- 1240 KQEN <u>OR</u>, Roseburg 1/19 0100 sports talk show in the jumble with ID, fair to poor on Hammarlund & Select-A-Tenna loop. (GH-OR1)
 - CFNI <u>BC</u>, Port hardy 1/10 0958 oldies, then multi-station ID "98.9 Magic FM is CFCP Courtenay, CFNI 1240 Port Hardy, and CFTA 100.3 FM Port Alice." (NP-AB1)
- 1260 KOIT <u>CA</u>, San Francisco 1/19 0420 good signal pummeling all else on frequency with ID "96.5 AM and 1260 AM, KOIT." Good conditions to Bay Area this morning. Later KTRC took over the frequency as usual. (RW-CA)
