UN-IDEN:

Here is an interesting tidbit. I have heard a station on 1650 KHz for a couple of evenings (12/15, 16) at around 18:00-20:00 playing some instrumental stuff. One of the pieces I heard was kind of a new age/hoe-down/middle eastern mix. Some of the folks on the internet are saying that this is probably WHKT 1650, Portsmouth, VA. This station was huge in Allentown PA on the old Jetta radio. You may want to pass this tip on.

You are correct. I believe they are running a full 10 KW They BOOM into Ocala at s-9 or 10. - They were off for a few days. Are back now (12-29)

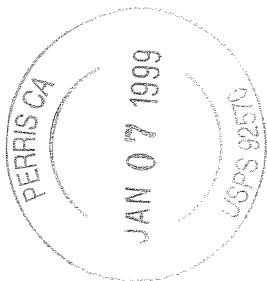
