Don Moore, Apartado #3, Santa Bárbara, SB Honduras

Lately have been doing a lot of SRS DX. Had done little on ECB here before at that time. Usually if I pulled myself up I did SW. Now I'm doing early morning DX (SW & ECB) about five mornings a week. Best recent catches here, all SRS, are HTS-1550, my first Dominican here; XEKK-620, after over a year of trying for Quintana Roo; & a Belize repeater on 940, the first of these noted in Santa Bárbara. In heard/verified (mainly taped), totals here are now 29/21 countries and 529/415 stations. For CenAm 256/212, including TG 61/54, HR 90/68, YS 37/33, YN 22/18, TI 33/30, HO 11/9 & Belize 2/1. South Am is 42/35, all Colombians save HC 5/4 & TV 1/0. Mexico is 18/16 states 67/59 stns. Cuba 26/13. USA 28/27 states & 116/87 stns. TAs 10/4 countries and 15/4 stns, all Euros except BSC-Oman, 1413. Comparing this to reception in Pa, SouthAm & the Carribean (excluding Cuba, only 6 countries and stns here and only Anguilla in the Lesser Antilles) were better in Pa. In Pa., these areas were heard during SSS, especially late summer and early fall, and during Auroras. Here auroras aren't really noticeable, just blank out some of the northern clear channels that aren't that strong anyways. I have, however, had better TA reception here than I ever did in Pa. Reception into Mexico here is quite good, even into central Mexico. Good reception of US South and Midwest. Several 5kw Midwest regionals have been heard here, e.g., WIBV, WMBF, WSAI & WHK. For coming DX season main targets will be Canada, Peru, Puerto Rico, and Haiti. In U.S.: Calif., N.Va., Md. and Conn. Mexico: Guerrero and Puebla. Anybody know the current SPS for KTRH-740, KMLD-1080, KRAY-1090, KUKH-1130, KVCU-1170, KGBT-1530, or KKEL-1540? All do a too good job of serving Honduras all night long. Some people here listen to KGBT too. ??

Here's more about the DX session 16 and 17 October at Ocean City State Park, on the ocean 14 miles west of here (see last week's forum).

I need help with a strange UNID on 830 and because I don't know if it's foreign or domestic I hope Ric will print it here. (Of course I will. WDXF is for worldwide radio and DX information, as is BDXF-RtH.)

Sunday, 16 October 2147 EDT or Monday, 17 October 0147 GMT, what sounded like a typical SS station with music and ads, played a song that ended abruptly 2149 and after a few seconds cut the carrier and left the air. The last song was a vocal chorus that could have been a national anthem or revolutionary song. From strength and audio, it could have been a new station or a pirate, perhaps in Mexico or Central America, perhaps in California. If a new day-timer, this was about 19 minutes late for a California s/off. Anyone have any ideas? We have the "anthem" on tape if anyone wants to try ID'ing it.

Besides the evening DX to the East Coast and the TP hets everywhere in the morning hours, this location one-half mile from the ocean also has great mid-day DX. Stations from the central and southern Oregon coast, Eureka on 790/980/1480 and San Francisco on 560/610/680/740/810 were all in, as was the CBC LPRT 540 (40 watts at 200 miles). Even from a land path, KROW 780 was in well enough to compare it to KQIN 800, which was parallel except for ID's and ads, meaning KQIN joins KROW on the Satellite Music Network "Starstation."

The capper for us was the logging of our closest unheard, KLAY 1480 Lake-wood, which has a wide null south and west to protect KELA 1470 and is almost inaudible ten miles this direction. Ric will like this -- I had to null KRED 400-plus miles southeast to hear KLAY at 75 miles east; KAAR at 100 miles southeast was a bit louder than KLAY. KLAY is a reluctant ID'er, so it took a good half hour but we finally got a good ID. Next xlosest unheard is KSCR 1420 Renton. That'll be tough; KITI is beamed this way. At the beach, nulling KITI produces KYNG Coos Bay, Oregon, 300-plus miles south.

In short, we enjoyed beach DX'ing and hope to try it again soon. 73.

I've finally done what most of you have been expecting, lost my mind. I've been actually tuning the dials for over six weeks. With this location which has the Himalaya II's in my backyard, capped with the giant roach clip yet, and in line of sight of every transmitter in the entire Bay Area from Vallejo to San Jose, one has to be MAD, MAD, MAD to put in any time at the dials, but I qualify after building up my instability for five years here on Burnett Street. There are actually three or four frequencies one can listen to with only minor splatter.

