Then his bosses told him he couldn't hire me. So, the resumes are going out again--and no responses so far to any of them. I have done a little bit of DX in the past week or so. One new country in PJB-800 Bonaire to give me three countries here, plus two new states in WTIC-1080 CT and WOKY-920 for Wisconsin. The odd thing is that when I lived near Philadelphia, I only heard one station from Wisconsin and that was also WOKY. I haven't had any luck here looking for WKSH-1640 although I have heard it in southeast Alabama. I still have one of the buttons on the car radio set for WOKY. Probably most of the new stations I have logged here recently have been either North Carolina or South Carolina. I don't know if it is the weather doing it or if it is the time of day (mostly around sunset or a few minutes before but it seems strange to start logging new stuff less than one hundred miles away. Now up to 196 heard here. Not good for 2.5 years in the area, but I really have not done that much listening here. The power company was out here early in April with a gadget that looked like a TV antenna, looking for noise problems. Then, a week later, they backed a cherry-picker truck thru my backyard to get to the electric pole which I have always suspected was my noise problem. Since then, it seems like the noise has been a lot lower, but we also had a stretch of storms at the same time which still made it rough to listen. I ran across someone at church who likes to listen somewhat to distant stations (he keeps talking about listening to WWL-870 and WOWO-1190) so the last time we were at his house, I took along the Quantum Loop and hooked it up to his radio. He had never seen a loop before and he was amazed at what it was picking up there. He is more into shortwave, tho. One of the things which amazed him was how much better some of the local stations came in on the loop. His house apparently is in a bad location for DX--it is in a real sandy area which they mine and ship out to the glass factories--but I managed to pull almost an S-9 signal out of WHAM-1180 NY for him which really impressed him. Next thing will be to get him up here where he can see the HQ in action with a loop. By the way, he repairs mainframe computers for a living. Must go. 73.

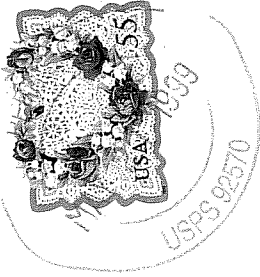
