+The Board of Directors shut down all transmissions both AM & FM, from Alberta's Access Radio Network March 22nd at 0000. They said they no longer have the funds to continue and had decided to shut down in an orderly fashion before they went bankrupt. Access Radio first went on the air in November 1927 as part of the University of Alberta and was funded by the Government of Alberta until July 1995 when all funding was withdrawn. Since then network has relied on donations & fund raising drives. (MS-AB)

800 KSOS UT, Brigham City 3/24 0335 pounding in way on top of frequency with oldies, ID. (RW-CA)

This past month I have received notes from two people concerning not seeing tips they reported to WDXR. Recently my column deadlines have been three weeks apart and I know one member's report arrived the day after a deadline. As a result, his tips sat in my WDXR drawer for three weeks before being used, there was a week before Ralph received that WDXR, then that issue arrived two weeks late. That meant the tips sent were finally read in print close to two months after they were sent! Now WDXR dealines are four weeks apart. So, if a report is received the day after WDXR is sent, it will sit for four weeks before the column is done. This is why it is important for you to note the deadlines. On another note, reporters are responsible for the correct spelling of their equipment. When I type receiver or antenna information I type it exactly as it is written by the reporter. If you misspell your equipment, that is how it will appear in the bulletin.

This letter serves as confirmation of your reception of KOZZ-AM on the evening of November 17, 1992, from 7:22pm to 7:48pm and from 8:55 to 8:59pm. Our music logs from this date confirm the music list provided in your letter compiled during your reception!

KOZZ-AM operates on 1450kHz with 1000-watts, non-directional, 24 hours per day, into a 180-foot radiator. The transmitter is a Continental 814R-1A, utilizing pulse width modulation. We normally have stereo capability, however our exciter is presently at the manufacturer for refurbishing and will be back in service within a week to ten days. Our AM facility normally simulcasts the Classic Rock programming of KOZZ-FM.

I've been surprised to receive a few reception reports in the two years that I've been Chief Engineer of KOZZ AM and FM, including one from Norway! I would have thought that congestion on a frequency like 1450kHz (or any former class IV frequency) would essentially preclude "dx'ing"!

For your information, our corporation, Lotus Radio, also owns two facilities in the Los Angeles area, KOXR-AM, Oxnard, and KWKW-AM, Pasadena, plus other AM and/or FM facilities in San Diego, Fresno, Las Vegas, Tucson, San Antonio and Lubbock (TX) and Chicago.

Ernest Cooper, 7 Anthony Street, Provincetown, Massachusetts 02657 It's been a frustrating season here this year, but I do get to do a little DXing from time to time. If conditions today were like they used to be, when most stations were off the air by midnight or 0100, I'd be logging a few new stations in towns along the Ohio River which have gone through devastating floods, for in times of dire emergency, daytime stations were permitted to operate around the clock. In fact, they still are, but now, with the all-night craze these stations are covered up. I've received only three new veries this season: WLUX-540 NY, KXBT-1630-CA (my 78th California verie), and new local WJLT-1060-Natick, MA whose logos are "The Light" and "Jesus is the Light". Another new one on the air is WRPT-650, with 250 watts daytime only. A report is off to them. And, WUOK-1240, West Yarmouth, MA has been given to Boston University, and began relaying WBUR-90.9 on Saturday, March 1, and I shot off a report and the verie came back in one week, and they're still using the old WUOK call, but expect to become WBUR-AM in a few days. They're running AN, of course. Reports have gone out to WCMF-990-NY, my 4th try for a verie, so this time I enclosed a PP/C but so far it has not come back. A report also to WQTM-540-FL, "The Team" for reception at 0100 on Jan. 27, and no reply yet. ... NRC's Ray Arruda sold me his HQ-180A, and I now have both it and my HQ-180 hooked up, which dislodges my HQ-150. I have no room for it - it is in sound working order, and I'll offer it to the highest bidder, and I'll pay the shipping charges. The special DX Tests didn't do anything for me - all I tried for didn't make it. I hope that no IRCAers were affected by the drastic weather conditions of mud slides, high winds, tornadoes, floods, etc. It seems every part of our country bears some weather risks. We here are right on East Coast - in fact, Cape Cod juts out into it, - and last summer we were spared a terrible hurricane which at the last moment veered about 10 miles east of here - we got lots of rain and wind, but the brunt of

The format change bandwagon seems to be cooling off right now on AM there has been one call letter change...WKBQ-104.1 but Jerseyville, IL has changed to WALC, reflecting its change to Modern AC as "Alice at 104.1". WKBQ continues to be used on 1380 in nearby St. Louis, MO, despite the fact its now simulcasting the Hot C&W format of WKKX-106.5 Granite City, IL. As far as I know, their new owners may have requested WKKX for the AM side. Also, CBS has gotten out of the FM business in St. Louis after 35 years by trading KLOU-103.3 Entertainment Communications (Entercom, for short) for KITS-105.3 San Francisco, CA. This leaves KMOX-1120 as a stand alone AM for the first time since 1958, when CBS purchased KWK-TV Channel 4, which they changed to KMOX-TV (CBS sold KMOXC-TV, now KMOV, in 1986). Speaking of KMOV, the station has been traded by Viacom Broadcasting Company to Belo Broadcasting Company for a TV station in Seattle, WA. Per John Tudenham, KGNN has switched off its AM spot on 1410, and moved KGNV-89.9 90.3 mHz. They continued to simulcast operations to Washington, MO with a religious format. Overnight music is courtesy of Moody Bible Network. Col. DX reported that WAVG-970 has been rumored to be sold to the owners of WLKY-TV 32. That company is Pulitzer Broadcasting Company. Their only other radio properties are both in Phoenix, KTAR-620/KKLT-98.7 (which Pulitzer got in exchange for KSD-550, now KTRS, in 1979). They've been out of the St. Louis television market since 1983, when they traded KSDK-5 to Multimedia for WFBC-TV 4 (now WYFF, "Your Friend Four") Greenville, SC. Their newspaper division owns St. Louis has a network owo on TV for the the St. Louis Post-Dispatch. first time since 1986. Fox Broadcasting Company, a division of Robert Murdock's News Corporation, has taken over ownership of KTVI-2 (along with several other TV stations) from New World Television. A lot of time has been spot on SW lately, especially with the purchase of a MFJ-1778 G5RV antenna at a hamfest on January 27. I've seen much improved results, especially on the tropical bands, as compared with a homebrew antenna I had been using since 1991. For instance, I wasn't able to get Guyana on 3290 kHz. Now, I can hear them with a fair signal. Latest AM verie came from WLAC-1510. 73 and good DX, Eric.
