The two contestants who sent "target" lists for the February minicontest failed to hear any of them, so we have no monthly winner. For new members and for those who'd like to send a "come from behind" entry, here is a quick recap of the IRCA contest rules: Two main contests run until April 30. In addition, there are mini-contests that last for one month each.

STATES & PROVINCES (began 9/15/92, continues until 4/30/93) Log 10 stations from each state or province. Scoring: #1=1point, #2=2 points, #3=3 points, #4=4 points, etc, with #10 being worth 10 points. BONUS: A regional station will earn a 3 point bonus, and a graveyarder will earn a 5 point bonus. During the contest period an entry can be replaced with one of a higher value.

LETTERAMA (began 9/15/92, continues until 4/30/93)

This is a "three level" contest, without the need to complete level one before going on to level two or three. In level one the second letter of the call is used: $K\underline{A}BC$, $W\underline{B}UZ$, $W\underline{C}VR$, $K\underline{D}KA$ and so on. In level two the third letter of the call is used: $CB\underline{A}$, WBBM, WCCO, CJDC, and so on. Level three uses the fourth letter of the call: KPLA, KFAB, WTAC, CKRD, etc. Each station will score one point.

MINI-CONTESTS, one month each:

One set hour each day. This month everyone will choose MARCH 1-31: one hour each day to count DX for the contest. It can be any hour, but must be the same hour every day of the month. Log as many stations during the hour as possible. Each will count one point.

Log all you can. Log as many stations as you can during the month. Each will count one point. APRIL 1-30:

Remember to postmark your March loggings by April 10, and your April loggings by May 10. And I'm open for ideas for next season's contests. Send your ideas, or tell us about them in BILLINGS!

The WADXA, which I considered folded since there were no GTG's in the last two years, is not dead; it was only dormant. On Saturday 2/6 a WADXA GTG was held at Arlene Luskin's pad with twenty attending. WADXA is mainly SWL. Several events, which are too complicated for mention in such a small space, occurred over the last two years (when it rains, it pours; we need some sun, hi) which forced the club into hibernation. Most of my DXing has been attempts at the many DX tests arranged by J.D.Stephens (he hosted last year's IRCA GTG) and the CPC. I'm batting around .150 to .200 on the CPC tests. I've already put in for a 16-day cruise down the Blue Danube from Austria to Rumania and the Black Sea to Turkey in late July and early August, the best time to be away from hot, humid, QRN-ridden DC (not now, not during prime BCB DX time). I'll have to get used to 9 kHz sep on the BCB instead of 10 kHz sep here in the Americas. Not much snow here this winter although we had 3 inches Friday 2/26. It was 14 years ago last month when we got zonked with 17 inches, the biggest I've ever seen here. I remember bringing in WMGA-1130 Moultrie, GA at the start of the blizzard and hearing WORI-1520 Oak Ridge, TN when the storm ended. My main DX rig at the time was the trusty 12-655 model TRF. It has shown its wear and tare and now I keep it for reminiscing. Enough blab-off for now. LXXIII de WPT.



On Sat. aft. the A-index was 167 with A-7, K-2 and high solar activity with a minor storm predicted. So I figured I'll check the band on Sat. night. Well, the BCB was like living in Fla. LA's dominated almost every freq. I heard so many R. Reloj clocks I had ticking on the brain all night. Seriously though I couldn't even loop in stns. like KDKA or WLW, everything was from LA. R. Rumbos on 750 khz was equal to WABC, and YVRS on 1020 was stronger than WBZ or WINS. It goes to show that you really have to check the bands every day because you never know when that freak condition will show up. I use a MFJ 959-b antenna tuner/preselector with my LW's for shortwave and just for ha ha's I flipped it on with my loop this past MM, and set in its lowest positions it gave a 10-20 db. boost to all signals over 800 kHz. I'm only running about 20% returns on my many reports out! What's going on? Don't stations verify anymore. I used to get 50-70% returns in the 1st 12-21

days. I really hope the talked about demise of IRCA is just that, talk. I was a member in '66 and it is really important, I think, to have 2 clubs going. 