It's taken me awhile, but I've heard most of the new clear spoilers in this area such as KFAM 700, KERR 750, KAZM 780, KORD 870, KWIP 880, KYXE 1020, KCLG and KREW 1210 and KEST 1450 (my local here used to be Madawaska, Maine).

Ric, would you believe I actually had Hawaii on 650, 720 and 830 on the same night, once? (Pests, all pests, hi-RtH.) The signal obviously came through the Twin Peaks tunnel and crawled up the eastern side of the precipice (sic) (I don't know how to spell that one either, hi-RtH.)

The new KLLK 1250 Willits hasn't been heard here yet; can you hear them in Eureka, rubberears? (Negatory, bucket mouth, hi-RtH.)

Many thanks to those of you who have written or phoned with information regarding the construction permit update; it's been helpful. 73 de don. (Ohmagawd, a forum from Kaskey. No, the earth hasn't moved. . .yet, hi-RtH.)

Congratulations to Gerry Thomas for his BCB article that appeared in the latest Popular Communications. The magazine is looking up these days; they even had a decent front cover for once, i.e.: Non-military.

I'm totally settled in at the new QTH these days and I'm even starting to like it around here, although Humboldt County looks better than ever when I occasionally return there on weekends. Everything's going great at school, it's actually a consulting engineering firm that takes on drafting students

as a sideline, so it's practically as good as on-the-job training. I plan at this point to get into electro-mechanical design and drafting.

I've discovered that DX around here is a piece of cake, in spite of the proximity of the Bay Area 50 kw'ers that come in so well here, and the overwhelming splatter from KPLS 1150. KPLS does have somewhat of an excuse as their towers are clearly visible less than two miles away. (Splatter at night with 500 watts!?-RtH.)

From the Bay Area, KCBS seems to cause the most splatter, which is surprising, because in Arcata they were by far the weakest 50 kw'er from that area. (Natch. KCBS is near Novato, you know--20 miles from you-RtH.)

The main difference between DX'ing here and DX'ing in Humboldt County is that a loop antenna is a real necessity here, while you could easily get by without one up north. In fact, I rarely used a loop in Arcata, considering it a needless waste of time, especially when just bandscanning for foreign hets or checking the rapidly disappearing clear channels. DX-wise here, nothing exciting, but I've noticed LA's are easier here, having heard several just using the TRF, including a nice signal from XELA 830 on a Sunday evening with a beautiful church chimes IS. First time I've heard XELA in several years. Also in on the TRF has been Hawaii, DU's and Japan.

One surprise here is the lack of a good electronics supply house that caters to radio enthusiasts and hams, in spite of the population here being over 100,000. There's a good surplus store (Halitex) that has lots of parts, even some receivers. They have a nice old Hallicrafters S-38A that I may pick up it it's still there next time I'm in. (Caution when buying there-RtH.)

Just got a Drake R-4C, so it looks like its Drake Triplettes on the DX table now. It totally runs circles around my SPR-4 on the ham bands, too bad it doesn't tune the BCB. Because I'm over an hours' drive from the FCC office in San Francisco, I've been boning up on my code; one of these days when I get the nerve, I'll go down there and try to pass the general-class ham test -- 13 wpm is not easy for me.

There was some great DX reported in the 15 October DXM. I like to hear DX'ers' states heard and veried numbers. I'd mention my states veried total, but Ric would be laughing too hard to type it. Thazzit for now. 73 to everyone de RET. (You could count on one hand and have room left over, hi-RtH.)

Hi. I'm a first-time listener to the Pacific region. After purchasing a Realistic 12-650, the DX'ing has paid off. Moving to the Sacramento area from the eastern U.S. has produced some interesting trans-Pacific skip. But this is only obtainable when my TVI rommates are asleep. Having my 12-650 wired to ground (ant. ---illegible-RtH) provides some skip every morning from 0700-0730 PLT. The Chinese station on 1044 will drift in and out as well as a nightly unusual station on 648 (Samoan language). I have recordings of Hawaiian DX including KMVI 550 playing Maui's own Hawaiian music; KIKI 830 Honolulu and KUAI 720 Eleele with Hawaiian music provided good reception last weekend--KDOWN was taking a "nightcap."

The intense voltage from my "favorite high voltage lines" raises havoc with TP stations and locals alike. KXOA 1470 --Music of Your Ending Life (sorry, but that best describes their format), splatters into the entire AM spectrum whenever the L₁-paging frequency is activated. But otherwise, DX is easily obtainable.

