Better late than never. It's a bit late for this note to be in the Anniversary issue, which I'm reading and enjoying now, a great tradition. I've been in IRCA on and off since 1967, have been retired for ten years now. I started DX listening in 1952 when in eighth grade, seeking hot jazzy sounds in that dull conservative era of popular music. Found lively country music and the friendly voice of Paul Kallinger on his All Nite Show on XERF which blanketed North America like a local on winter nights then, and Firehouse Five Dixieland type jazz on 50 kw'ers such as WLS, back then shared with WENR. By 1959 I was getting

thrills catching 5 kw'ers from as far away as California with a 6 tube Zenith radio from the St. Louis area where I lived until I moved to central FL four years ago. I did not discover the DX Clubs until the 1963-64 season. It was amazing how advanced in DXing club members were, I found the bickering confusing and dismaying in the old "other club" just before IRCA was born. The best radio I had in my younger days was a Hallicrafters SX-122 11 tube set. it wasn't as good in sensitivity as a friend's National NC-190 but guite selective, was thrilled to heard, send out a tape and verify Dakar on 764 in 1976, on one of the very rare occasions TA signals made it far inland to Missouri. Before that, the best set I got my hands on for DXing was a Zenith Transoceanic a friend had, an early series all-transistorized portable. Also car radios used with power supply were fun, as they gave DXing performance comparable with fine communications rigs, only with better tone quality and less selectivity for foreign splits. The downside of club DXing then was being put down if discussed Top 40 programming instead of pure DXing, thankfully not true anymore. The all-night broadcasting craze started accelerating in 1965-66, by 1970 I thought the AM band was getting so crowded that BCB DXing was going to wither and die. So I took up car collecting and only got DXing kicks from the fine sounding radios in my Kaiser and Thunderbird cars whenever I got around to dial twisting. Since old cars take up far more room, care and feeding than home radios & QSL cards, I gave that up after three years. In 1971, I made the discovery that areas that have frequent sightings of flying saucers and strange creatures are areas of disturbances in the earth's magnetic field, and that the most advanced successful

DXers as a general rule lived in these certain areas. The Ohio Vallev and its tributary rivers seemed to be the hot places, along with some Great Lakes locations, to be the places encounter to great DX and otherworldly objects and creatures. Since DX signals are skewed off course by these magnetic disturbances and flying saucers, the debate over what state to count a station



from that has a transmitter site in an adjoining state is preposterous to me. Then I acquired a place in the country, topping it with an 8 element FM yagi which I had fun with until an ice storm took it down. Replaced it with a 6 element R.S. yagi in the attic, not quite as good but still fun in those days of an uncrowded FM band until the 1990s when too many stations and far fewer IDs got me turned off of serious TV-FM DXing, though I still very sporadically tune FM with indoor antennas. I never got married, so I encountered few problems of DX'ing due to family distractions. Just replaced my old ham call KBOZLZ with a new call W4WMB, have fun with 50 watts into a Smart-tuner fed 33 foot wire across the outside end wall of my apartment building working northern states, Canada and Europe on SSB 10, 15, & 17 meters. Am hoping that XM satellite radio with prosper with its inclusion into new 2003-04 autos and give commercial AM & FM radio enough competition to force improvement in programming.

# The Blooper

# by Jack Rhodes

In the early days of radio, most receivers were of the regenerative type. When operated just below the point of oscillation, they were very sensitive and selective. In an oscillating condition they were used to find weak stations, and for CW reception. But then the resulting radiation interfered with nearby receivers by causing a beat or "bloop" with other receivers in the vicinity. Hence, the term "blooper".

The set was popular because it provided the most for the least. The real test of a radio was its ability to get distant stations. DX fans in the U.S. wanted to get Australia, and vice versa. One of the early American stations to span the Pacific was KGO in Oakland, California. All of which lead Wireless Weekly (in Australia) to publish the following ode in 1927:

When Jenkins hunts for KGO For miles around the listeners know Who twists and twirls his radio -"That's Jenkins".

With whoops and howls the heavens abound, The local stations fade from sound, And fiercest static goes to ground, For Jenkins.

But Jenkins with his one-tube set Has never logged that station yet, No KGO can Jenkins get -Not Jenkins.

Yet always have I yearned to know If, in their Oakland studio, Our Yankee friends of KGO Get Jenkins?
