DX Tests

PLEASE NOTE: Even if you don't hear a test, be sure and drop a card, letter, or e-mail to the station personnel, and thank them for going to the trouble to run a test! Please remember, what's listed as being on, say, Monday morning "may" be what you think of as Sunday night! (THE TIME OF THE TEST IS IN THE LOCAL TIME OF THE STATION)

Monday, October 21, 2002 - WLCR-1470, Louisville, KY (COL Shepherdsville, KY) from 3:00-4:00 am EDT:

This test was to run some Morse code IDs along with their regular EWTN programming, and the power was to be 750 W, at least at the start of the test. However, due to some technical problems, the Morse wasn't played, and the test ran at only 54 watts! The test has been rescheduled for Sunday, Dec. 1, 2002, at the same time (3-4am EST), though this time the power will be 750 W from 2:45 - 3:15am. Many DXers confirmed that they tried for but didn't hear the test; these included Robert Wien of San Jose, CA, Mac (KR0I) in Kansas City, MO, RC Watts in Louisville, KY, Phil Bytheway in Seattle, WA, Patrick Martin in Seaside, OR, Greg Myers in Clearwater, FL, Les Rayburn in Helena, AL, Park Barton in Tuscaloosa, AL, Steve Powell in Clemson, SC, Bill Dvorak in Madison, WI, Kevin Redding in Mesa, AZ, Gerry Bishop in Niceville, FL, Paul LaFreniere in Grand Marais, MN, Bob Karchevski in Sunnyvale, CA, Rich Line in Sterling Heights, MI, and Steve Francis in Alcoa, TN. Hopefully, the rescheduled test will be just as widely listened for!

Saturday, November 2, 2002 - WDFB-1170, Danville, KY (COL Junction City, KY) will conduct a DX test from 12:00am-?? EST. The station's regular format is Christian; they go by "WDFB Christian Radio". Songs such as "Amazing Grace" "Sweet Beulah Land" and "My Country, My Flag (by the Hoppers)" will be played, along with voice and/or Morse code IDs.

KTRB Granted Move By FCC

KTRB Modesto CA has been granted a construction permit to move the station from Modesto to San Francisco, CA. The new facilities, to remain on 860 kHz, will be 50 kW day and 40

kW (directional) nights. According to the FCC application, two sites are given: one is near Antioch CA near the Delta, the other is in the hills just west of Gilroy (one is in error as the coordinates are identical except for one digit). The station management is considering a new format for the station once the move is complete by next Fall; additionally, a new station will be constructed in Modesto to operate on 840 kHz from the existing facilities, with a power of 5,000 watts. The station's ownership, having pursued the move since 1986, indicates that the San Francisco area is well suited for a successful AM station because of the surrounding terrain. Presently the station relays KMPH 107.5 Fresno CA with a news and talk format, the local studio having been closed. – *from various sources*

- 730 KLVB OR, Medford 10/22 0345 fair at best with KBSU's jazz taking center stage. Several K-Love slogans, with assorted contemporary Christian music and talk. (DP-OR)
- KULE WA, Ephrata 10/22 0446 fair mixing with many others. Michael Regan self promoting show "on Hot Talk 730 KULE AM." (DP-OR)
- 770 KATL MT, Miles City 10/24 0916 great. Nice local announcer, with plenty of ID's, time & temperature checks. Ad with mention of "Stagecoach Breakfast Special" and then details for a pumpkin hunt contest. AC music now and then. (DP-OR)

- 790 (KWIL) OR, Albany 10/24 0935-1019 with open carrier. About 4-5 stations in background. After KJRB, I spent the rest of the time trying to ID a Spanish station, possibly KOOR, Clovis. (DP-OR)

DX has been very AU the past week, bringing in Mexicans and DUs. So away we go....

PAN-AMERICAN DX ROUNDUP

- 540 MEXICO, Tijuana, BCN.XESURF 10/21 0400. Good ID is SS at 0433 "XESURF, Tijuana, Mexico" (all letters). Several slogans one of which is "...the Surf, perfect where ever you are in Southern California." Into Mr. Sandman. (DP-OR)
- 540 MEXICO, San Luis Potosi, SLP XEWA 10/22 0557 very good at first. Late or delayed time pips and female with news at 0600. This was followed by a mix of mx, two ancrrs and call-ins. Heard several simple "W Radio" slogans. They played a great version of "La Cucaracha". XESUR much weaker tonight. (DP-OR)
- 730 MEXICO, Mexico City, XEX 10/22 0625 very poor with music and occasional talk, fading about every 20 minutes, KBSU, KLVB, and CHMJ (ex CKLG), Mojo Radio which continually switches places with KBSU dominating. I only copied tidbits until call letters by male announcer were heard at 1113. No slogans heard. (DP-OR)

