Docket No. 20542; FCC 78-863. It appeared on page 4502 of the 1/22/79 Federal Register (available at many libraries) or you can probably obtain or examine a copy at the nearest FCC office. Interested parties may file comments before 4/9/79. Possibly IRCA, as a club, should prepare a brief set of comments (emphasizing the impact of clear channel stations on the general public instead of just DXing, of course). Opinions, pro or con, anyone? Incidentally, the docket is interesting reading, even if you don't feel like spending 15¢ on the FCC....

ELECTIONS


Elections will be held in June for the new slate of club officers: President, Secretary-Treasurer, and Board of Directors. Nominations will be open from March 1 to April 15 and each member in good standing may nominate one person for President, one for Secretary-Treasurer, and seven persons for Board of Directors. Any person who has had one year's continuous membership as of April 15, 1979 is eligible and members may nominate themselves for office. Shortly after April 15, the Elections Committee Chairman will notify the eligible nominees, ask that they notify him if they wish to accept the nomination, and instruct them as to the preparation of campaign statements. Further details on the election process appear in the IRCA Bylaws, which appeared in the 11/11/78 DXM. TED VASILOPOULOS AWARD

Each year, the IRCA presents the Ted Vasilopoulos Award to one of its members. This person is the one who has done the most to promote the club and the hobby, as determined by a vote of the members. The winner receives an engraved plaque and one year's free membership.
