Please remember, what's listed as being on, say, Monday morning "may" be what you think of as Sunday night! (THE TIME OF THE TEST IS IN THE LOCAL TIME OF THE STATION)

Monday, October 21, 2002 - WLCR-1470, Louisville, KY (COL Shepherdsville, KY) will conduct a DX test from 3:00-4:00 am EDT. The station's regular programming is EW TN - their slogan is "Louisville's Catholic Radio". IDs will be played in both Morse code and voice. The IDs will use a 1 kHz tone at 5 wpm sent every 5 minutes. The station's power will be 750 W (not sure of pattern). Reception reports (with return postage) may be sent to:

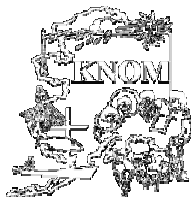

Saturday, October 26, 2002 - KNOM -780, Nome, AK will conduct a DX test from 12:00am-1:00am Alaska Local Time (e.g. 4-5 am EDT). From Les Brown, who arranged the test: "We are currently planning to go from nighttime power (14 kW) up to 25 kW within a minute or two after midnight on 10/26, a Saturday. As I won't be here, I'll set it up with a regular operator to make the change as soon as the station goes into AP network news. The news ends at 12:05 and is followed by lengthy weather forecasts for various Alaska regions, typically ending around 12:09. Programming will be Polish polkas from then until the next newscast at 1 AM with a

A TA Opening has occurred! Thanks to a tip on [RCA] at Topica from **Nick Hall-Patch**, **Mike Stonebridge** and I noted receptions as well. I was really surprised tonight (9/23 local time) after Nick's posting earlier about a carrier on 1314 kHz. Mike writes: Thanks to Nick's tip from last night, I checked the band for TA's just after local sunset tonight and found that 1314-Norway was in with a huge signal playing their usual fare of pop music. I also heard faint unrecognizable audio on 747 and 1053, which was probably France and the UK. Also carriers were noted on 702, 837, 855, 864, 909, 1071 and 1215. First TA's of the new season. Nick added: Yep, plural carriers, but still no audio, even on 1314. Others were 1539, 1377, 1215, 1197, 1107, 999, 855 and 585...quite different from what **Patrick Martin** was hearing, but Mike Stonebridge was hearing 855 and 1215 carriers.

PAN-AMERICAN DX ROUNDUP

660 **MEXICO**, Aguascalientes, Agua. XEEY a new catch on 9/9 at 0300 with local commercial in which a man said "aguien Aguascalientes." At 1151 9/10 I heard the "La Consentida" ID. On 9/9 1157, the ancr m entioned "Caliente" that might be another slogan. KTNN was apparently off at this time. Main QRM was from KGDP and assumed CFFR. (LG-M T)

1500 **MEXICO**, Mexico City, XEDF was surely the one with mention of "Organizacion Radio Form ula de Mexico" at 0300 9/13. (LG-M T)

TRANS-ATLANTIC ROUNDUP

711 **UNID** was only a carrier causing a het on KIRO-710. Never did get any audio at several tries at 0320, then at 0330, and again at 0341 9/24. (PM-OR)
819 **UNID** again another het against a domestic, KGNW -820, produced no audio at 0315 9/24. (PM-OR)
864 **UNID** a good strong carrier at 0318 UTC with bits of music, Southern European?, hard to hear with domestic splatter 9/27. (PM-OR)
963 **UNID** produced a good strong carrier at 0322. I was hoping for some audio on this, presumed Finland, but no audio showed up 9/24. (PM-OR)
