Before I begin typing this weeks loggings, I wish to announce that after 6 years of editing CDXR I am resigning. The current philosophy, of it would appear to be a good majority of the members, that anything sent in should be published, whether or not it is of any DX value, is incompatible with the purpose of the Round-Up columns. As a result, I do not wish my name to be associated with the poor quality columns that would result if I gave in to those who seek to destroy IRCA. For those of you advocating this, I would suggest that you take a close look at IRGA's content, and compare it with NRC. I think you will find that while IRCA many times does have longer Round-Up sections, the value of what is in NRC is far superior to that of IRCA. The purpose of a Round-Up is to inform about what DX is being heard, not report routine loggings on trips or DXpeditions. While I do not object to vacation DX & DXpedition reports being in Round-Up columns, I draw the line when long lists of routine groundwave stations are sent, or when extremely easy stations are listed solely because they were heard at a place other than your DX shack. I will continue to edit CDXR until someone else steps forward, but I will continue to edit all non-DX oriented items during this interim period.

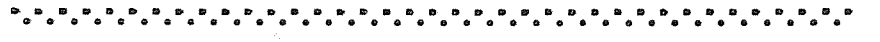

KCHU-770 in Valdez, AK came on the air August 1, 1986, and is presently on the air from 6 am to about 9 pm (Alaska time), pending new volunteer break-in qualifications. They plan to eventually be on 0600-2400 within a couple of months. Format is diverse (classical, folk, news, etc) with NPR and Alaska Public Radio affiliations. Per the station engineer, power is 1 kw days, 500 watts nights, non-directional. At 300 miles, they put a fair signal days into Kodiak (mostly a water path). (via Rod O'Conner)

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