My Buick's Sonomatic radio does OK for DX. Locals such as KFI, KNBR, KRMB, WLS are regulars every night, but the radio has a defective volume control creating intense crackles well past 60 db. (Could be just dirty-RtH.)

When on DX'peditions, my antenna system is '50 foot and 200 feet/ for the ground system.

Super pest, KRAK 1140 takes away any hope of pulling in WRVA.

I have a couple days off later this week and plan to DX from the beach at Santa Cruz. 73 to you and the best of DX de GJC.

(Continued from last week. . .) So I visited the Denver library and re-searched Time and Saturday Evening Post over the years around 1930. There was considerable information about the days when Southern Californians patronized three or four gambling ships which operated outside the three-mile limit. But no mention was made about any of the ships broadcasting to an audience on shore. So I wrote my correspondent in England that I could find nothing to substantiate my recollection.

So I was keenly interested in hearing from Wayne Heinen about page 127 in the NRC's 50th anniversary book. On that page is reproduced a verification from station RXKR 500 watts 815 kHz on board The City of Panama off the California coast. The verification, dated 25 July 1933, was sent to Carlton Lord in Akron, Ohio. It also contained the information that RXKR operated from

8 PM to 1 AM daily and on Sunday 2 PM to 6PM. And the letterhead describes RXKR as the first commercial radio station on board a steamship.

Now I hope someone in England will relay this information to the author of that book. It would be interesting to know what shipboard station he mentions as the first one in the world. And I suppose that this is only further evidence that California is the traditional place where something new is developed and then spreads later on to other places. 73.

Sensation" (pronounced as in EE), KBTW with NBC news on 1240---"Radio GCK" (KGCK?); 840 --"R Incondesascia" (probably Mexico); 100 "R. Santasin," WJLJ; 1180 Onda Tropical, HJ-- (Bogota?). There are more, of course, but if I can sort these out, especially the cluster of SS on 1330, I'll feel pretty good about it. If anyone wants to take a crack at them and needs times/notes/tape dubs, gimme a holler here at R. Rancho Zukinidád, hola (oops...that's olé). channel or adjacent channel protection requirements, to use higher power at night than during the day.

FCC Proposes Class IV Nighttime Power Increases

The FCC has issued a notice of proposed rulemaking to allow **Class IV AM stations**, which currently operate on local channels with a maximum of 1000 watts during the day and 250 watts at night, to **quadruple their nighttime power**. The across-the-board-change, which NAB supports, would serve to improve AM service by doubling the field intensity within the area of interference-free reception. If the proposal is adopted, broadcasters would, instead of dropping to 250 watts at sunset, maintain the 1 kilowatt daytime power throughout the night.

The proposal also would allow for those Class IV stations which are unable to operate with daytime power of 1000 watts due to co-

The increase of nighttime power for Class IV's has been a major point of discussion since 1979 when the FCC endorsed it at the Region 2 Administrative Radio Conference on AM Broadcasting. Since that time, extensive negotiations have been conducted with Mexico and Canada to achieve bilateral agreements which would include the authorization of increased nighttime power for Class IV stations. In November of 1981, NAB filed a petition with the FCC seeking a rulemaking proceeding aimed at increasing, on an across-the-board basis, Class IV nighttime power to 1000 watts.

Actual implementation of increased nighttime power awaits final agreement with Canadian and Mexican negotiators and is expected late this year or early in 1984.

Clear Channel Status Backed For Certain Alaskan Stations

NAB supported an FCC proposal to give Class 1 status to certain Alaskan AM stations saying that "their protection from future interference would be enhanced." NAB also is in favor of adoption of AM propagation curves that more accurately represent propagation phenomena prevalent at high northern latitudes.

In its filing, NAB urged the Commission to grant clear channel status for stations operating with minimum antenna efficiencies of as low as 175 mV/m/kw rather than the FCC's proposal of 225 mV/m/kw.

The Association also asked that the 16 stations be protected from potential Canadian interference even if substantial skywave service were not found to be present. "In this way," NAB stated, "the Commission could provide for future enhancement of Alaskan skywave service, through improvement of Alaskan facilities, without being precluded by potential new stations in Canada."

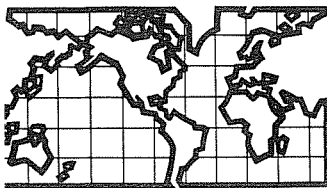
