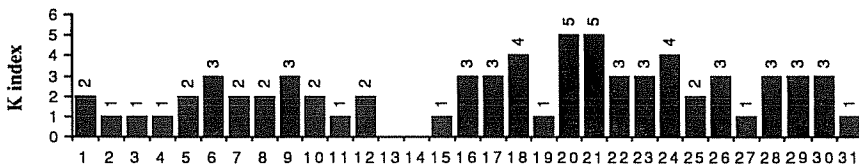
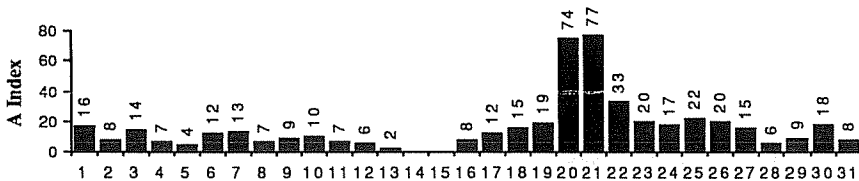
## Geomagnetic Indices

Here is the Geomagnetic activity for October 1989 taken directly from the WWV broadcast at 18 minutes past the hour (usually tabulated at 0518 or 0618). The bar graphs for the Solar Activity and Geomagnetic Field data have the following breakdown:

When the Geomagnetic Field is given as a range (e.g. quiet to unsettled), I've tried to show that by superimposing a second bar graph on top the first, with a different fill code.

The month started off in the middle of a Satellite Proton Event which ended on 10/3. Conditions were then pretty quiet until the 18th. Flares occurred on 10/18, 19 and 22 - 27, with corresponding Satellite Proton Event from 10/19 - 30. In addition, Polar Cap Absorption occurred from 10/20 - 27. phil bytheway.

Unfortunately we have another slim turnout for DXWW-E this week. I would, however, like to take the opportunity to give a big welcome to Randy Stewart of Springfield, MO who is a new IRCA member. Randy sent a few details about himself as well as a few loggings, but yes, Randy, according to the reporting guidelines enforced by Don I can't really itemize them, but briefly: 530-Costa Rica @0430, 655-El Salvador @0400 s/off, 700-Jamaica @0433, 1210-Venezuela @0505, and 1610-Anguilla @0215 all on 10/23. Randy uses an early 80's vintage Realistic TRF modified with Radio West transfilters & a 4' unamplified spiral loop. As far as I've been able to comprehend the reporting guidelines to DXWW-E, foreign reports shall come from east of the Mississippi. I accept reports for DXWW-E also from the states immediately west of the Mississippi, those inclusive of LA, AR, MO, IA & MN. It is the decision of the reporters in those states as to whether their loggings would better benefit DXWW West or East. Again, a big welcome to Randy and please report often if you're hearing anything foreign. A few more items from Randy's letter: Yes, I do still list foreign QSLs (verifications) here in DXWW-E if reported to me. Randy had sent a taped report to JBC-Radio One-700 back in Nov. '88 but no reply. The report was sent to the address for the entire JBC network in Kingston. Does anyone know of a separate address for Montego Bay? If so please let Randy or DXWW-E know. Yes, back in the 70's Jamaicans used to be excellent verifiers. By the way, J.D. Stephens was also attempting to verify JBC last season. Any luck J.D.? We also have a report from Tom Jasinski with a stumper on 1580. Good to hear from you again, Tom.

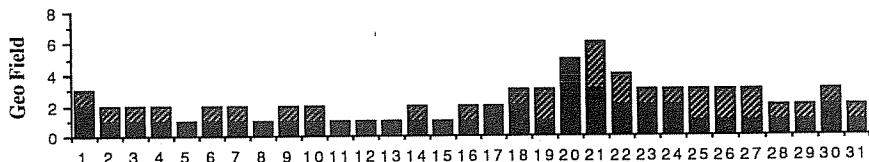
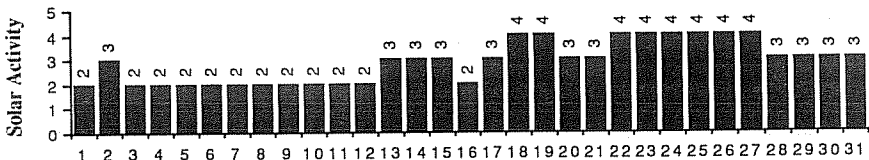

Hello again. Before the year is over, thought I'd better tell you about something interesting. During the first week of October, I experienced my first inspection by the FCC in my 10 years in radio. It was just after 0900 and I had finished the news. I then watch the board at KOCN (104.9) for two hours. When the receptionist told me a man from the FCC was here and wanted to inspect the station, I couldn't believe it. What I had feared several years ago as a DJ never happened, and with deregulation, some of us got lax on our responsibilities. Now, the FCC finally shows up and because I'm the licensed operator on duty, guess who he checks out first? Actually, he looked over the public inspection file first, as the owner/GM and CE were called to the station. Then, he looked over all the licenses in the control room and had me do some transmitter readings, then run an EBS test over the air. I got through it alright, but I sure was more nervous than I thought I'd be, because we don't take regular readings at KOCN and I know the transmitter better at KNRY 1240. While there's a bit of time, I asked the inspector what the rule was on legal ID, because many of the CHR stations are giving them as much as 10 minutes before the hour. He looked it up and the rule is no longer between :55 and :05, just during a natural break in programming as close to the hour as possible. I forgot to ask him about AMers not giving their legal ID when // their FM, suck as KCVR 1570. He told me he manages to inspect 3 or 4 stations monthly out of the San Francisco office. The rest of his inspection was at the XR site. The CE says he doesn't expect any fines and should hear back from the FCC soon on their final report on our station. So, you just never know, the FCC still inspects. If you work at a station, be prepared! 73.

I'm just now settling down in my new home which I moved into the middle of August. I have a large family room which is now my "radio shack." I've already put up a 45-foot lw and looking into a 50-foot inverted V dipole and a 170-foot L-shaped lw. Reception here is a lot quieter than my old apartment location. I've been spending more time DW DX'ing than BCB as just a few hets have been heard so far this season. Was in Idaho Falls the last week of September and the only BCB changes noted there is KTEE is off again. Bill Frahm heard they went bankrupt (this would be the second time). Their tower is still up so the station may be for sale. No sign of KBRV but I didn't get close enough to Soda Springs to really tell if they've made it back on the air. The station hasn't existed physically for 3 years and it appears the group who had supposedly bought the station and changed the calls to KORI never came through. The local C of C told me there was never any sign of the owners of KORI actually showing up in town. While reorganizing all of my DX records I found several copies of the 1982 OREGON BROADCAST BAND GUIDE and the 1984 and '85 IDAHO BROADCASTING GUIDE. These may be of interest to members who collect broadcasting data/memorabilia and I'll sell all three for \$3.50 postpaid. My uncle just recently opened a bar/restaurant in Bavaria. He is decorating the bar with license plates. If anyone has an old plate or two they'd like to get rid of let me know and I'll send you postage. 73.
