Flash Tips

We have a whole bunch of them this week: KSTU-1310 is changing their calls to KFYL and their format to news, per Rich Toebe and Robert Wien. KGNN-1150 will sign on the air October 1 with an NSP religious format (this is ex-KSPL, currently dark). KXA-770 will be off the air 10/1 to 10/8 because they are moving their transmitter to a new location, presumably replacing their horizontal dipole with a vertical. When they return they will have a new call (KXMI) and new format (probably similar to their FM, which is a mixture of adcon and oldies). KLLV-1560 is now on the air with 5 kw ND days and an EZ listening format, per Robert Wien. KWVK-670 is now on the air, per Mike Riordan. KXL-750 is now 10 kw nights, as of 9/28, according to Bill Block. KSUN-1400, currently dark, will return to the air in late October or early November, per a news story sent in by Dennis Kibbe. Format will be "contemporary music...geared toward black and Hispanic listeners". And finally, a Federal appeals court has ruled that WNYC must curtail its nighttime operations, in order to prevent interference to WCCO. WNYC had been operating 0600-2200 for many years. This decision is rather odd in light of other clear channel breakdowns. Thanks to Jim Hilliker for the last item, which he got from the UPI newswires.

NEWS FROM LATIN AMERICA

Paul Swearingen has sent along the following item regarding DXers to the south of us: "Emilio Pedro Povrzenic, editor of 'Latino-america DX', the bulletin of La Asociacion DX del Litoral, Casilla de Correo 26, Villa Diego 2124, Pcia de Santa Fe, Argentina, mentions a dire need for DX lists, such as WRTHs, which may otherwise be discarded, to go to DXers who cannot obtain or afford them. (The average monthly income down there runs between \$170-270 per month, and the monthly inflation rate is about 20%, so they have a real problem. He adds that of the 320 members in the club, only about 70 are paid up-to-date. ADXL publishes a monthly bulletin, in Spanish, available for \$20 a year to us notreamericanos, and an English four-pager for \$5 for six issues." The club covers all bands. Paul would be happy to receive any station lists, old bulletins, etc to send via surface mail in a large parcel. My Electronics Today International article about the future of Medium Wave, mentioned in a previous WDXF, appeared in their Sept. issue under the title "DXing: The Dying Hobby". Also in that same ETI is a very interesting piece on the status of AM stereo in Canada by Edward Zapletal. Still on the subject of magazines, in the past I have made several references to my resignation from the staff of S9 (now Popular Communications) where I served as a contributing editor for over two years. A complete account of this adventure appeared in the July CIDX Messenger - copies of which can be had from the Canadian International DX Club, 6815 - 12th Ave., Edmonton, Alberta T6K 5J6. Meanwhile the August PopComm contains an article by Harry Caul on the 1960's clandestine Voice of the Blue Eagle. With ref. to their transmissions on 532 kHz in the Baltimore area, and the SW broadcasts from various locations, Caul claims "My own research indicates that these were, indeed, one and the same station...". The real Blue Eagle was of course airborne, and a creation of the Pentagon, but what Caul doesn't mention is that the Baltimore DXer who originally corresponded and received information from the FCC about Blue Eagle (and thus would have been able to counterfeit Blue Eagle transmissions) was also the operator of - or at least certainly involved in - the infamous pirate WJMS "Voice of the Purple Pumpkin". Best.

