"Sports Byline USA" grew out of a sportstalk show Ron Barr had on 560 KSFO-CA in the 1980's. The national show, based at KSFO, began in 1988. The program moved to 910 KNEW in 1992 before being dropped in 1994, so the show ironically no longer has a hometown outlet. In 1993 Champion launched a national sports radio network in conjunction with Platinum Partners II, with the following schedule:

POINTS: There's no Simpson Trial Radio Network per se, but several stations had carried "gavel to gavel" coverage. Among the stations and their sources were 650 KSTE-CA (ABC), 670 WMAQ-IL, 760 KGU-HI (CBS), 1090/770 KNWX-WA, 1110 KAOI-HI (selected CNN stuff), 1340 KKTR-CA, 1550/95.7 KKHI-CA (COurt TV) and 1590 KLIV-CA (CNN). Steve Futterman, who reported on the trial for Westwood One Radio, Mutual's "Tom Leykis Show," the CBC and BBC Radio, also had a weekly show dealing with the trial, Sundays at 2200-0100 ELT on 710 KMPC-CA...For the record CBS Radio's baseball coverage was handled by Jim Hunter, John Rooney, Jerry Coleman, Gene Elston and Ernie Harwell, with color by Jeff Torborg, Al Downing and Johnny Bench. Vin Scully was scheduled to work the World Series with Torborg and Rooney. For football, the announcers are Jack Buck & Hank Stram, Howard David & John Dockery, and Rooney & Pat Haden, with Jim Hunter and Fox-TV's Matt Millen in the studio: the latter two also host the 30-minute "NFL Preview." CBS Americas provides Spanish-language coverage...CBS and Host Communications combine for a college football package with Chuck Cooperstein & Phil Schaefer, plus Tom Walsh joining either Pete Arbogast or David; Mike Keith's in the studio...The old NFL Mutual package is now under the aegis of Westwood One Entertainment with Tony Roberts, Harry Kalas, Beau Kiels, Jack Ham, Jack Snow and Rick Walker. Meanwhile the college football version uses Roberts, Joel Meyers, Don Williams, Fran Curci and Dave Rowe. Larry Michael and John Tautges are in-studio...
