1240 KQEN OR, Roseburg 1/19 0100 sports talk show in the jumble with ID, fair to poor on Hammarlund & Select-A-Tenna loop. (GH-OR1)
CFNI BC, Port Hardy 1/10 0958 oldies, then multi-station ID "98.9 Magic FM is CFCP Courtenay, CFNI 1240 Port Hardy, and CFTA 100.3 FM Port Alice." (NP-AB1)

1260 KOIT CA, San Francisco 1/19 0420 good signal pummeling all else on frequency with ID "96.5 AM and 1260 AM, KOIT." Good conditions to Bay Area this morning. Later KTRC took over the frequency as usual. (RW-CA)

1290 KOUU ID, Pocatello 1/23 0900 top of hour ID "This is KOUU AM stereo 1290 K-O Double U, Pocatello, American Falls, Blackfoot." (BB-ID)

1490 KMET CA, Banning 1/19 0800 fair on top with ID "Smooth jazz the way you like it, we're 1490 AM The Oasis." (RW-CA)

1500 KSJX CA, San Jose 1/22 1000 weak but all alone with ID as "Radio ???, KSJX." (LG-MT)

1570 WBGX IL, Harvey caught a Black Gospel station on 1570 at 0305 1/23, giving info on Sunday evening church services, mentioned one at 7pm. I phoned WBGX and asked them about what I heard, and they ID'd it over the phone. They want me to send a tape as they have never been logged in Oregon. I must admit the tape leaves a lot to be desired, but at least I heard WBGX. The reason I heard them is they are currently on a STA running 1kw 24/7 while their pattern is being worked on.
