I suspect that these cx which can bring in stn's like WDR-1593 as strong as the domestic clears are the result of F layer propagation of the high band frequencies.

It seems that the super AU of July 26-31 has recurring effects every 27-29 days or so . when a strong AU hits (A index greater than 40, K index prob. 5 or more) check to see if the regional freq's between 1230 & 1490 are yielding LA's. This is where some rare DX is & LA's can be heard on GY channels, too.

Stan has suggested that we don't list Cubans w/ calls & only list the announced calls or slogans. For the time being, I'll keep the present format unless I receive several objections.

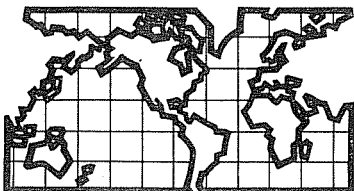

On Jan. 6, 1982, the Alaskan Forces Radio Network (AFRN) will conduct a commemorative broadcast from the Support Center at Kodiak, where the original facility still exists. AFRN has been granted permission to recreate, in so far as possible, the original four hours of operation. This will include period music, commentary, newscasts and use of the call letters KODK. The broadcast will begin with the original sign-on: "K-O-D-K is on the air."

I've enjoyed reading Gene Martin's two forums expressing his disappointment with his new Sony ICF-S5W. . . I like it when people tell it like it is. Some people are probably quite happy with this receiver, but Gene obviously felt he got ripped off by buying his. Maybe there's enough room inside the Sony to incorporate the two pole bandpass tuner described in the 27 January 1979 DXM (tech. column). This would act as a preselector and could clear out the birdies; a bypass switch could also be added. I know that preselectors have really gone out of style in newer radios, but I've never minded using them. The SPR-4's preselector gives a nice sharp peak and this good RF selectivity is probably one of the reasons why the SPR-4 shows no sign of overload on the BCB. Japan Radio Corporation was wise in incorporating a BCB preselector in their expensive NRD-515 receiver, they probably learned their lesson by not having one in their even more expensive 505 model, which was considered in some circles to be a real dog on the Broadcast band. I wouldn't mind owning an NRD-515 and I'm considering hocking my FRG-7 and SPR-4 to help finance one. Seems to me the 515 would combine the good selectivity and signal handling of a Drake with the good sound and easy operation of a Yaesu. Any NRD owners out there wish to comment in a forum how theirs is working out? If there's anybody that rich to afford one, hi.

Made a more down-to-earth receiver purchase recently, got the Shack's "Deluxe" AM pocket radio, the 12-173B. For under \$11 new, a truly good performing and interesting little rig, so I'm sending additional comments to Nick for his column. Just right for listening to the Western clear channels at night. Because I live midway between Seattle and Los Angeles, I pick 'em all up pretty well. Actually, in spite of being located in California, I'm closer to Seattle! (So is your weather, hi-Rth.) California is a loooong state, or should I say it's tall?

On the subject of pocket radios, the GE model 7-2705 is a real mutt. Horrible sounding, stiff rotary dial makes it hard to tune a local station in, and if you succeed at that, it'll soon drift off it. Amazed me, so I took it back to the dealer and got another one, but it was even worse. You can even flex the case and hear its birdies change pitch. So what did I expect for under \$10? ### Los Angeles Times

#### COUNTRY RADIO IN L.A.

KLAC (570-AM)—Still the biggest and the best dispenser of country music in town. KLAC is overloaded with commercials and does interrupt the music too often with such items as auto racing and Lakers basketball, but its roster of personalities—namely Sammy Jackson, Gene Price and Harry Newman—are first-rate talents and their musical mix features a good blend of the sophisticated country and pop crossover songs with the more traditional music. KLAC isn't flashy or brilliant, but it's a solid, under-rated citizen in L.A. radioland.

KHJ (930-AM)—With much fanfare and a pot of promotion money (the figure was reported to be in the neighborhood of \$1.5 million), the one-time king of Top 40 made the switch to country in 1980, but the switch has yet to take hold. Part of the problem was that KLAC had a 10-year head start. The rest of the problem was that KHJ at first seemed to want the best of both worlds—that is, to change to country music but still keep enough pop tunes and pop-style disc jockeys around to let their old audience down gently. Now, KHJ is straight-ahead country and in Lee Sherwood, they have a fine morning man. But it might be too little too late.

KZLA (94.3-FM, 1540-AM)—KZLA FM plays more music than the other two. It's an automated station, cluttered by too many commercials, and the music is played in three-record sets. Unfortunately, the station's lack of personalities to accompany the three songs and a cloud of dust makes KZLA sound too predictable after a while. Being a jukebox isn't enough—not unless every record you play is a gem. In this case, it isn't. As for KZLA-AM, it simulcasts the FM programming from 10 a.m.-6 p.m. During the other portions of the broadcast day there's again an emphasis on music at a cost of personality. □
