




- 570 KLAC <u>CA</u>, Los Angeles 1/17 1245 carrying earthquake coverage of KFWB-980, but with very low modulation. (DG-CA) (KLAC) 1/17 0800± off due to quake. (MS-CA)
- 640 (KFI) <u>CA</u>, Los Angeles 1/17 0732 knocked off for about a minute due to earthquake in S. Calif., back on at 0733. Seemed to be on low auxiliary power, signal not as good as usual, XEYQ audible in background. (RW-CA)
- 670 (KWNK) <u>CA</u>, Simi Valley 1/17 1250 off due to the earthquake. Their transmitter is probably the closest one to the earthquake's epicenter in Northridge. Still off 1/18; back on 1/19. (DG-CA) (Wasn't much of this area without electricity?--NH)
- 790 (KABC) <u>CA</u>, Los Angeles 1/17 0731± off due to quake, returned to air in a short time. (MS-CA)
- 850 (KCTQ) CA, Thousand Oaks 1/17 1253 off because of earthquake, back on 1/18. (DG-CA)
- 870 (KIEV) CA, Glendale 1/17 0800± off due to guake. (MS-CA)
- 910 (KOXR) CA, Oxnard 1/17 1304 off due to earthquake. Back on 1/18. (DG-CA)
- 390 KQSB <u>CA</u>, Santa Barbara 1/17 1306 carrying earthquake coverage of KFWB-980, usually blocked here by KQSB. Much appreciated, as KFWB is all news. (DG-CA)
- 1070 KNX <u>CA</u>, Los Angeles 1/17 0732 (1 minute after 6.6 earthquake) announcer was forced to flee his position - mike was left on and frantic staffers could be heard fleeing, frantically answering phones, and picking up equipment that had been thrown on the floor. This continued for about 5 minutes, at which time the announcer returned, obviously very shaken, to begin news coverage of the earthquake. (DG-CA) +1/17 0733 running tone briefly after getting knocked off air

by quake, also running weak signal after quake, possibly on auxiliary power? (RW-CA) 1150 (KIIS) <u>CA</u>, Los Angeles 1/17 0800± off due to quake. (MS-CA) 1230 (KGFJ) <u>CA</u>, Los Angeles 1/17 0800± off due to quake. (MS-CA) 1460 (KTYM) <u>CA</u>, Inglewood 1/17 0800± off due to quake. 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



[continued from #20] Then I got to thinking, "How does society at large remember certain people who have passed on?" And the answer was: by naming (and re-naming) things after them; such as streets, schools, libraries, and so on. I also recalled that when KFI's traffic reporter, Bruce Wayne, was killed, the station renamed its ."KFI Traffic Center" the "Bruce -Wayne-KFI Traffic Center." So I thought, "Why not apply that concept to Ric's case and our club?" So, my suggestion to honor Ric's outstanding service of editing WDXF for so many years is for us to rename the column "The Ric T. Heald - WESTERN DX FORUM." I envision that in the masthead "Ric T. Heald" would be across the top in somewhat small print, and "WESTERN DX FORUM" would be below Ric's name in large print. The current editor, or course, would also continue to list his or her name and address. (So, in otherwords, the masthead would essentially look as it does now, except that "Ric T. Heald" would be added in small print across the top. Possibly, also, Reid might add the word "Editor:" directly before his name so that new members wouldn't be confused.) In practice, the column would still be referred to as "Western DX Forum" and "WDXF"; but by seeing Ric's name in the masthead, we would be quietly reminded of him every week.
