Well we are monthly now so watch the deadlines. We have a good bunch of catches this time from Tim Hall plus a tip from Steve Mittman. So here we go:

PAN-AMERICAN DX ROUNDUP

- 540 MEXICO, Tijuana-XETIN-MM 4/29 1255 NEW STATION signed on this AM w/100% automatied operation, mosly SS AC so far. No ads yet. Slogan "R. 540" o/marimba mx theme after every song. Call-letter ID every 15 or 30 minutes. Power unknown, but I would guess about 5 KW. There was nevera CP listed for this. New XE #229. (TRH-CA2) (Tim, thx for the tip on this. Any address as yet? PM)
- 590 MEXICO, UNID MM 4/29 1059 UNID w/XE anthem (more than 1 verse), rooster crows, faded during possible ID and ads by woman. Most likely unneeded XEE or needed XEFD. Can anyone in CO or TX help on this? (TRH-CA2)
- 680 MEXICO, Hermosillo-XESON 4/8 0657, 4/11 0558, 4/12 0558, 4/14 0557 Finally caught the ID on this after tip from John Wilkins that the station was now on until 0700. Station carries ACIR network feed most of the night, including an XE anthem from the network around 0600. Back to the network feed after 0600 but there is usually an ID in there somewhere before 0700 s/off. (Occasionally they s/off at 0600). ID "Radio ACIR en Hermosillo, Sonora---XE-Son..." New, XE #226, tried every night for a month before I got the ID. (TRH)
- 690 MEXICO, Manzanillo-XECS MM 4/8 0733 Usual programming poking through local XETRA with "La Grande de Manzanillo" slogans. Somebody else should be hearing this besides be,hi. (TRH-CA)
MEXICO, Tijuana-XETRA MM 4/22 0822 off, leaving KHEY, XECS, and Unid (prob. CBU). (TRH-CA)
- 730 MEXICO, Mexico DF XEX MM 0730 4/8 ID followed by slogan "La Super Grande" and promo anmt mentioning they were back to 24 hrs. (TRH)
- 760 MEXICO, Esperanza XEEb 4/19 0713 Fair through KFMB w/"E-B La Rancherita" slogans. (TRH-CA4)
- 770 MEXICO, Monterrey-XEATH 4/9 1103 weak u/KKOB w/sign on: "Con una potencia de 5000 watts, XEATH...." 2 more IDs noted at 1158. Ran AC format. Took a yr to finally catch the ID on this. New XE #225. Much needed. (TRH-CA)
MEXICO, UNID Tu 4/9 1045 UNID w/nondescript songs, male DJ. Weak and way u/KKOB. XE anthem at 1200, drowned out by XEIH s/on at 1210 w/anthem. Nothing listed should be on at this hour. (TRH-CA)
- 810 BAHAMAS, Freeport ZNS3 4/24 0720 Booming in w/KGO. I still don't know why no one outside of San Diego hears this. (TRH-CA) (I have tried several times but no luch here. PM)
BAHAMAS, Freeport-ZNS3 4/12 1030 Usual religious programs u/KGO radio. (TRH-CA)
- 820 MEXICO, UNID 4/9 1235 "La Poderosa" noted here again, likely XESB radio. (TRH-CA)
- 830 BELIZE, Belize City-MM 4/29 1109 Fair signals w/ID by man. Always nice to hear this one. (TRH-CA2)
MEXICO, UNID 4/30 0245-0416 Opera and classical mx way u/XELK. Has to be needed XELA, extremely tough to get an ID. (TRH-CA2)
- 880 MEXICO, Chihuahua XEV MM 4/29 1155 fair-good w/XE anthem, IDs and "Radio Sensacion" slogans. (TRH-CA2)
MEXICO, Torreon-XETC MM 1159-1214 Excellent w/slow XE anthem to 1201, TC and ID by woman: "XETC, Estereo Mayran, La Imagen del Sonido, transmite en los 880 Khz de AM, con sonido estereofonico 10 KW de potencia....en Torreon, Coahuila, telefono 12-68-68." Frequency change (ex 1240) and big power increase. New and XE