Yet another letter on changes in Florida radio. WLFW-680 is no longer with CBS but soon to be with CNN. Address is 9549 Koger Blvd., St. Petersburg, Florida 33702. Power is still D1 1000. WSST-800 is with satellite radio net and no longer with Florida net. Power is still D3 250, address is still Box 800. Per Charles Castle, GM of WAPR-1390, the CP for D1 5000 was denied due to a 2.7 mile overlap with the .5 mv/m signal of WRBQ-1380, although they're considering applying for 2500 watts or moving the transmitter three miles east. They're still D1 1000, and no longer with Ae or Florida Net. Larry King's current affiliates in Florida are WPLP-570, WGBS-710, WKIS-740, WPLA-910, WNDB-1150, WQNN-1230, WSSB-1230, WINK-1240, WMMB-1240, WNOG-1270, WTNT-1270, WTMC-1290, WQIK-1320, WPER-1340, WCOA-1370, WSPB-1450 and WSIR-1490. WPLP-570 is U4 1000/1000 with CP for U4 5000/5000 which they hope to have complete sometime next year. Networks are C/M/K/FN. WRBQ-1380, still U2 5000/5000, is affiliated with ABC/AP/U. WQSA-1220, still D3 1000, is affiliated with CBB/AP/M. Bill Smiley, CE at WFPG-1300, says their new power (U3 2500/2500) will be on in Sept. Their address is still Box 488. Hours are still 0530-2400. WTAN-1340 is now 0500-0100 nightly, no longer 24 hours, and affiliated with ABC. Per Richard Van Hook of WNWS-790, "at this time WNWS has no plans to move to 780 kHz. The original request was due to interference...from Cuba. As of this writing WNWS is operating with special temporary authority (STA) running 25 kw. We will probably continue with this STA until a determination is made with possible new interference when Radio Marti goes on the air." By the way, when is Radio Marti slated to go on? WPLA-910 is affiliated with Mutual and Larry King. Power is still U3 1000/1000 and address is still Drawer J. WORL-1270 is Eatonville, Orlando and still 2001 Mercy Drive. Power is U3 5000/5000 and no networks. Per WORL morning DJ O. J. Campbell. WPAS-1400 is affiliated with AP. Address is now Box 209. WGUL-1500 has dropped AP and picked up Mutual. Address is now 7212 U.S. Highway 19N. WAMR-1320 is affiliated with NBC and AP only. Address is now 282 Auburn Road, per Dave McClure, S.M. at WAMR. WDCF-1350 is U2 1000/500 and affiliated with RKO and Florida Network, per Jay Thompson of WDCF. WQDI-1430 is U2 5000/500 and (still) affiliated with UPI. 73.

Also, much thanks to you Mark for phoning and filling me in on the column. I appreciated your offer of the computer program and your advice to get this "fledgling" editor editing. You called at the perfect time - I had just finished DXing and was grabbing a bite to eat. You see, I hate to be disturbed while DXing, as most others are, I'm sure. Thanks for the TA pointers also - I'll nab one yet! I'm jealous of your DX knowledge, Mark -- I'd like to DX sometime with you. Speaking of worldwide DX, Eastern DXers should try for "La Grande de Sonora" 1580. I recently logged them with a fair strength thru CBJ's early morning tones. That one's practically a WCer, being in Hermosillo, Mexico. So, if you hear SS tunes here, it may be them. John Demmitt, I'd guess you were hearing Radio Reloj-570 as their signal is very powerful in this area (you're fairly close to my QTH). I was puzzled by this one in my last Forum and finally narrowed it down to Reloj. Neil Kazaross reports that this is probably just a program switch of Radio Rebelde that was previously on 570. By the way John, keep an eye on your mailbox - I've been really busy lately and just recently am catching up on correspondence, and you're up soon for a reply to your last letter. As to your question as to what I'm hearing on 690 - daily it's usually pretty much a garble except for some days when WZAP Bristol makes it through. SSS usually brings WAPE and WVOK and assorted daytimers, except in AU CX when Radio Rebelde makes an early appearance, and nightly CBF and Rebelde are common. One good thing about the treacherous weather in the Carolinas is the many stations that are granted Emergency Broadcast Authorization. So far, I've noted WJIK-1580, WRRZ-880, and WMBL-740 staying on past local s/off times because of the storms. Lately, massive amounts of QRN have been ruining reception of the lower part of the band and it has made DXing here very frustrating. 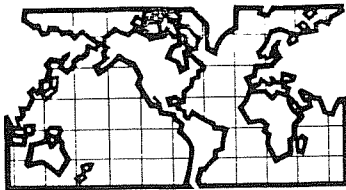
