DX Tests

PLEASE NOTE: Even if you don't hear a test, be sure to contact the station, and thank them for going to the trouble to run a test! Please remember, what's listed as being on, say, Monday morning "may" be what you think of as Sunday night! (Test times are in the station's LOCAL time.)

Sunday, February 2, 2003 - WBMJ-1190, San Juan, PR and WIVV-1370, Vieques, PR will conduct a DX test from 12:00-2:00 am AST (11:00pm-1am EST). This test will be run simultaneously on both stations. At 11:59 pm AST, the stations will come out of a youth program - "Life on the Edge" - and then run a minute of DX information, including Morse code IDs. Then the stations will return to their regular programming from the Moody Broadcasting Network. The same procedure will be repeated at 12:59 am AST and 1:59 am AST. WBMJ will be broadcasting at 5 kW; WIVV at 1 kW. Reception reports (with return postage) may be sent to:

- 153 NORWAY with Andy Williams record at 1/1/03 at 0104 UTC, S-7 signal at times. Also noted with female singing in NN at 2342 12/31. Good signal at times and the best of them all. (MS-AB)
- 162 FRANCE with female speaking FF at 0215 1/1/03, not needed. (MS-AB)
- 189 UNID, faint mx here at 0217 1/1. Probably Iceland. (MS-AB)
- 207 UNID, faint mx here at 0219 UTC u/beacon noise. Could have been Iceland, and if it was, it would have been new for me. 1/1/03. (MS-AB)
- 225 UNID, Faint mx here at 0221 1/1. I heard Ireland here 2 years ago, but they went off the air and I am not sure if they are back on. (MS-AB)
- 693 UNID, Male talking at 0110 1/1. Unable to make out language. (MS-AB)
- 711 UNID, woman talking at 0112 1/1. Unable to make out language. (MS-AB)
- 747 UNID, Faint mx here at 0114 1/1. Poor signal. Never got better. (MS-AB)
- 756 UNID, Faint inst. mx here 0117 1/1. Never heard any talking. (MS-AB)
- 855 UNID, I could just discern 2 males talking at 2341 12/31. Poor at best. (MS-AB)
- 945 UNID, I hrd faint Jazz at 0237 12/31. Very poor signal. (MS-AB)
- 954 UNID, male singing at 2337 12/31, unable to catch lang. Very poor (MS-AB)
- 963 UNID, Woman talking in unk language at 2336 UTC 12/31. Male with what sounded like news at TOH, then into mx which included some EE, fair at times. Language did sound somewhat similar to what I hear on 153 and 1314, so it is possible it could have been Finland which is listed as 600 kW. (MS-AB)
- 963 UNID, man and woman talking at 0124 UTC 1/1. Still unable to make out language. Though the signal was better than last night, it wasn't still all that great and noisy too. (MS-AB)
- 1008 UNID, Man talking in unk lang. at 0131 UTC 1/1. Could have been one of the Slavic languages. Followed by mx, fair at times. (MS-AB)
- 1035 UNID, faint mx heard at 2335 12/31. Very poor signal. (MS-AB)