- 940 MEXICO, Tijuana XEKAM SM 4/14 0700 Gigantic noise spurs on 940/960 tonight instead of usual 880/1020. Easily separable form, and much louder than, the parent signal on 950. I only count one high spur and one low spur in my totals, otherwise I'd have counted this station 15 times by now. (TRH-CA)
- 950 MEXICO, Hermosillo-XEPB MM 4/8 0458 Full ID through local XEKAM OC/noise. Network is radio S.A. (IRCA Mexican list abb. = RDIO") not Radio ACIR as previously listed. (TRH-CA)
MEXICO, Tijuana-XEKAM-4/7 1110 Now running oldies at night, as per tip from Gary Larson. Station wants to double power to 20/10 KW. but is installing a new Ground system so maybe they'll clean up their act. Spurs continue 24 hors a day. (TRH-CA)
- 960 MEXICO, Tijuana-XEKAM-SM 4/14 0700 Huge growling noise spur...see 940 above. (TRH-CA)
- 990 MEXICO, Cuauhtemoc XEER MM 4/29 1132 Huge s/on w/distorted XE anthem, ID by man and "Sistema R. Lobo" jingles. Spanish and local Indian languages by heavily accented man. Apparent new s/on time. (TRH-CA)
MEXICO, Monterrey-XET MM 4/29 1111-1131 Poor u/XETG and XEER OC Call letter ID by man at 1131. Fairly rare. (TRH-CA2)
MEXICO, Tuxtla Gutierrez XETG-MM 4/29 1111-1132 Fair to good sigs but fading, mixed with XET. Female DJ, man w/ads for a pharmacy and bank in Tuxtla Gutierrez. Marimba mx noted at times. Killed by XEER s/on at 1132. New #XE 227, an excellent deep south XE catch. (TRH-CA2)
- 1000 MEXICO, Los Mochis XEMIL MM 4/8 0500 Noted w/NRM network programming// 6010 SW. Ifyou hear the SW // do not assume you've got Mexico City as Los Mochis, Mazatlan or any number of other stations can carry the same program. (TRH-CA)
- 1070 MEXICO, Cd. Obregon-XEOBS-MM 4/29 1214 Fair u/KNX w/XE anthem, s/on, IDs. (TRH-CA2)
- 1380 MEXICO, Tecate-XEKT-4/18 2358 Fair to good signals on car radio even past Santa Barbara Barbara w/full IDs mentioning 250watts. This gets out well. (TRH-CA3)
- 1450 MEXICO, San Luis Rio Colorado XECB 4/19 1330 Good on top w/local ads. (TRH-CA4)
- 1590 MEXICO, Ensenada-XEHC-Su 4/14 1800 utc, vy poor middfay in semi-local KOGO Ventura null with local KBLA-1580 (ex KDAY) w/OC all day. SS Pops, finally caught def. ID at 1847 and 1851 from lady DJ "X-E-H-C...mas? musica." New station for me and midday station #142. (SMM-CA)
- 1600 MEXICO, Tecate-XETCT-4/14 0653 Fair w/NRM jingles full ID mentioning 250w power, XE anthem at 0654. Due to DST now on summer sked 1300-0700. (TRH-CA)

Of 2849 CBX stations QSLd since 1946, 374 have been via special DX programs arranged by various radio clubs - NRC, the old NNRC and others. If I counted correctly the NRC arranged about 20 DX programs this season. Most of the nearby stations were already QSLd here, while most of the needed distant stations were out of reach for this DXer. Never given the band conditions when I started the hobby back in the mid 40s and even into the 60s, many of the distant stations would have found their way to the east. I went back thru my log and pulled up all the DX programs QSLd. There were some lean years as far as I was concerned, as many years I was chasing foreign CBX stations or off on LW searching for ships and beacons or some other band chasing broadcast and utility stations so my totals don't represent the DX programs presented thru the years but they do show some of the interesting stations that could be pulled in and QSLd in the past. Greetings! V/1 in from WABI-910 for state #45 and ME #1 QSLd! Wonder if I'll "ever" get the last 5: AL, NH, RI, VT and WI? A few questions. First, what is the "City of License" for a radio station? Local WWOV-1580 is listed with Camp Lejeune (a U.S.M.C. Base) as the "City of License". Local IDs/s-on & off annmctms give "Camp Lejeune / Jacksonville" IDs. Base Public Affairs confirmed what I already knew: WWOV is in NO way associated with the base. Along the lines of stations, I just took a week of vacation and did some sight seeing (read: antenna/station locating!). As in most places, the transmitter site/towers are not marked w/any identification. Some topographic maps list antenna towers, but many don't. Local (government topographic) maps used for military exercises don't identify towers. Does anyone know of any maps (source) which identify towers/locations? I've found several "in the middle of nowhere" and no idea to whom they belong. Also, while driving around, I discovered a "new" (to me) TIS operation (no call letters) on 1610 kHz which is operated by the NC Div. of Ferries. The tape gives info for ferry times, reservations, etc. Finally, a puzzle (reported, then, to EDXR). On 2/22 between 0620-0645 ELT on 1000 kHz, a station was noted (o/u WLUP) w/a promo by Nat King Cole (Yes. I know he's dead): "Hi. This is Nat King Cole ..." who went into a promo congratulating "...this fine station on their recent increase in power." A female followed, w/a similar promo adding "serving a greater area." A review of bulletins, the NRC Log, checks by Jerry Starr, and correspondence/phone calls to WTAK-AL, WLUP-IL and WMUF-TN, it has been determined NOT to be those (WTAK and WMUF had CPs). I've tried several times since to see if anything would "appear" on 1000 kHz, but only WLUP. KFLG-AZ (also w/a CP listed) on an ET? Any other ideas? All for now. Very 73 and Best of DX!

Some did not appear to have signs. With the car radio volume turned down so the noise is tolerable, they pop right in when you get close to the transmitter. We heard the Hy. 321 entrance, elkmont camp grounds, sugarlands visitor center, Cade's Cove, Roaring Fork Trail and Cable Mill stations. Also a station at Fort Donelson, TN (on bluff over Cumberland River near Dover, TN) was very strong for several miles. I got a good photo of the antenna (I hope) and will forward to the club as soon as the film is processed. Near the Smokey Mountains National Park is a tourist town named Pigeon Forge, TN. In one of the large "outlet store malls" I found a Philips/Sylvania/Magnavox store. They offered the D1875, D3205 & D3805 Philips short wave receivers at good prices. On the way home, we checked the Sony outlet store in the Kenosha, Wisc outlet mall. No luck for short wave receivers however.
