- 1280 KDYL UT, Salt Lake City 10/23 0510 good ID amid MYL. (PT-WA)

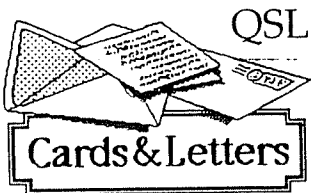

The St. Louis market went through the ninth format change of 1997 on October 20. After two weeks of simulcasting, the Majic Twins have split. Jacor Communications has moved the Urban Contemporary format that was previously on KMJM-107.7 to WCBW-104.9, and is now known as "Majic 105". A Top 40 (CHR) format has taken the 107.7 spot, IDing as "Z-107.7". Call letter changes will occur at both stations, and even KATZ-FM 100.3 (known as "100.3 Kiss FM") could change calls, too. It's another attempt to reposition the stations to better serve their markets. WCBW's 11 kW FM signal will more effectively serve African-American audiences, who are centered in the immediate St. Louis area. There's no better place to return a CHR format to St. Louis than on a 100 kW FM signal, which KMJM has. Of course, the AM affiliate of this duo is KATZ-1600, which is now the top-rated Urban Gospel station in St. Louis, displacing KSTL-690. WRBQ-1380 will switch to Talk as KWK sometime after Thanksgiving, inside sources say that the station will carry metro St. Louis high school basketball this winter. The ownership group that's expected to take over 1380 is headed by St. Louis businessman Mark Cason. KFNS-590 has been sold by American Radio Systems to Missouri Sports Radio. Surprised to see KCMO and WHB trade places on the AM dial in Kansas City...my guess is that WHB needed the 50 kW day signal on 810 to better cover the rural areas. It was my pleasure to attend the get-together in Mount Vernon, IL on 10/18. It was nice to renew old friendships, and make new ones. I was amazed at WMIX-940's night pattern on 1.5 kW, which shoots west up I-64. I was still able to hear the Westwood One Adult Standards programming on WMIX at Fairview Heights, IL (I-64 at SR 159), while I couldn't hear peep out of 5 kW WRTH-1430 (which I didn't until I got to I-255). I was also surprised to hear KTRS-550 at Mount Vernon, even in their null toward WKRC. That'll do it for now, 73 and good DX, Eric

Sorry about being incommunicado for so long but RadioPlus+ was virtually shut down from June to September. Late last January, just as production of the Quantum Phaser was beginning, a review of our Q-stick appeared in Monitoring Times. This led to a tremendous number of orders which was filled over a 6-8 week period but which almost totally depleted our stock of variable capacitors. These capacitors are used in virtually every product we sell and, when we went to re-order, we discovered that someone had bought out all of our suppliers (US and European) entire stock. None of the suppliers intended to re-order (there was a minimum order of 10,000 units) so we were stuck with trying to find a substitute. We did eventually find one but it was of different physical size and capacitance, so all of our products would have had to be re-designed. Furthermore, these new capacitors didn't arrive until late August, leaving very little time to re-design circuit boards, coils, cabinets, etc. Right in the midst of this re-design effort, we were contacted by a company that had placed the minimum order of 10,000 units, so now it looks like we may be able to resume normal production without completely re-designing our product line (but we are stuck with hundreds of the substitute capacitors, hi). We have resumed production to fill back orders of the Quantum Loop and Q-Stick series but will not be able to accept new orders until late November/early December. (Right now, we have just under 50 Quantum Loop orders to fill and even more back orders for Q-Sticks (plus several LW loopheads to get out), so it will take 4-6 weeks to catch up.) Our other products will likely not be available until after the first of the year. Obviously, the preceding state of affairs has delayed this seasons catalog; we may just send out an abbreviated product sheet since we will only be offering the Quantum Loop and Q-Stick until the first of the year. Oh yeah,

after months of frustration with America On-Line, I have a new e-mail address: radioplus@gulf.net. This is not a formal website (that may come in the future), just an e-mail site (that I check a couple of times a week). Sometimes I ask myself why I'm doing this radio equipment business stuff--the net profit line is minimal, the hassles sometimes extreme. Right now, I'm just trying to hang on until next summer when I become eligible for an early retirement; then, I'm thinking, I can go full blast with Radio Plus+. In the meantime, I deeply appreciate your patience, understanding, business, and especi-ally, your kind words regarding our products. 73's...GT (Gerry, my kind words are that the Quantum Loop is a lot easier to haul 400 miles to my mother-in-law's house than the 2 foot square air core loop--rce)



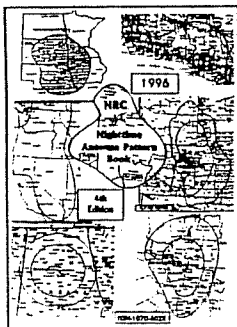

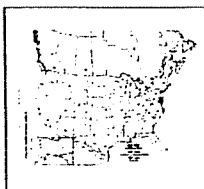
