But anyway, Pan-American SRS has been prevalent with Belize 834 among one of the strongest along with the "tincan" format of XEVQ 830 Navalato and XETNT 650 Los Mochis, both brought in with excellent signals.

One of the strangest occurrences took place on Monday, 26 December at 0405 ELT. Both KCBS 740 and KDWN 720 were off the air with KCBS ID'ing on the hour, "This is KCBS San Francisco." Without KDWN bleeding over onto 740 and KCBS to 750, the Dutch station on 747 was received. Could this be a Pacific relay, Ric? (Dutch on 747?-RtH.) They have programming in different languages, putting in a fine signal. The China/Korean/Asian DX scene has been nil.

With CFRR 660 going on the air in a few days, 660 will be "far-off" in the DX scene. As of now reception from the EC has been terrific on the frequencies below 900 kHz. On 19 December at 0300 ELT during WLS' SP, KBYE Oklahoma City put in a weak signal playing oldies, giving out their phone number (405) 478-2100 (or 3100). A few weeks ago the subject of veries was brought up again and why some never send for them. I was gung-ho for veries back in the days when postage was four-to-seven cents and the return rate was high. Nowadays I simply don't have the time to write unless it's a rare catch or a new station just on the air or a change of frequencies for an existing station just to let them know how they're being received. I'm willing to bet that most of these new "clear channel" stations would appreciate knowing just how far out they're being heard. However, I've brought this up before, a long-distance report is really useless to a station simply because they want to know how well they're doing in their own area for the sake of their sponsors. If you live a thousand miles from a station, usually unless there's an interested CE (or another staffer) or even a DX'er, ABC Market on Main St. has no interest in you. I know that sounds cold, but it's reality. Oh sure, the sponsor is often amused, tickled that their message was heard in another part of the country. And this is not to say many stations aren't interested in receiving reports. The larger stations routinely send out QSIs (sometimes too routinely), so if you're in to sending out reports, great! I'm just not that interested any more and I know what I've heard which is what counts for me. I'm just remembering the last two I worked for and that they put me in charge (v/s) because they weren't all that interested and/or didn't have the time to verify a DX'er. Of course, I never did get any reports, hi.

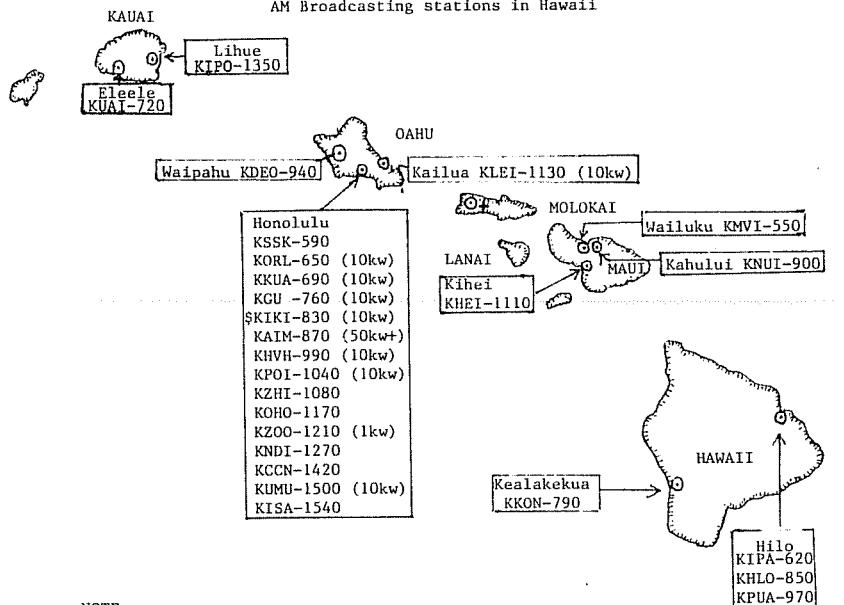

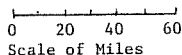

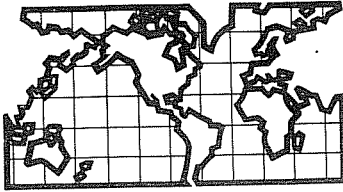

Outlaw broadcaster wants Dick Dorwart asks FCC to grant permit for Glendale FM station to reform

Outlaw broadcaster Dick Dorwart has decided to reform.

Dorwart, 36, who ran an AM radio station without a license for 10 months in 1978-79, is asking the Federal Communications Commission to grant him a license for a non-commercial FM station in Glendale.

The station would provide a forum — as well as jobs and training — for disabled people, Dorwart announced at a Los Angeles news conference Wednesday.

"What I plan to do is help the handicapped community out," said Dorwart, who has been confined to a wheelchair since infancy because of a crippling bone disease.

The station would not be limited to handicapped interests, Dorwart said, and also would feature music and other programming, including a call-in show called "Glendale Speaks Out."

Money is a problem, though. Dorwart said he is on welfare and will have to raise funds if his radio station is to get off the ground.

Dorwart plans to raise funds while the FCC is considering his application, which could take five to six months because of the number of FM license requests, said Raymond La Forge, chief of the FCC's FM branch in Washington, D.C.

Dorwart said the transmitter would be in Glendale because of the availability of a low-power FM frequency in that area. Programming would originate in his Hollywood home, however, where Dorwart illicitly broad-

cast as KDOR 830 AM in 1978-79.

Dorwart said he began a serious interest in radio as a teenager in the early 1960s, when he started phoning in Dodgers interviews to disc jockey Sandy Nelson on KTYM. He said he eventually started his "pirate" station because he did not know educational FM frequencies were available.

"As far as I was aware, the L.A. airwaves were jammed since the early '60s," Dorwart said.

Larry Guy, the FCC's chief engineer in Los Angeles, said it took five trips to Dorwart's home and threats to remove his transmitter before he finally signed off from AM 830 for good.

Dorwart's past piracy will not hurt his chances for an FM license unless someone complains about it on his current application, said the FCC's La Forge.