- 531 NEW ZEALAND, Auckland, 1XPI, good with Samoan talk by man at 0915 10/25. (PM-OR)
- 576 AUSTRALIA, Sydney 2RN, 10/25 1422. Noted here initially with "really" weird sounding Indian sorta Indian music and became really excited about the 200 kw Indian station on the frequency. Was somewhat devastated when the number was followed by a scholarly discussion of the classic Aussie talk! It was Radio National's weekend world music show it WAS an Indian album. // 9580 & 846. Nuts! (JB-WA) *(The Radio National net has been running Indian mx in the evenings, Australian Time, for years now. 4RN-792 is common. This can fool you, if you never have heard it. PM)*
- 612 AUSTRALIA, Brisbane 4QR (MS), 10/25 1420. Tuned across 612 and noted Aussie talk armchair level. 4QR is our beacon for DU cx on the low band. (JB-WA)
- 612 AUSTRALIA, Brisbane 4QR 1400 10/25 ABC news, into mx program 1406 (NP-AB)
- 702 AUSTRALIA, Sydney 2BL (MS) 10/25 1426. Hrd w/Aussie talk //612. Fair to poor. (JB-WA)
- 702 AUSTRALIA, Sydney 2BL 1352 10/26 "Saturday Night Country" program, ID as "702 ABC Sydney" prior to news at 1400. (NP-AB)
- 738 FRENCH POLYNESIA, Tahiti, Papeete, RFO 1102 10/26. News in FF read by M&F (NB-AB)
- 756 P.R.CHINA, CNR 1, unknown location 10/23 1405, CNR 1 program noted here in standard CC from 1400 to 1510, normal pips at TOH //7150//5030. Good at peaks. Pleased with this totally new one for me! (JB-WA)
- 792 AUSTRALIA, Brisbane 4RN 1331 10/25 Presumed the one with eclectic mix of mx, into ABC news at 1400. //2RN 846. (NP-AB)
- 828 AUSTRALIA, Sale, 3GI 1347 10/25. Presumed the one with talk program hosted by Aussie accented man. (NP-AB)

- 846 AUSTRALIA, Canberra 2RN 10/25 1433. Heard here with same "really" weird sounding Indian music as noted on 576 and there is a 100 KW Indian listed. Again, Aussie talk. Good level. (JB-WA)
- 846 AUSTRALIA, Canberra 2RN 1359 10/25. "Across Australia, you're listening to Radio National" then into ABC news. (NP-AB)
- 864 REP. KOREA, Gangleung (pres), HLKR 10/23 1410. KK talk heard here at fair level. Not //to N. KK SW Service, so this one likely. (JB-WA)
- 891 AUSTRALIA, Adelaide 5AN 1233 10/25. ABC News by a woman, noted again at 1330 with ABC Adelaide, ID prior to news. (NP-AB)
- 972 REP. KOREA, Dangjin, HLCA 10/23 1425. Heard with 1st Liberty program to North Korea. Good level with KK talk (JB-WA)
- 1026 AUSTRALIA, Melbourne 3DB 1228 10/25. Presumed this one with BBC program (NP-AB)
- 1116 AUSTRALIA, Brisbane 4BC 1228 10/25. Weather, with mentions of the Gold Coast. Noted several "4BC Brisbane" jingles and heard "Southern Cross Network News" at 1300 UTC. As strong as the US stations on 1110 and 1120 at times! (NP-AB) (*This one really gets out. PM*)

- 1287 JAPAN, Sapporo, JOHR 10/23 1428 Also noted with informal JJ talk and pop music. Fair to poor. (JB-WA)
- 1422 UNID, 1353 10/26. Very weak with talk in non-EE then what sounded like Greek mx, Possibly 3XY? (NP-AB) (*Very likely. PM*)
- 1566 REP. KOREA, Cheju Island, HLAZ 10/23 1437. Noted here in passing with fair to good audio. (JB-WA)
- 1575 THAILAND, Ayutthaya, VOA 10/23 1435. Heard in SE Asian language at good to excellent signals. I wonder if they have increased power or tightened their Northern beam? They are doing very well this season. (JB-WA)
