DX Test Results

Here's the results of the most recent DX test that have been received here:

WKWN-1420, Trenton, GA - tested Thursday, March 13, 2003 from 12:00-1:00 am ELT:



This test seems to have been received best to the north-northwest of the station. Trenton isn't all that far from Helena, AL, (near Birmingham), where **Les Rayburn** tried for the test, but the best he could receive was a possible CID. He called the station's CE, who confirmed that the test did indeed run, but thanks to storm fronts in the area, there was a lot of interference on 1420 kHz keeping WKWN's signal from getting out. **Gerry Bishop** in Niceville, FL reports hearing a rather weak CID at about 0029 EST. However, **Greg Myers** in Clearwater, FL says he didn't hear anything that sounded like a test during the test period. **Eric Breon** in Middletown, PA, reports he didn't receive the test, and neither did **Steve Francis** in Alcoa, TN or **Dave Lines** in SE PA. But **Tom Jasinski** in Shorewood, IL heard Morse code at 0029 and 0044, as well as several test tones. **Jeff Falconer** in Clinton, ON, also heard the test - a weak Morse code ID – he says interference from other stations on the frequency was strong.



WEPG-910, South Pittsburg, TN - tested Thursday, March 20, 2003 from 12:00-1:00 am CLT:

South Pittsburg is right on the AL-TN border, and Helena, AL, is about 120 miles away, but **Les Rayburn** reports only a tentative male ID followed by a code ID - he says the signal was very weak. He says he heard the PSK31 signals around 6 minutes

after the hour and what he recognized as Scottie One Slow Scan TV signal about 40 minutes

after the hour. But that was the only positive report received - **Gerry Bishop** in Niceville, FL, **Park Barton** in Tuscaloosa, AL, and **Brian D. Smith** in Indianapolis, IN all tried for the test but didn't hear it.

I just heard the ID with SS pops "KFSG Roseville-Sacramento" at 2200, ex-KSXX.

(Note: **Tim Noonan** of Madison, WI. sent similar info from FCC website for KSXX/KFSG call change).

Pat also sends along the following re KTFH-1680 Seattle:

Monte, the CE for Salem in Seattle called me today. I told him I sent Richard Harris the report. Richard used to be Dir. of Communications for Salem in Seattle. Richard must be about 75 now and works in the corporate offices mostly. I sent a cassette of the signal. Monte was very pleased to hear the signal. They are 10/1 KW ND. So the testing at night is 1 KW ND. They are using one of the 1590 towers. They will be on by 3/31. KKOL 1300 will be on as soon as they can get the site built for 50/5 KW U4.

Pat also sends along the following re IBOC station status:

Only WOR & WLW is testing IBOC at the moment. Those other stations on the list have been ok'ed to go IBOC in time. When that will be is anyone's guess. I notice there are 25 AM

stations on the list and only 5 are in the West. 840 Las Vegas & 880 Seattle really don't count as they were tests only at the NAB convention. What we have left is KNX, KABL, and KCBS.

Paul Ormandy of New Zealand (via Pat Martin of Seaside, OR.) sends the following:

Am hearing Radio Catolica on 1670kHz, anncing 660kHz and advertised a rally at Los Angeles Sports Center. I guess one of the CA X-banders has gone all religious, relaying KGDP???? - 640 **MEXICO**, Cd. Juarez, Chih. XEJUA a new catch 3/17 at 0400. I heard Ranchera music and a man gave call ID and said "...desde Ciudad Juarez, Chihuahua, Mexico." Poor signal in KFI null. I think this was just before "La Hora Nacional" began. It's carried by most, perhaps all Mexican stations once a week at this time.
